**YESTERDAY:** After falling behind 5-1 in the fourth, the Curve chipped away at the New Hampshire lead. In the seventh, Jacob Stallings hit a bases-clearing, three-run double to give the Curve a 7-5 lead. Stetson Allie went 3-for-4 in the game with a solo home run and two doubles. Gift Ngoepe hit his third homer of the year during his 2-for-3, two-RBI night. Max Moroff had three hits, including two doubles. Reliever Jeff Inman pitched two innings with five strikeouts to earn his first win of the season. Tom Harlan picked up his first save with a 1-2-3 ninth. For the Fisher Cats, Dalton Pompey hit a two-run homer during their five-run fourth inning, his third longball of the series.

**CURVE/FISHER CATS SERIES:** New Hampshire and the Curve meet for the final times during the regular season this weekend in Curve, Pa. The two clubs split a pair of games in Manchester over Memorial Day weekend with the Fisher Cats winning the first two games before the Curve took the last two. Today's game marks the rubber match of this three-game set and will determine who wins the season series between the Curve and Fisher Cats.

**FOR ALTOONA:** RHP Angel Sanchez looks to become to first Eastern League pitcher to reach eight wins after improving to 7-1 with a win at Reading five days ago. He has picked up a win in each of his last four starts and won five straight decisions overall. In 2015, Sanchez has allowed more than two runs in just two of his previous 12 starts.

**FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE:** Right-hander Austin Bibens-Dirkx returns to the Fisher Cats after working with the Triple-A Buffalo Bisons for his last two outings. The last time the Salem, Ore. native made a start, he allowed four runs in two innings against New Britain on May 11. Bibens-Dirkx was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in 2006 out of the University of Portland, reaching as high as Triple-A Tacoma that season. He spent time in the Cubs, Nationals and Rockies organizations before joining the Blue Jays organization in 2013.

**BLANK CHECK:** The Altoona Curve are one of four teams in all of baseball (including MLB) that have not been shutout in 2015. Every team in Major League Baseball has been shutout at least once and the other three are from different levels of the minor leagues. In Triple-A, the El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego) have not thrown a shutout or been shutout. The only other Double-A team to not be shutout so far in 2015 is Chattanooga of the Southern League. The third and final team are the Lansing Lugnuts (Midwest League, Toronto).

**LIKE THE ENERGIZER BUNNY, IT KEPT GOING AND GOING....:** Thursday night's 18-inning loss to the Reading Fightin Phils was by far the longest game of the season and in fact it was the longest since the longest home game in franchise history of 5:49 on August 13, 2010 vs. New Hampshire. Since then, the two-longest games had been a pair of 4:35 games that came on July 9, 2011 vs. Bowie and July 11, 2014 vs. Harrisburg. It did not find its way into any of the Curve record books, however, as the longest road game in team history in terms of innings is 19 (July 13, 2000 at Norwich) and the longest game in terms of time is also that same game, which took 6:17 minutes to play.

**SAY JAKE:** Curve catcher Jacob Stallings is riding an 18-game on-base streak into tonight's game with the Fisher Cats, which is the second-longest for anyone on the team this season behind Max Moroff's 30-gamer. Stallings, 25, hit .320 in 14 games during May after batting .208 in seven April games. This month, he's off to a running start with a .360 clip to go along with one home run and eight RBI. For comparison's sake, Stallings had one home run and five RBI in his 14 games in May. He also made his first appearance on the mound in Friday night's loss, tossing one-third of an inning.

**FREE WILLY:** Outfielder Willy Garcia is heating up once again as the calendar turns to June. Garcia has clubbed all five of his home runs in his last 15 games and his batting average at .315 entering play tonight. He's also riding a season-best 18-game hitting streak into tonight's game, hitting .377 (29-for-77) with five home runs, 15 RBI, 12 runs scored and three walks in that span. The streak is the longest of his pro career, the longest for any Curve player in 2015, and tied for the longest active streak in the Eastern League with New Hampshire's Dalton Pompey (his streak started last July).

**HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM:** The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .277 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .289 (424/1465) as a team since May 1. The Curve have five active players hitting better than .300 -- Josh Bell (.320), Adam Frazier (.342), Willy Garcia (.315) Dan Gamache (.346), Jose Osuna (.340), Max Moroff (.304) and Jacob Stallings (.303). However, of those batters, only Bell, Moroff and Garcia have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

**THE ROAD, MAN:** The Curve are in the final stretch of games where they play 20 of 29 games on the road and just finished a 5-1 homestand last week. Altoona was 4-6 during its 10-game, 11-day road trip from May 18-28 and won three-of-four in Erie before dropping two-of-three in Reading after Thursday night's 18-inning loss. During this tough stretch of road games, Curve are 8-9. They'll finish the road gauntlet next Tuesday through Thursday in Akron, Ohio.

**JUST JOSHIN' YA:** First baseman Josh Bell enters today's game with New Hampshire owning a .320 average that is fifth-best in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (71, 2nd), RBI (40, 4th) and triples (5, T-2nd). With two hits on Thursday, Bell now has 21 multi-hit games for the Curve.

**HIP HIP JOSE!** With Keon Broxton's promotion to Triple-A, the Curve have added first baseman/outfielder Jose Osuna from A-Adv. Bradenton. Osuna, 22, played in 44 games this year for Bradenton and hit .282 with 12 doubles, one triple, four homers and 29 RBI in his third season at Bradenton. Last year, Osuna batted .296 in 97 games while hitting 10 home runs and driving in 57 runs. Through his first 13 games in Double-A, Osuna is hitting .358 with four doubles and five RBI. He had a hit in each of his first six career Double-A games and launched his first Double-A home run on Monday night at Erie.
