**YESTERDAY:** The Curve received more solid starting pitching on Monday night in Richmond but a seven-run seventh inning by the Squirrels turned a pitcher's duel into a rout as the Curve fell, 10-3. Curve starter **Zack Dodson** tossed the ball well, dealing five innings of scoreless ball. Altoona had a chance to score in the third with the bases loaded and two out but Josh Bell flew out to left to end the inning. The game was scoreless until the seventh when Richmond's Mitch Delfino hit a solo homer off **Tyler Sample** (0-1) to open the inning. From there, 10 more hitters would bat and six more runs would be scored. Richmond added three more in the eighth off reliever **Jhondaniel Medina** to end his scoreless innings streak dating back to last April at 43.0 innings. **Gift Ngoepe** hit his first homer of the year in the loss.

**CURVE/SQUIRRELS SERIES:** Tonight marks the second of three games in this series and the second of 20 games between the Curve and Squirrels this season. Each team will host 10 games in the series and after this series the Curve will not return to Richmond until immediately following the All-Star break.

**FOR ALTOONA:** The ball on Tuesday night will go to Opening Day starter **Angel Sanchez** as the Curve look to level the series at a game apiece. Sanchez pitched well in his first start of the 2015 season on Opening Day in Harrisburg. The righty out of Tenares, D.R. did not allow a hit until the fifth and went a total of six scoreless innings to set the tone for starting pitching so far this season. Pittsburgh is the fifth organization that Sanchez has been a part of in his career and the fourth in the last two seasons as he ended the 2014 season in a Curve uniform. He had a successful stint in the Arizona Fall League with Scottsdale in the offseason, posting a 2.26 ERA in eight games out of the bullpen. *For more on Sanchez, see page two.*

**FOR RICHMOND:** Richmond will give the ball to its Opening Day starter Chris Stratton on Tuesday night, bumping them out of a scheduled six-man starting rotation due to the fact they played a pair of 14-inning games in the season's first three contests. Stratton took a no decision on Opening Night versus the Baysox, giving up two runs on five hits in five innings. Stratton, 24, was the Giants' first-round selection (20th overall) in the 2011 draft out of Mississippi State and spent most of last season in Adv.-A San Jose. In five starts at the end of the season for Richmond, Stratton was 1-1 with a 3.52 ERA.

**THE STARTING LINE:** The first time through the starting rotation for the Altoona Curve has been a successful one, with the five hurlers combining to allow three total runs (one earned run) in 26 innings. That's good for an ERA of 0.35 heading into tonight's game. Tonight's starter, **Angel Sanchez**, got the ball rolling on this streak with six shutout innings in the season opener on Thursday in Harrisburg.

**CORNERING THE MARKET:** Both first baseman **Josh Bell** and third baseman **Eric Wood** have reached base safely in each of the team's first five games this season. Bell walked four times the first two games of the year before having hits, including an RBI single on Monday, in each of his last three games. Wood, who is in his first crack at Double-A, hit safely in each of the first four games before drawing a walk in the series-opening loss to Richmond.

**PASSING THE BAR:** Curve reliever **Jhonthan Barrios** has converted on each of his first two save opportunities so far in 2015 and could be one of the folks that closes games for Curve in 2015 on a regular basis. The 2014 Curve struggled with finding a closer early on in the season before the role was bestowed upon Kenn Kasperek after he was re-assigned back to Altoona in mid-June. The 2014 Curve only converted on 32 save opportunities while blowing 26 of them.

**SWITCHING IT UP:** Curve shortstop **Gift Ngoepe** had been a switch hitter his entire minor league career but will now bat exclusively from the right side in 2015. Ngoepe, who hit his first homer of the season on Monday, actually hit better left-handed in 2014 (.249) than righty (.220) but hit six of his nine home runs from the right side.

**I GOT FIVE ON IT:** Of the 25 players on the Curve's Opening Day roster, five of them are listed in the Pirates Top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. The five are: **Tyler Glasnow** (#1), **Josh Bell** (#4), **Willy Garcia** (#12), **Stetson Allie** (#21) and **Chad Kuhl** (#28). Of the five, three of them spent time in Curve, Pa. in 2014.

**ALL HAIL THE PRINCE:** The Curve have a new man to steer the ship in 2015 in manager **Tom Prince**. Prince, 50, embarks on his first season at the Double-A level as a skipper and is coming off leading the Bradenton Marauders to a playoff appearance and a second-half title in the Florida State League in 2014.

**SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS?:** In three games so far with the pitch clocks in play, the Curve have played some very quick games. On Friday night, the game took 11 innings to complete but only took two hours and 55 minutes of actual time. On Saturday, the nine-inning affair took two hours and 27 minutes to play. Sunday afternoon was the team's longest nine-inning game so far, checking in at two hours and 39 minutes. The clocks were not active on Monday night in Richmond and the team played its longest game of the season at three hours and 12 minutes.
