YESTERDAY: The Curve offense found just what it was looking for in Erie, busting out to the tune of 12 runs on 16 hits en route to a, 12-3, rout of Erie. The big inning came in the seventh when the Curve batted around and sent a total of 10 men to the plate while scoring six runs. **Keon Broxton** delivered the biggest blow of the inning with a grand slam off Slade Smith that solidified the flood gates were open. Broxton also had two RBI earlier in the game and drove in six of the team's 12 runs. Not to be lost were three hit days by **Stetson Allie**, **Josh Bell** and **Sebastian Valle** plus another solid effort from the starting pitching. **Chad Kuhl** (2-0) worked six innings and gave up only one run for his second win.

CURVE/SEAWOLVES SERIES: The Curve face the SeaWolves for the second of three matchups in a season-series that will see the two clubs meet a total of 20 times in 2015. Last season, Erie won the season series 15-7, which included an 8-3 mark here at The Uht.

FOR ALTOONA: On the bump tonight in Erie for the first time will be RHP **Tyler Glasnow**, who would have started Wednesday night's finale with Harrisburg had it not been rained out. Glasnow, 21, hasn't pitched since April 17 when he beat the Akron RubberDucks for his first win in Double-A. In that start, Glasnow fanned seven without walking a batter while surrendering one run on four hits in six innings for his first quality start of the season. Glasnow entered this season as the Pirates top overall prospect according to both *Baseball America* and *MLB.com*. For more on Glasnow, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Erie sends its prospect pitcher to the hill Saturday evening in Austin Kubitzka. Kubitzka, who checks in as the eighth-best prospect in the Tigers system according to *Baseball America*, is making his third start of the season for the Howlers after a solid campaign in 2014 with the West Michigan Whitecaps. The 23-year-old was a fourth-round pick out of Rice in the 2013 draft by Detroit and went 10-2 with a 2.34 ERA while dominating the Midwest League. He was a member of the Midwest League mid-season All-Star Squad and was a two-time Pitcher of the Week selection last season while also picking up the organizational Minor League Pitcher of the Year award.

THE STARTING LINE: The Curve starters are on fire to start the 2015 season, allowing five earned runs in 70 innings so far (seven total runs). That's good for an ERA of 0.64 heading into tonight's game. Monday night's starter, **Angel Sanchez**, had a 13.1-inning scoreless streak until giving up a home run to Mario Lisson in the second inning. It is a team-high for the season, with Sunday afternoon's starter (and winner) **Zack Dodson** holding a streak of 12 scoreless innings across two starts and one relief outing. Tuesday night's regularly-scheduled starter **Jason Creasy** allowed one run in six innings for his first win of 2015. No Curve starer has allowed more than two runs overall in a start this year through 13 starts.

INSTANT OFFENSE: The Curve as a team were hitting .216 coming into this series with the Erie SeaWolves, which was last in the 12-team E.L. On Friday, the team rattled off a season best 12 runs on 16 hits and raised the team batting average nearly 20 points (from .216 to .233). In the process they re-wrote pretty much every offensive season-high so far this season with the high-octane output.

FAST FIVE: With two hits yesterday, **Max Moroff** will ride a season-best, five-game hit streak into today's game with Erie. Also joining him on the five-game hit streak train is **Stetson Allie**, who has hit safely in his last five contests to the tune of a .421 clip (8-for-19). Allie has three doubles, five RBI and three runs scored during the streak. So far in 2015, no Curve player has hit safely in six straight games.

THE ALTOONA GRAND SLAM: Centerfielder **Keon Broxton** clubbed his third career grand slam in the, 12-3, drubbing of Erie on Friday night at Jerry Uht Park. It was the first home run of the season for Broxton, who hit 15 a year ago in 127 games for the Curve. He also doubled in two other runs and matched a career-high in RBI, which he set in 2010 with South Bend, with six. Strangely enough, the grand slam also came nearly a year to the day of the last Curve grand slam as **Stetson Allie** hit one on April 23, 2014 versus Harrisburg at Peoples Natural Gas Field.

ROSTER MOVES: OF **Jonathan Schwind** has been placed on Altoona DL (internal injury) after Friday night's collision in the seventh inning.

VAMOS VALLE: Catcher **Sebastian Valle** smashed the team's first home run at home in the win during Tuesday night's regularly-scheduled game with Harrisburg. As a team, the Curve are tied for the fewest home runs hit in the E.L. heading into action today with four. That's in large contrast to the 2014 Curve, who finished the season leading the league in home runs with 124 home runs with very similar players (Allie, Broxton, Garcia and Vasquez) all had double-digit home run totals at the end of 2014).

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: With Tuesday night's, 2-1, victory over the Senators, the Curve have now won five one-run games already in 2015 (which is over 70% of the total team wins). By comparison, the 2014 Curve went 21-38 in one-run games a year ago.

STARTING BLOCKS: The 8-5 start through 13 games for the Curve is the best for the team since the 2010 season, when they were 10-3...That year the team also opened with, and beat, Harrisburg by the score of 1-0 but did it at home.

MAD MAX: **Max Moroff** broke out in a big way on Saturday night in the loss to Akron, tying a career-high and going 4-for-5 at the plate while driving in the team's only run. Moroff only had two prior hits in seven games heading into action on Saturday night. It was also the Curve's first four-hit game of the season for any single player. In his last five games, Moroff is hitting .524 (11-for-21) with three doubles, one triple and one RBI.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: Of the 25 players on the Curve roster, five of them are listed in the Pirates Top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. The five are: **Tyler Glasnow** (#1), **Josh Bell** (#4), **Willy Garcia** (#12), **Stetson Allie** (#21) and **Chad Kuhl** (#28). Of the five, three of them spent time in Curve, Pa. in 2014.
