**YESTERDAY:** Zack Dodson left in line for his second win with six more innings of scoreless ball but the Curve wound up losing the game in 14 innings, 5-4. Akron tied the game off Collin Balester in the ninth before the Curve reclaimed the lead with three unearned runs in the top of the 14th inning. In the bottom half of the 14th, Akron rallied for four runs and won on a walk-off hit batter by Tyler Sample with the bases loaded. Tom Harlan (2-1), who had thrown in excess of 50 pitches in three innings of relief already, was saddled with the loss as he was charged with all four runs in the 14th inning. Josh Bell had three more hits and Max Moroff ran his streaks up a game to nine games (hitting) and 15 games (on-base), respectively.

**CURVE/DUCKS SERIES:** The Curve and RubberDucks continue the season series today with the Curve having won four of the series' first six games. Altoona only needs two more wins to match its win total versus Akron from 2014 of six (Ducks won series 14-6).

**FOR ALTOONA:** Looking to lead Altoona to a series victory on Wednesday afternoon will be RHP Chad Kuhl, who started this road trip off with a win in Erie on Friday. Kuhl, 22, turned in his first Double-A quality start in the win over Erie at hitter-friendly Jerry Uht Park. Kuhl permitted one run on five hits in six innings while fanning two. This will be his second start of the year versus Akron after taking a no-decision against the Ducks at home on April 18. Kuhl entered the season ranked as the 28th-best prospect in the system according to Baseball America and led the Pirates' farm system in wins in 2014. For more on Kuhl, see page two.

**FOR AKRON:** LHP Ryan Merritt faces the Curve for a second time this year after giving up a season-high six runs on 10 hits to the Curve in his start at Peoples Natural Gas Field on April 19. Merritt was solid in the early goings of that outing, allowing two first inning runs before the Curve got him for one more in the sixth and a few more in the seventh. He rebounded in his most recent start with 7.2 innings of shutout ball versus Bowie here at Canal Park on April 24. In his two home starts this year, Merritt is 1-0 with a 1.84 ERA to go along with 14 strikeouts in 14.2 innings pitched.

**THE STARTING LINE:** The Curve starters are on fire to start the 2015 season, allowing 10 earned runs in 93.1 innings so far (12 total runs). That's good for an ERA of 0.96 heading into today's game. Sunday afternoon's starter, Angel Sanchez, tossed 6.2 innings of scoreless ball and has given up one earned run in four starts (22.2 IP). Tuesday night's starter Zack Dodson is riding an 18-inning scoreless streak after six shutout yesterday. That is a team-best in 2015.

**INSTANT OFFENSE:** The Curve as a team were hitting .216 going into the weekend series with the Erie SeaWolves, which was last in the 12-team E.L. On Friday, the team rattled off a season best 12 runs on 16 hits and raised the team batting average nearly 20 points (from .216 to .233). In the process they re-wrote pretty much every offensive season-high so far this season with the high-octane output. On Saturday, they pounded out four runs on nine hits with a pair of home runs. It was more of the same on Sunday with eight runs on 12 hits. The hot bats continued even after a change of venue with the Curve exploding for nine runs on 15 hits on Monday night and then 11 more hits on Tuesday. They're hitting .318 on this road trip and have brought the team batting average up to .250.

**DON'T YOU STEAL MY SUNSHINE:** The Curve improved to 5-0 in day games this year (games that start before 5 p.m.) with the victories over Erie on Saturday and Sunday. In day games this year, the team is hitting .268, which is better than 20 points higher than their batting average in night games (.243). The team also owns an unreal 0.80 ERA in the five day games they've played so far.

**RING THE BELL:** First baseman Josh Bell rattled off his first four-hit game of the 2015 season (and the team's second) in the win on Monday night before grabbing three more hits on Tuesday night. Entering play today, Bell is hitting .343 with seven multi hit games (trails Keon Broxton for team lead by one).

**KEON ♥ AKRON:** Centerfielder Keon Broxton is 4-for-11 in this series with two doubles and an RBI. This is the second year that Broxton has played in Altoona and he seems to have a knack for good games against the RubberDucks. In 19 games against Akron in 2014, Broxton hit a whopping .415 (22-for-53) with four doubles, two triples, six home runs, 12 RBI and 14 runs scored. More specifically, 10 of those games he played in were here at Canal Park and in those games he batted .429 (12-for-28) with one double, one triple, five home runs 10 RBI and nine runs scored. In his career versus Akron with the Curve (including this season) Broxton has a batting average of .390 (32-for-82) with six doubles, two triples, six home runs, 14 RBI and 18 runs scored.

**MAD MAX:** Second baseman Max Moroff was named the league's Player of the Week today for the week ending April 26. It is the first Player of the Week award for any Curve player this season and the first in the pro career of Moroff. He batted .474 last week in five games with four doubles, one triple, one home run and four RBI. His 2-for-6 day on Tuesday extended his career-best hitting streak to nine games and his on-base streak to 15 games. During the streak Moroff is hitting .447 (17-for-38) with five doubles, one triple, one homer and three RBI.

**V FOR VALLE:** Catcher Sebastian Valle had a terrific series in Erie over the weekend as he went 6-for-9 in the series with two RBI and a run scored. He's followed it up here in Akron with hits in each of the series' first two games to run his hitting streak to seven games.

**THOU SHALL NOT PASS:** Left fielder Willy Garcia continues to show off his impressive cannon in left field as he registered one outfield assist in each of the three games of the Erie series to give him six total on the season. For comparison, he set the franchise record last season with 19 assists in 126 games.

**STARTING BLOCKS:** The 11-5 start through 16 games for the Curve matched the start of the 2010 season team that went on the EL Championship, when they were 11-5.
