YESTERDAY: The Curve opened the season with a win in a road opener for the first time in franchise history as they defeated Harrisburg, 1-0. **Willy Garcia** drove home **Keon Broxton** in the ninth for the game's only run and **Yhonathan Barrios** closed the door in the bottom of the ninth for the save. **Angel Sanchez** tossed six scoreless innings to start the game and didn't allow a hit through his first four. **Tom Harlan** (1-0) was credited with the win after pitching a scoreless eighth and getting out of a jam with the leadoff runner at second base and no one out.

CURVE/SENATORS SERIES: This is the second of four games to open the year in the capital of the commonwealth and the second of 20 total games the two teams will play against one another this season. With the win on Thursday night in the season opener, the Curve improved to 4-0 versus Harrisburg when opening the season with the 'Sen. Entering tonight, the Curve are 159-131 all time versus Harrisburg all-time.

FOR ALTOONA: Making his Double-A debut on Friday night will be North Carolina native **Jason Creasy**, who spent all of 2014 with Bradenton. Creasy, 22, went 8-9 for Bradenton in 28 games (27 starts) last season while posting a 3.93 ERA in 148.2 innings pitched. This will be the first time he's faced a Washington Nationals affiliate since 2013 when he was a member of the West Virginia Power of the South Atlantic League. Creasy is an innings eater, going at least five innings in all but nine of his 27 starts last season while going at least six in 13-of-27 starts. *For more on Creasy, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right hander Joe Ross gets the nod for the 'Sens on Friday night in the second game of the series. Ross, 21, will be making his organizational debut tonight as he was acquired in a trade by the Nationals on December 18, 2014. He is the brother of current Padres starter Tyson Ross, who went 13-14 in the big leagues last year with San Diego and is in the rotation once again this season. Joe, pitched a majority of 2014 with Adv-A Lake Elsinore, going 8-6 with a 3.98 ERA in 19 starts. He was bumped up to Double-A San Antonio and pitched well, going 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA in four games (three starts). The younger Ross is a former first round pick, taken 25th overall in the 2011 draft by San Diego.

I WOULD WALK 500 MILES...: It's been a good long while since the Curve had a record of .500 or better in the regular season. A win in Thursday night's season-opener put the Curve over the .500 mark for the first time since they were 4-3 after a win versus these Senators on April 11, 2013.

SEASON OPENER NOTES: With the win on Thursday the Curve...are 7-10 overall on Opening Day...won their first Opening Day game since April 5, 2012 (7-4 vs. Erie)...grabbed their first Opening Day win on the road, breaking a previous 0-8 record when opening on the season on the road. Thursday night's starter Angel Sanchez also spun six shutout innings vs. Harrisburg, the most scoreless innings by a Curve starter in franchise history.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: Of the 25 players on the Curve's Opening Day roster, five of them are listed in the Pirates Top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. The five are: **Tyler Glasnow** (#1), **Josh Bell** (#4), **Willy Garcia** (#12), **Stetson Allie** (#21) and **Chad Kuhl** (#28). Of the five, three of them spent time in Curve, Pa. in 2014.

ALL HAIL THE PRINCE: The Curve have a new man to steer the ship in 2015 in manager **Tom Prince**. Prince, 50, embarks on his first season at the Double-A level as a skipper and is coming off leading the Bradenton Marauders to a playoff appearance and a second-half title in the Florida State League in 2014. Prince owns a career managerial record of 360-339 and has won one championship in 2012 with the GCL Pirates (their first title since joining the league in 1968).

PLAYOFFS...PLAYOFFS?: Of the 25 men on the Curve's Opening Day roster, three of them have been a part of a playoff team in the Pirates organization in each of the last three seasons. RHP **Tyler Glasnow**, 2B **Max Moroff**, and 3B **Eric Wood**, have all been a part of teams that have made the playoffs in each of the last three seasons. It began when they won the GCL title with the GCL Pirates in 2012 before they made the playoffs by winning the second half with the West Virginia Power in 2013. Last season, under Prince, they won the second half title of the Florida State League South division. Altoona as a franchise has not made the postseason since winning its only Eastern League Championship in 2010. Other members of the Curve's Opening Day roster with playoff experience are **Jason Creasy** (2013), **Tom Harlan** (2013), **John Kuchno** (2013), **Jhondaniel Medina** (2013 & 2014), **Jonathan Schwind** (2013) and **Josh Smith** (2014)

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS?: The Curve are one of 60 teams that will play the entirety of the 2015 season with the use of pitch clocks (all teams in AA and above) but it won't be the first time seeing pitch clocks for a few of the players on this 2015 team. IFs **Josh Bell** and **Dan Gamache**, RHP **Tyler Glasnow**, LHP **Tom Harlan** and RHP **Angel Sanchez** all played in the Arizona Fall League last season, where the clocks were first tested out. Enforcement of pitch clock violations will not begin in the Eastern League until May 1. However, the clocks were non-operational on Thursday night in Harrisburg.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: The 2015 Curve roster...has 13 players that have suited up in a Curve uniform at some point in their careers....10 that are playing at the Double-A level for the first time....12 pitchers and 13 position players...and one member of the Pirates' 40-man roster (**Willy Garcia**).

TROPHY CASE: The Curve have both the Pirates Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Year from 2014 on their 2015 Opening Day roster. **Josh Bell** was named the Pirates Player of the Year after a stellar season with High-A Bradenton that saw him win the league's MVP award despite playing for Double-A Altoona the last month and a half of the season. RHP **Tyler Glasnow** was named the Pirates' Pitcher of the Year for a second straight season and was also named the Florida State League's Pitcher of the Year in 2014.

CHRISTENING THE OPENING DAY ROSTER: The Curve will have their first MLB rehab assignment player of the 2015 season when they open the season tonight in Harrisburg. Pirates catcher **Chris Stewart** has been added to the club's roster to begin his rehab assignment. Stewart, 33, is recovering from a right hamstring strain and is expected to have one more rehab game with the Curve.
