WEDNESDAY: For a second straight day the Curve were unable to hold the lead in the ninth but, unlike on Tuesday, they were able to prevail in extras with a, 6-5, win. Akron scored three times in the ninth inning off **John Kuchno** (1-2) to tie the game before the Curve scored the go-ahead and deciding run in the 10th. **Max Moroff** walked with one out in the 10th, went first-to-third on a ball hit to left field by **Josh Bell**, and scored on a wild pitch during Willy Garcia's at bat. Kuchno recorded the final three outs in the 10th to clinch the series victory. **Chad Kuhl** tossed six innings and allowed two runs while leaving in line for a win. Both Bell and Garcia registered multi-hit games.

CURVE/SEAWOLVES SERIES: Erie makes the first of its three trips to Curve, Pa. this weekend a week after the Curve swept the SeaWolves at Jerry Uht Park. In those three games, the Curve averaged eight runs a game and hit .336 with 13 extra-base hits (eight doubles, two triples and three home runs).

FOR ALTOONA: On the hill tonight for the Curve is RHP **Tyler Glasnow**, who is making his second home start and fourth overall start of the season. It'll be a second straight start for Glasnow against Erie as he faced them on Saturday at The Uht. In that start, Glasnow gave up one run on five hits in 5.2 innings before being removed in the sixth with 87 pitches to his name. The top prospect in the Pirates organization has given up two runs in 16.2 innings to start the season and averaged just better than a strikeout per inning (17 K in 16.2 IP). *For more on Glasnow, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: In a true rematch, Erie also sends its starter from last Saturday in Austin Kubitzka back to the hill tonight in the series opener. Kubitzka was very sharp on Saturday, striking out seven in six innings and allowing one unearned run on three hits in the no decision. He entered 2015 as the eighth-best prospect in the Tigers' system according to *Baseball America* after a terrific first full year in West Michigan in 2014. Kubitzka was drafted in the fourth round of the 2013 draft by Detroit out of Rice University.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR: The Curve nearly completed a perfect road trip as they went 5-1 over the six games and were within an out on a few different occasions of making it perfect trip. The Curve hit .301 as a team across the six games and averaged better than seven runs scored per game. On the mound, the club had an ERA slightly over three at 3.02 for the six games with opponents batting .238.

HOME IS WHENEVER I'M WITH YOU: Tonight's series opener with Erie marks the first game of a seven-game homestand and the first of 17 games that the team will play at home in the month of May. Over the next two weeks, the Curve will play 14-of-17 games at Peoples Natural Gas Field.

FIRST OF DA MONTH: Altoona went 12-6 in the first month of the season with two games being postponed due to rain. The 12 wins are tied for the third-highest total for the month of April in team history. The 2006 Curve went 15-8 in the season's first month en route to a playoff appearance while the 2010 Curve opened the year 14-6. Of the four prior times the Curve have opened up with 12 or more wins in the first month, the team made the playoffs in three of the seasons.

THE STARTING LINE: The Curve starters are on fire to start the 2015 season, allowing 12 earned runs in 99.1 innings so far (14 total runs). That's good for an ERA of 1.09 heading into today's game. Sunday afternoon's starter, **Angel Sanchez**, tossed 6.2 innings of scoreless ball and has given up one earned run in four starts (22.2 IP). Tuesday night's starter **Zack Dodson** is riding an 18-inning scoreless streak after six shutout yesterday. That is a team-best in 2015.

INSTANT OFFENSE: The Curve as a team were hitting .216 going into most recent road trip, which was last in the 12-team E.L. They went on to hit .301 in the six games while hitting even better with runners in scoring position, batting for a .338 clip (25-for-74) during the six games. During the trip, the Curve raise their team batting average to its current spot at .248.

DON'T YOU STEAL MY SUNSHINE: The Curve improved to 6-0 in day games this year (games that start before 5 p.m.) with the victory on Wednesday in Akron. The team's next day games are this Sunday (1 p.m. vs. Erie) and next Thursday (10:30 a.m. vs. Richmond).

RING THE BELL: First baseman **Josh Bell** rattled off his first four-hit game of the 2015 season (and the team's second) in the win on Monday night before grabbing three more hits on Tuesday night. All told, Bell registered nine hits in the Akron series (9-for-16) with a triple, two RBI and four runs scored. He enters today hitting .352, which is third-best in the Eastern League (Noel Cuevas of New Britain leads the league at .367).

MAD MAX: Second baseman **Max Moroff** was named the league's Player of the Week for the week ending April 26. It is the first Player of the Week award for any Curve player this season and the first in the pro career of Moroff. He batted .474 last week in five games with four doubles, one triple, one home run and four RBI. Moroff did not extend his hitting streak on Wednesday but did keep his on-base streak alive with his walk that proved crucial in the top of the 10th inning. In his 16-game on-base streak, Moroff is hitting .311 with five doubles, one triple, one home run and 12 runs scored.

V FOR VALLE: Catcher **Sebastian Valle** had terrific road trip for the Curve and is currently riding a seven-game hit streak into tonight's series opener with Erie. On the trip, Valle hit a team-best .471 (8-for-17) with a double, four runs scored and four RBI.
