YESTERDAY: The Curve were swept by the last-place Richmond Flying Squirrels as Richmond took the final game of the series, 4-2. The Squirrels scored first in the first but the Curve did lead for the first time in the series after **Stetson Allie** mashed his third home run of the season (a two-run shot). The lead was short lived, however, as Richmond scored once in the third off starter **Angel Sanchez** (2-1) before Javier Herrera hit a two-run homer of his own in the fourth to put the game away. Matt Lujan (1-2) picked up his first Double-A win for Richmond. **Jacob Stallings** was 2-for-2 and reached base four times in the loss while Max Moroff ran his on-base streak to 23 games.

CURVE/SENATORS SERIES: This weekend's three-game set is the second of three trips the Curve make to Harrisburg this season and is the third time these two teams have met already in 2015. It's been a dead-even series so far with each team taking three games of the six played so far. During the first series of the season, the Curve and 'Sens split the series here at Metro Bank Park.

FOR ALTOONA: Pirates RHP **Charlie Morton** will make the rehab start for the Curve tonight in Harrisburg. Morton, 31, is on his road back from surgery to his right hip that he had done last September. Morton did pitch for the Pirates in Spring Training this year, going 1-2 with an 8.47 ERA in five games (four starts) spanning 17 innings. Morton last threw a 93-pitch sim game in Bradenton on May 3. With his rehab start tonight, Morton has now pitched for the Curve on a rehab assignment at least once in each of the last three seasons (2013-2015). *For more on Morton, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Altoona faces Brian Rauh for the first time on Friday night in Harrisburg after seeing four of the five Senators starters in the opening series here in Harrisburg. Rauh, an 11th-round pick in the 2012 draft out of Chapman University (Calif.), actually began this season in Adv.-A Potomac and was flat-out dominant with a 0.51 ERA in three starts. He whiffed 13 in 17 innings on the hill with Potomac before getting the bump here to Harrisburg. It's actually his second stint in a 'Sens uniform after making one relief appearance for Harrisburg back in 2013. Last year, he only made 17 appearances (12 starts) for Potomac as he was on the shelf for nearly two months with an injury.

TROUBLE WITH THE SQUIRRELS: The Curve are mighty glad to see Richmond get out of town as of the team's 10 losses in 2015, five of them have been at the hands of those pesky Squirrels. In the six games versus Richmond this year, the team has hit .192 with eight extra-base hits (six doubles and two home runs). The two teams will not meet again until after the All-Star break.

THE IMPORTANCE OF A QUICK FIRST STEP: In the four losses to the Richmond Flying Squirrels, the Curve did not score first in any of the four games. Overall this year when they don't score first, the club is 2-6. When they do get out to a fast start, the Curve are 13-4.

MAD MAX: Second baseman **Max Moroff** was named the league's Player of the Week for the week ending April 26. It was the first Player of the Week award for any Curve player this season and the first in the pro career of Moroff. He batted .474 during the week in five games with four doubles, one triple, one home run and four RBI. The Florida native went 2-for-4 on Thursday to extend his on-base streak to 23 games. During the streak, he's batting .352 with seven doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBI and 14 runs scored. Even more impressive, Moroff has hit safely in seven straight games and in 16 of his last 17 contests. His 23-game on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League.

FOR WHOM THE BELL TOLLS: First baseman **Josh Bell** had a flair for the dramatic with his first Double-A home run coming in walk-off fashion on Saturday night to lift the Curve to a victory. He drove in five runs on Saturday to match a career-high and then drove in two more on Sunday while going 3-for-3 with two triples. The Irving, Texas native had a season-best seven-game hitting streak end last night. He had two or more hits in six of those games. Monday, Bell was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for April 27-May 3. During the week he hit .615 with three triples, one home run 11 RBI and five runs scored. It's the second career Player of the Week award for Bell, who won one last year while with Bradenton. Despite all the success last week, Bell had a tough series versus Richmond, going 0-for-13.

DON'T YOU STEAL MY SUNSHINE: The Curve suffered their first loss of the season in a day game (start time before 5 p.m.) on Thursday morning with the, 4-2, defeat. They had been 7-0 in day games and 6-0 in day games following a night game. They'll try and get it back on track in day games on Sunday in the series finale with the Senators.

THE STARTING LINE: After an out-of-this-world start, Curve starters have still pitched well recently allowing 27 earned runs in 137.2 innings so far (35 total runs). That's good for an ERA of 1.76 heading into today's game. Tuesday night's starter **Zack Dodson** had his scoreless streak snapped at 23.1 innings for this season, just shy of the franchise-best mark for a single season of 24-scoreless innings set by Derek Hankins in 2010. If you date Dodson's scoreless streak back to last season, the south-paw didn't allow a run in 27 straight innings, which is also a franchise-best.

NEW FACES, DIFFERENT PLACES: After this series with the Senators, the Curve will play a series against the first-place Bowie Baysox at PNG Field from May 11-13. Aside from Akron coming in next weekend for a four-game set, the Curve will play four new opponents in Bowie, Portland, New Hampshire and New Britain before coming back home again to close out May with another new opponent, the B-Mets.
