**YESTERDAY:** For a second straight night the Curve were able to overcome an early deficit, this time coming back from a 1-0 hole after half an inning to down Bowie, 6-4. Altoona tied it with an RBI groundout from **Josh Bell** in the bottom of the first before taking the lead for good on an **Eric Wood** two-out double in the second. **Stetson Allie** homered in the fourth, a solo shot, before a pair of runs came across in the fifth to open up the game and make it, 5-1. Bowie closed the gap with two runs charged to **Angel Sanchez** (3-1) in the sixth. They'd add another in the eighth to pull within one before a big triple by **Gift Ngoepe** gave the Curve a two-run cushion. **Max Moroff** was 0-for-3 in the game but did draw two walks to run his on-base streak to 28 games. Collin Balester picked up his fourth save of the season.

**CURVE/BAYSOX SERIES:** This will be the first of four series between the two clubs in 2015 with two apiece taking place in Curve, Pa. and Bowie. Last year, the Curve went 11-8 in games played against Baltimore's Double-A affiliate, including a 4-3 mark here at PNG Field.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Lefty **Tom Harlan** will return to the mound in a starting capacity for the Curve on Wednesday morning as he gets the spot start with the odd spot up in the rotation with Tyler Glasnow on the mend from a right ankle sprain last week. Harlan made 10 starts for the Curve last year after being called up from Bradenton and was extremely effective. This season, the Fresno State product has been used exclusively out of the bullpen and last pitched on Sunday with two scoreless innings. The San Bruno, Calif. native made three starts against the Baysox last year and was 1-1. *For more on Harlan, see page two.*

**FOR BOWIE:** RHP Parker Bridwell goes for the Baysox on Wednesday morning as they look to avoid being swept. Bridwell, a ninth-round selection out of Hereford (Texas) HS in 2010, is in his first season in Bowie after spending all of 2014 with Adv.-A Frederick in the Carolina League. In 26 starts last year, Bridwell was 7-10 and boasted a 4.45 ERA with 142 strikeouts in 141.2 innings pitched. He went seven innings in his last start in Richmond on Friday night, giving up four runs (three earned) while whiffing eight Flying Squirrels hitters. He's been far better on the road (1-1, 3.00ERA in three starts) than at home (0-0, 8.18 ERA in three starts).

**NOTHING FOR CHICKS TO DIG:** Chicks dig the long ball is how the saying goes but the Curve pitching staff has been keeping the ball in the ballpark at a pretty solid rate in 30 games so far in 2015. The pitching staff has allowed just seven home runs all season in 273.2 IP. That is the fewest home run total for a staff in not only the Eastern League but in any league Double-A or higher. Only three teams have allowed fewer home runs than the Curve staff this season and all are in either Advanced-A or Class-A. The Palm Beach Cardinals (Adv.-A, FSL) have allowed one home run this season while the Daytona Cubs (Adv.-A, FSL) have given up six. In the Midwest League, South Bend has given up four homers.

**MAD MAX:** Second baseman **Max Moroff** was named the league's Player of the Week for the week ending April 26. It was the first Player of the Week award for any Curve player this season and the first in the pro career of Moroff. He batted .474 during the week in five games with four doubles, one triple, one home run and four RBI. The Florida native walked twice on Tuesday to run his on-base streak to 28 games, which is five shy of the franchise record set by Ronny Paulino back in 2004. Moroff did have his career-high, 11-game hit streak come to a close on Tuesday. Despite that, he's still hit in 20 of his last 22 games and has multi-hit games in six of his last eight. His 28-game on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. During the streak, the Florida native is hitting .351 with 11 extra-base hits and 19 runs scored.

**DON'T YOU STEAL MY SUNSHINE:** Altoona avenged its first day game (start time before 5 p.m.) loss on Thursday vs. Richmond with a win on Sunday afternoon in Harrisburg. The team is now 8-1 in sunny hours games in 2015 and 6-0 on the road.

**FRENEMIES:** The Baysox roll into Curve, Pa. with a pair of former Curve players on the active roster in RHP Kenn Kasperek and OF Quincy Latimore. Kasperek suited up for the Curve in each of the last two seasons while serving as the team's primary closer in 2014. Latimore first came to Curve, Pa. in 2011 and hit 15 home runs for the P.J. Forbes led Curve. He hit 15 more in 2012, which was his last season in a Curve uniform. This is the third different time that Latimore has visited Altoona from the third-base dugout since leaving the Pirates system. He's returned as a member of the Akron Aeros and Harrisburg Senators over the last two seasons.

**APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS?:** Shortstop **Gift Ngoepe** is enjoying the turnover of the calendar to the month of May. In 11 games played this month, the South Africa native is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with two doubles, one triple and 11 runs scored with an on-base percentage of .476.

**IN YHONATHAN WE TRUST:** Righty **Yhonathan Barrios** closed out his seventh save of the season on Monday night and is a perfect 7-for-7 in save tries so far in 2015. Opponents are hitting .189 off Barrios in his 10 games so far this season and he has yet to allow a run in 10.2 total innings pitched. Last season, Kenn Kasperek (who is here with visiting Bowie) led the team in saves with 13.

**MAGNIFICENT MEDINA:** Reliever **Jhondaniel Medina** tossed two scoreless in the win on Sunday afternoon over Harrisburg.
