YESTERDAY: Chad Kuhl (1-0) dealt five innings of one-run ball and the offense was just good enough to edge the Harrisburg Senators, 2-1, in the series finale for the Curve to grab a series split. Eric Wood drove in the game's first run with a two-out, RBI single in the third but the deciding run in the game was clubbed by Jacob Stallings, who mashed a double into the left-centerfield gap to score Jonathan Schwind in the sixth. Kuhl struck out five in his first Double-A start while the bullpen duo of Tom Harlan and Yhonathan Barrios combined for four innings of shutout baseball. Barrios converted his second save in as many tries, getting the final five outs. Keon Broxton and Wood have each hit safely in the team's first four games.

CURVE/SQUIRRELS SERIES: Tonight marks the first of three games in this series and the first of 20 games between the Curve and Squirrels this season. Each team will host 10 games in the series and after this series the Curve will not return to Richmond until immediately following the All-Star break.

FOR ALTOONA: Getting the nod for the Curve in the series opener tonight is LHP Zack Dodson, who begins his second season in the starting rotation for the Curve. Dodson, 24, went 4-8 with a 4.62 ERA a season ago for Altoona in his first full season at the Double-A level. He showed great improvement after the All-Star break last year and finished the season strong with a 3.10 ERA over his final eight starts. Dodson was a fourth-round pick of the Pirates in the 2009 draft out of Medina Valley HS in Texas. For more on Dodson, see page two.

FOR RICHMOND: Richmond will send RHP Joe Biagini to the bump for his Double-A debut in tonight's series opener. Biagini spent all of 2014 with the San Jose Giants and posted a 10-9 mark with a 4.01 ERA in 23 starts. He's steadily progressed through the system since being drafted in the 26th-round out of UC Davis in the 2011 draft. The righty enjoyed his best month of the season last year in August, going 3-2 with a 2.73 ERA in five starts. He whiffed 24 in 29.2 innings and held opponents to a .257 batting average against. Biagini's father, Rob, also played minor league ball in the Giants organization in 1981 and 1982 with Great Falls (Rookie) and Fresno (A).

THE STARTING LINE: Today's starter Zack Dodson will try and continue what has been a solid start to the season for Curve starting pitching. On Thursday night, Angel Sanchez spun six shutout innings while allowing just three hits. On Friday, Jason Creasy (making his Double-A debut) twirled five innings of two-run ball (neither of the runs were earned) and allowed just four hits. Saturday night, Tyler Glasnow did not allow a run in five innings to run the starting pitcher's line to 16 innings pitched with zero earned runs allowed. RHP Chad Kuhl continued the success on Sunday, giving up one run in five innings with five strikeouts. It was the first earned run allowed by a Curve starter this season after 20.2 innings of not allowing an earned run.

KEEP ON KEEPING KEON: Centerfielder Keon Broxton is picking up right where he left off when he finished the 2014 season with the Curve on fire. Broxton is six for his first 15 this year (.400) and has a hit in each of the team's first four games (two doubles). He ended the 2014 season by clubbing .349 in 26 games during the month of August.

THIS HAS TO BE SOME KIND OF A RECORD: With his two scoreless innings in his Double-A debut on Saturday night, Curve reliever Jhondaniel Medina continued a pretty impressive streak. Entering 2015, the reliever had not allowed an earned run in his final 40.2 innings pitched with Bradenton in 2014. With two innings of scoreless relief, that streak is now at 42.2 IP. The last time he gave up an earned run was on April 30, 2014 versus Fort Myers.

SEASON OPENER NOTES: With the win on Thursday the Curve...are 7-10 overall on Opening Day...won their first Opening Day game since April 5, 2012 (7-4 vs. Erie)...grabbed their first Opening Day win on the road, breaking a previous 0-8 record when opening on the season on the road. Thursday night's starter Angel Sanchez also spun six shutout innings vs. Harrisburg, the most scoreless innings by a Curve starter in franchise history.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: Of the 25 players on the Curve's Opening Day roster, five of them are listed in the Pirates Top-30 prospects according to Baseball America. The five are: Tyler Glasnow (#1), Josh Bell (#4), Willy Garcia (#12), Stetson Allie (#21) and Chad Kuhl (#28). Of the five, three of them spent time in Curve, Pa. in 2014.

ALL HAIL THE PRINCE: The Curve have a new man to steer the ship in 2015 in manager Tom Prince. Prince, 50, embarks on his first season at the Double-A level as a skipper and is coming off leading the Bradenton Marauders to a playoff appearance and a second-half title in the Florida State League in 2014.

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS?: In three games so far with the pitch clocks in play, the Curve have played some very quick games. On Friday night, the game took 11 innings to complete but only took two hours and 55 minutes of actual time. On Saturday, the nine-inning affair took two hours and 27 minutes to play. Sunday afternoon was the team's longest nine-inning game so far, checking in at two hours and 39 minutes.

Josh Bell was named the Pirates Player of the Year after a stellar season with High-A Bradenton that saw him win the league's MVP award despite playing for Double-A Altoona the last month and a half of the season. RHP Tyler Glasnow was named the Pirates' Pitcher of the Year for a second straight season and was also named the Florida State League's Pitcher of the Year in 2014.
