 $\textbf{YESTERDAY:} \ Altoona's \ of fense \ came \ alive \ and \ scored \ 11 \ runs \ on \ 17 \ hits \ to \ rout \ the \ Fisher \ Cats, \ 11-3, \ on \ Sunday \ night$ in Manchester. Josh Bell (4-for-5) and Keon Broxton (3-for-4) helped lead the offense with Bell driving in four runs in addition to his four hits. Gift Ngoepe (3-for-5) also chipped in with three hits. On the mound, Angel Sanchez (4-1) dealt eight innings of two-run ball to tie a career high in innings pitched for the righty. The 17 hits by the Curve offense were a new season-high as everyone in the lineup had at least one hit.

CURVE/FISHER CATS SERIES: The two teams renew their season series this weekend four a four-game series here at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium. This series last year was a highly flammable one, especially here, with the two teams being involved in a benches-clearing brawl that resulted in countless suspensions and fines for both sides. New Hampshire won the season series last year, 5-1.

FOR ALTOONA: Going to the hill on Monday afternoon seeking to guide the Curve to the split will be RHP Jason Creasy, who picked up the win in his last start in Portland. Creasy, 23, has continued his early-season success into the month of May, going 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts this month after going 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA in four starts in April. He's lasted at least five innings in all eight of his starts and tossed seven innings in his most recent win over Portland on May 20. All told, he's given up two runs or fewer in five of eight starts this year. For more on Creasy, see page two.

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: RHP Taylor Cole makes the start in the series finale on Monday afternoon for the Fisher Cats as he looks to give them the series win. Cole, 25, pitched most of last season with Dunedin of the Florida State Leaguewhere he went 8-9 in 24 games (23 starts) with a 3.07 ERA. He made two brief appearances here in New Hampshire in early August and didn't fare very well, going 0-2 with a 7.30 ERA (11 R, 10 ER in 12.1 IP). This year, Cole had a bumpy few starts to the year but has come around as of late. After going 0-2 with a 6.52 ERA in four April starts, Cole is 2-1 this month with a 3.05 ERA in four starts. Last time out, Cole gave up one run in five innings at Reading on May 19.

THE ROAD: The Curve are in the midst of a stretch where they play 20 of 29 games on the road with 10 of them coming on this 11-day trek to Portland, Manchester and New Britain. They'll return home after this road trip for six games before heading right back out for another six-game road trip. So far, the team is 2-4.

THE SOUND OF SUNSHINE: The Curve wrap up today's game in Manchester with a day game and look to continue their solid play during sunny hours games. In 11 games this year under the sun, the team is 9-2, which includes a 6-0 mark away from PNG Field. The team ERA in day games this year is 2.97. Offensively, **Josh Bell** has raked during day games, batting .382 (13-for-34) with four extra base hits and seven RBI in 10 games.

180-DEGREE TURN: After April was such a terrific month for Curve pitching (2.32 ERA), May has been a different story. This month, the Curve have a team ERA of 4.06, which is fourth-highest among any team in the league this month.They've permitted 106 runs (93 earned) in 206 innings and given up 11 home runs in 23 games. By comparison, the team gave up just 53 runs (43 earned) and three home runs in 18 games during April.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman Josh Bell collected a season-high tying four hits on Sunday night and has now hit in six straight games. Bell owns a .338 average, which is second-best in the Eastern League while leading the league in hits with 51. He also ranks among the league leaders in triples (5, T-1st) and on-base percentage (.412). He's also got the second-lowest strikeout rate in the league behind Tony Renda of Harrisburg at one strikeout every 12.79 plate appearances.

EASTERN OVEREXPOSURE: The Curve's first few series against the Eastern Division have not gone well with the team going 2-4 through the first six games. Over the last three games, the Curve have struck out 30 times in 27 innings at the plate. On the flip side of the coin, the team ERA against the East teams thus far is 5.22 in the small sample size. HOMECOMING: IF Dan Gamache had hits in all three games in the Portland series and two hits in each of the games he has played in this series. The trip to the upper northeast is the first with the Curve for Gamache, who just missed out on last year's trek up while he was recovering from a Spring Training injury. Gamache, a native of Newport, R.I. will get to play in front of some family and friends throughout the duration of this trip. It couldn't have come at a better time for the Auburn Tiger as he's riding an 11-game hit streak with five of the 11 games being multi-hit games. In 16 games total this month, he's hitting .354 (17-for-48) with five doubles, one home run, nine runs scored and eight RBI. During his 11game hitting streak, Gamache is hitting ..444 (16-for-36).

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS: Shortstop Gift Ngoepe is enjoying the turnover of the calendar to the month of May. In 22 games played this month, the South Africa native is hitting .356 (26-for-73) with four doubles, two triples, one home run, six RBI and 16 runs scored with an on-base percentage of .440. In 18 games during April, Ngoepe hit .172 with an OBP of .232.

SAVE THE LAST DANCE: Righty Yhonathan Barrios closed out his ninth save of the season on Wednesday night and is a perfect 9-for-9 in save tries so far in 2015. Opponents are hitting .196 off Barrios in his 14 games so far this season and he did not allow a run in his first 13.0 total innings pitched. Last season, Kenn Kasparek led the team in saves with 13.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Tyler Glasnow was placed on the Altoona DL after Wednesday night's game with a right ankle sprain. The move was retroactive to May 18, the day after he started in Curve, Pa. Taking his spot on the roster and in the rotation will be RHP Matt Benedict, who was received from Triple-A Indianapolis.
