YESTERDAY: Erie took the lead with two runs in the eighth inning and held off a late Curve rally as Altoona fell, 4-3. The Curve scored a run in the eighth on a **Josh Bell** single, but Jeff Ferrell worked out of a one-out, bases-loaded jam with a pair of strikeouts. He struck out the last five Curve hitters overall to earn a five-out save, his 11th of the season. Curve starting pitch **Chad Kuhl** allowed two runs in seven innings on five hits with three strikeouts. **Brett McKinney** (0-2) gave up two runs in his one inning.

CURVE/SEAWOLVES SERIES: The Curve won the first eight games against the SeaWolves in 2015, and have won ten times overall in the twelve games played between the two clubs this year. The series marks the second set of meetings at PNG Field this season. The Curve swept the SeaWolves in Altoona in late-April. The two teams meet again at Jerry Uht Park, July 7-9.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Matt Benedict** starts on the mound for the Curve, making his sixth start of the year. He beat the SeaWolves at Jerry Uht Park on June 8, allowing two runs on seven hits in six innings. The former Western Carolina Catamount has also played at Adv.-A Bradenton and Triple-A Indianapolis this season. *For more on Benedict, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Lefty Ryan Robowski makes his second spot start of the season after scheduled starting pitcher Derek Hankins was promoted to Triple-A Toledo earlier today. Robowski last made a start on May 24 against Trenton, allowing three runs on five hits over three innings. Robowski, a native of Mount Pleasant, Pa., has made two appearances against the Curve this year. He tossed 1.1 scoreless innings at PNG Field on May 2. In Erie on June 8, he allowed four runs, including a two-run homer by **Adam Frazier**, in three relief innings.

ALL HAIL THE PRINCE: Curve manager **Tom Prince** earned his 400th career win with the 7-3 Curve victory over the Senators on Saturday night. He entered the season with 360 career wins since he took the helm of the Lynchburg Hillcats mid-season back in 2004.

MAD MAX 2: **Max Moroff** has heated back up in mid-June. His 82 hits lead the Eastern League and his .314 average is fourth in the league. His .390 on-base percentage is the third-best. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he had a season-best 12-game hitting streak end on Sunday in the first game of the double-header. Since June 8, Moroff is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with 13 runs scored, eight RBI and six walks.

A PINCH OF THIS...A DASH OF THAT: Adam Frazier, Dan Gamache and Edward Salcedo were all used as pinch hitters in Friday night's walk-off win over Harrisburg and all of them reached base. Gamache and Salcedo both singled while Frazier was hit by a pitch to give the Curve the win. Regardless, the team overall has been tremendous when being asked to come in and pinch hit. As a team this year, the Curve are 11-for-32 when pinch hitting...that's a .344 batting average.

MAGIC MEL: In nine games since rejoining the Curve, **Mel Rojas, Jr.** has recorded three multi-hit games and slugged his first home run at either level this season. Rojas was hitting .265 in 51 Triple-A games before being assigned back to Altoona and was seeming to turn it up at the plate in June. In 12 games this month with the Tribe, Rojas was batting .290 with three doubles and an RBI. He's hit safely in six-of-nine games since returning and reached base safely in all eight of them.

CHECK CASHED: The Altoona Curve were shutout for the first time in 2015 in the first game of the scheduled double-header. They'd gone 65 games without being shutout to begin the season.

HONING IN?: LHP **Josh Smith** tossed two more scoreless innings on Friday night in the extra-innings win for the Curve and another scoreless frame last night. For Smith, it was the seventh scoreless appearance in his last eight outings. This month in five games, Smith has an ERA of 0.93.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .275 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .284 (506/1780) as a team since May 1. The Curve have six active players hitting better than .300 -- **Josh Bell** (.318), **Adam Frazier** (.350), **Dan Gamache** (.310), **Jose Osuna** (.311), **Jasob Stallings** (.302) and **Max Moroff** (.314). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game with Harrisburg owning a .318 average that is third-best in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (81, T-2nd), RBI (44, T-4th), on-base percentage (.389, 4th) and triples (6, T-1st).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on Monday night, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.
