YESTERDAY: Altoona won the opener of the series behind a 15-hit offensive attack, led by Stetson Allie and Gift Ngoepe with three hits each. The Curve took a 1-0 lead in the third inning on an RBI single by Willy Garcia, extending his hitting streak to a Curve-best 14 games. The streak is also the longest active streak in the Eastern League. After Reading tied the game in the bottom of the third, the Curve jumped back ahead in fifth with back-to-back RBI doubles by Max Moroff and Josh Bell. Altoona added another run in the fifth on a single by Ngoepe. Ahead 4-2 heading to the eighth, Allie launched a solo home run, his eighth of the year, and Bell hit a sacrifice fly to push the lead to four. Starting pitcher Angel Sanchez allowed two runs in six innings. Jeremy Bleich, Jeff Inman and Jhondaniel Medina each pitched a scoreless frame to finish the Curve win. Reading starter Ben Lively (4-4) allowed three runs (two earned) on eight hits in his five innings.

CURVE/FIGHTINS SERIES: The Curve and Fightin Phils meet for the first time this season with this three-game series. The two teams will see each other again for a three-game series at PNG Field from Aug. 24-26 and total only six matchups this year. Last season, the Curve went 2-4 against Reading, taking one game each at home and on the

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Jason Creasy has a perfect record so far this season, going 7-0 with a 2.69 ERA in his first eleven starts. Last time out, Creasy allowed two earned runs over 6.2 innings in a win at Erie. Overall, Creasy has earned a win in each of his last four starts. The Clayton, N.C. native is in his fifth professional season after being drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round in 2011. Last year, he went 8-9 with A-Adv. Bradenton, and has a chance to tie that career-high win total in tonight's game. For more on Creasy, see page two.

FOR READING: Lefty Jesse Biddle makes his eleventh start this season for the Fightin Phils, coming off of a nodecision in his last outing at Binghamton on June 5, when he allowed one earned run on seven hits in five innings. The Philadelphia native has only worked through six complete innings twice this year, with one of those outings being his only loss against Harrisburg on May 11. However, the Phillies' first-round pick from 2010 has only allowed more than three earned runs in one start this year when New Hampshire plated five runs on ten hits in a no-decision on May 5. Biddle made 16 starts for Reading in 2014, going 3-10 with a 5.03 ERA.

FREE WILLY: Outfielder Willy Garcia is heating up once again as the calendar turns to June. Garcia has clubbed all four of his home runs in his last 11 games, and his batting average at .315 entering play tonight. He's also riding a $season-best\ four teen-game\ hitting\ streak\ into\ tonight's\ game,\ hitting\ , 397\ (23-for-58)\ with\ four\ home\ runs,\ 12\ RBI,$ nine runs scored and two walks in that span. The streak is the longest for any Curve player in 2015 and the longest current active streak in the Eastern League.

PUT YOUR STUNNA SHADES ON: The Curve now have the best record in the 12-team Eastern League at 35-21, just slightly ahead of New Britain's 35-22 mark and Trenton at 33-25. The 35 wins are still the second-most among Pirates' minor league affiliates with Triple-A Indianapolis leading the pack with 37. The Class-A West Virginia Power have won 34 games.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .278 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .289 (364/1258) as a team since May 1. The Curve have six active players hitting better than .300, including Jose Osuna (.361 in nine games), Josh Bell (.329), Adam Frazier (.352), Willy Garcia (.315), Max Moroff (.305) and Dan Gamache (.312). However, of those batters, only Bell, Garcia and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard. Catcher Jacob Stallings is now batting .299 on the year. Over the five games on this road trip, the Curve had totaled 11 or more hits four times.

THE ROAD: The Curve are in the final stretch of games where they play 20 of 29 games on the road and just finished a 5-1 homestand last week. Altoona was 4-6 during its 10-game, 11-day road trip from May 18-28 and won three-offour in Erie before traveling to Reading for this series. The Curve are 4-1 on the current road trip.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman Josh Bell enters today's game with Erie owning a .329 average that is fourth-best in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (68, 1st), RBI (39, T-2nd), on-base percentage (.396, 6th) and triples (5, T-2nd). Bell has 20 multi-hit games for the Curve.

HIP HIP JOSE! With Keon Broxton's promotion to Triple-A, the Curve have added first baseman/outfielder Jose Osuna from A-Adv. Bradenton. Osuna, 22, played in 44 games this year for Bradenton and hit .282 with 12 doubles, one triple, four homers and 29 RBI in his third season at Bradenton. Last year, Osuna batted .296 in 97 games while

hitting 10 home runs and driving in 57 runs. Through his first nine games in Double-A, Osuna is hitting .361 (13-for-38) with four doubles and five RBI. He had a hit in each of his first six career Double-A games and lauched his first Double-A home run on Monday night at Erie.

#OMGAMACHE: IF Dan Gamache had quite a month of May for the Curve as he hit to the tune of a .382 average in 22 games last month. After hitting .077 (2-for-26) in 11 games during April, Gamache collected five doubles, three homers, 12 RBI and 13 runs scored in 68 at bats during May. In that span he also had a 12-game hitting streak (a team-best this year) and he also tied a franchise record with a five-hit day (5-for-5) on May 25 at New Hampshire. The former Auburn Tigers has kept it rolling into June, batting .400 (6-for-15) with a home run in his first four games this month.
