YESTERDAY: The Curve played from behind twice on Friday night but both times they found a way to come back and eventually wound up with a walk-off win in 10 innings, 4-3. Trailing 2-0 in the fourth, **Stetson Allie** clubbed a monster homer to left-center that scored **Josh Bell** to tie the game at two. That's where the game stayed as **Matt Benedict** settled in to pitch seven innings and allow one earned run (two runs total). Altoona had a chance to win the game in the eighth and ninth but couldn't push runs across. Harrisburg went ahead in the 10th off **Jeff Inman** (2-0) but the Curve rallied in the bottom half. **Jose Osuna** singled home **Mel Rojas, Jr.** and then with the bases loaded, Sammy Solis (0-2) hit pinch hitter Adam Frazier to bring home the walk-off run.

CURVE/SENATORS SERIES: The series is the fourth between Altoona and Harrisburg and the second at PNG Field in 2015. The Curve are 6-4 against the Senators this season and 2-1 at PNG Field. The last time the two teams met, Altoona took 2-of-3 from Harrisburg on City Island in early-May.

FOR ALTOONA: Making his Double-A debut in Game 1 tonight for the Curve will be LHP Steven Brault, Brault, 23, was acquired during the offseason along with LHP Stephen Tarpley from Baltimore in the deal that sent Travis Snider to Baltimore. In his first year in the Pirates' system, Brault was assigned to A-Adv. Bradenton and went 4-1 with a 3.02 ERA in 13 starts. Since May 1, Brault is 4-1 in nine starts with an ERA of 2.31. Baltimore originally took Brault in the 11th round of the 2013 draft out of Regis (Colo.) University. For more on Brault, see page two.

LHP Tom Harlan will get the nod for the Curve in game two, making his second spot start of the year. In his other spot start, Harlan turned in a quality start (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R) on May 13 vs. Bowie. For more on Harlan, see page three.

FOR HARRISBURG: RHP Dakota Bacus faces the Curve for the first time this season in Game 1 on Saturday night. Bacus, 24, was originally drafted by the Oakland Athletics in 2012 out of Indiana State University. He spent the 2012 season and part of the 2013 season in Oakland's system before being traded to Washington in the deal that sent Kurt Suzuki back to Oakland. This season, the righty from Illinois began the year in Potomac where he cruised to a 2-0 record and a 2.33 ERA in eight games (five starts). Except for one start on the road at Richmond where he gave up six runs in five innings, Bacus has given up two runs or fewer and pitched at least five innings in each of his other four

RHP James Simmons makes the spot start for the 'Sens in the second game, making his third spot start of the season. In his two previous spot starts, Simmons was 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA.

ALL HAIL THE PRINCE: With the Curve win on Friday night, skipper Tom Prince now has 399 career managerial wins in his minor league managing career. He entered the season with 360 career wins since he took the helm of the Lynchburg Hillcats mid-season back in 2004. With his next win, he will be at win #400.

MAD MAX 2: Max Moroff has heated back up in mid-June. His 79 hits lead the Eastern League and his .321 average is fourth in the league. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he has now reached base in 13 straight games and compiled a 10-game hitting streak. Since June 8, Moroff is hitting .386 (17-for-44) with 10 runs scored, seven RBI and five walks.

A PINCH OF THIS...A DASH OF THAT: Adam Frazier, Dan Gamache and Edward Salcedo were all used as pinch hitters in Friday night's walk-off win over Harrisburg and all of them reached base. Gamache and Salcedo both singled while Frazier was hit by a pitch to give the Curve the win. Regardless, the team overall has been tremendous when being asked to come in and pinch hit. As a team this year, the Curve are 11-for-28 when pinch hitting...that's a .393 batting average.

MAGIC MEL: In four games since rejoining the Curve, Mel Rojas, Jr. has recorded three multi-hit games and slugged his first home run at either level this season. Rojas was hitting .265 in 51 Triple-A games before being assigned back to Altoona and was seeming to turn it up at the plate in June. In 12 games this month with the Tribe, Rojas was batting .290 with three doubles and an RBI.

BLANK CHECK: The Altoona Curve are one of three teams in all of baseball (including MLB) that have not been shutout in 2015. Every team in Major League Baseball has been shutout at least once. The only other Double-A team to not be shutout so far in 2015 is Chattanooga of the Southern League. The Single-A Lansing Lugnuts (Midwest League, Toronto) are the other team.

EXTRA, EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The Curve played another extra innings game on Friday night in the homestand

opener and came away with their third win (second at home) in an extra-innings game this year. Of the 12 teams in the Eastern League, the Curve have played the second-most extra innings games this year (eight) behind Akron's 15. Of the Curve's eight extra-inning games, five have been against Akron.

HONING IN?: LHP Josh Smith tossed two more scoreless innings on Friday night in the extra-innings win for the Curve. For Smith, it was the sixth scoreless appearance in his last seven outings. This month in five games, Smith has an ERA of 1.04.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .276 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .287 (473/1646) as a team since May 1. The Curve have five active players hitting better than .300 -- Josh Bell (.324), Adam Frazier (.348), Dan Gamache (.316), Jose Osuna (.333) and Max **Moroff** (.321). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman Josh Bell enters today's game with Harrisburg owning a .324 average that is third-best in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (78,
