YESTERDAY: The Curve kept to their winning ways against teams not named Richmond by taking the series from Harrisburg with a, 7-4, win in the rubber match yesterday afternoon. Starter Zack Dodson was gifted an early lead but only ended up finishing four innings in a no decision. Each time Harrisburg was able to pull within one or tie the game the Curve offense went right back to work. They went ahead for good in the fifth when Josh Bell drove in his second run of the game with a sac fly. Altoona added two more in the ninth for insurance as Yhonathan Barrios closed the door for his sixth save in as many tries. Tom Harlan (3-1) picked up the win in relief as the Curve bullpen spun a total of five scoreless innings (3 H, 1 BB, 4 K).

CURVE/BAYSOX SERIES: This will be the first of four series between the two clubs in 2015 with two apiece taking place in Curve, Pa. and Bowie. Last year, the Curve went 11-8 in games played against Baltimore's Double-A affiliate, including a 4-3 mark here at PNG Field.

FOR ALTOONA: To the hill tonight for the Curve goes RHP Chad Kuhl, who searches for his third win of the season. Last time out, Kuhl faced the pesky Richmond Flying Squirrels and was the victim of some defensive lapses that led to six runs (three earned) in six innings. He's been solid here at home, posting a 2.45 ERA In two starts here but both of his wins so far in 2015 have come away from PNG Field. Kuhl entered the season as the 28th-best prospect in the Pirates system according to Baseball America. For more on Kuhl, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Bowie sends a seasoned Double-A lefty in Tim Berry in the series opener tonight. Berry, 24, spent all of last season in Bowie with the Baysox to make 23 starts. He had a 6-7 record and 3.51 ERA in those 23 starts and was selected to the league's mid-season All-Star team. He went on to be even better after the break, going 2-2 with a 2.15 ERA in five starts. The San Diego, Calif. native has progressed pretty high in Baltimore's system after being a 50thround pick in the 2009 draft out of San Marcos (Calif.) HS.

THE IMPORTANCE OF A QUICK FIRST STEP: In each of the last five Curve losses, the Curve opponent has scored the first run of the game. Overall this year when they don't score first, the club is 2-7. After scoring in the top of the first inning on Sunday, The Curve are now 15-4 when plating the first run of a game.

FRENEMIES: The Baysox roll into Curve. Pa. with a pair of former Curve players on the active roster in RHP Kenn Kasparek and OF Quincy Latimore. Kasparek suited up for the Curve in each of the last two seasons while serving as the team's primary closer in 2014. Latimore first came to Curve, Pa. in 2011 and hit 15 home runs for the P.J. Forbes led Curve. He hit 15 more in 2012, which was his last season in a Curve uniform. This is the third different time that Latimore has visited Altoona from the third-base dugout since leaving the Pirates system. He's returned as a member of the Akron Aeros and Harrisburg Senators over the last two seasons.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS?: Shortstop Gift Ngoepe is enjoying the turnover of the calendar to the month of May. In nine games played this month, the South Africa native is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with two doubles and 10 runs scored with an on-base percentage of .471. He's hit in three straight games (all multi-hit) and has multi-hit games in five of his last six games played. During the stretch, he's brought his average up from .174 to its current spot at .245.

IN YHONATHAN WE TRUST: Righty Yhonathan Barrios closed out his sixth save of the season on Sunday afternoon in Harrisburg and is a perfect 6-for-6 in save tries so far in 2015. Opponents are hitting .182 off Barrios in his nine games so far this season and he has yet to allow a run in 9.2 total innings pitched. Last season, Kenn Kasparek (who is here with visiting Bowie) led the team in saves with 13.

MAGNIFICENT MEDINA: Reliever Jhondaniel Medina tossed two scoreless in the win on Sunday afternoon over Harrisburg. He's allowed runs in just one appearance this season and if you date that all the way back to May 1st of last season, Medina has only allowed runs in three appearances of his 37 appearances.

MAD MAX: Second baseman Max Moroff was named the league's Player of the Week for the week ending April 26. It was the first Player of the Week award for any Curve player this season and the first in the pro career of Moroff. He batted .474 during the week in five games with four doubles, one triple, one home run and four RBI. The Florida native had two more hits on Sunday to extend his on-base streak to 26 games. Moroff has hit safely in a team-best 10 straight games (six-straight multi-hit games) and in 19 of his last 20 contests. His 26-game on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. During the streak, the Florida native is hitting .369 with 11 extra-base hits and 18 runs scored. In the 10-game hitting streak, Moroff is batting .452 (19-for-42).

DON'T YOU STEAL MY SUNSHINE: Altoona avenged its first day game (start time before 5 p.m.) loss on Thursday vs. Richmond with a win on Sunday afternoon in Harrisburg. The team is now 8-1 in sunny hours games in 2015 and 6-0 on the road.

THE STARTING LINE: After an out-of-this-world start, Curve starters have still pitched well recently allowing 34 earned runs in 153.2 innings so far (42 total runs). That's good for an ERA of 1.99 heading into today's game.

NEW FACES, DIFFERENT PLACES: The Curve will now begin a long stretch of the season where most of their opponents will be new faces in 2015. Aside from Akron coming in this weekend four a four-game set, the Curve will play four new opponents in Bowie, Portland, New Hampshire and New Britain before coming back home again to close out May with another new opponent, the B-Mets.
