**YESTERDAY:** The Curve were swept in a double-header by the Senators, 3-2 and 4-3. In both games, the Senators came from behind and ultimately scored the go-ahead run in the sixth inning of the seven inning contests. **Dan Gamache** homered and drove in both runs in the first game, while **Zack Dodson** picked up a complete-game loss. The Curve jumped to a 3-0 lead in the second game through three innings, but the Senators tied the game in the fourth and took the lead with a go-ahead single in the sixth by Isaac Ballou.

**CURVE/SENATORS SERIES:** The Curve are 8-8 against the Senators this season, including a 4-5 mark at Metro Bank Park. In their last meetings at PNG Field, the Curve took three-of-five games over four days from June 19-22. This series marks the final trip to City Island in 2015 for Altoona. The two teams will meet for the final time this season for a three-game series at PNG Field from July 4-6.

**FOR ALTOONA:** RHP **Tyler Glasnow** makes his first start since returning from the disabled list after suffering a right ankle sprain in May. He posted two scoreless outings and two one-run games in his first four starts this season for the Curve. The Pirates' top prospect has pitched against the Senators one time this season prior to tonight, notching five scoreless innings and allowing just two hits on April 11 at MetroBank Park.

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Left-hander **Matthew Spann** takes this hill for Harrisburg, making his first start against the Curve this season. He was named an MiLB.com Nationals Organizational All-Star after pitching for Hagerstown and Potomac in 2014. Originally drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in 2010, Spann was part of a trade for David DeJesus in September 2013. The Tennessee native did not allow more than two runs in his first three starts for the Senators this season, but has given up a combined nine runs over his last eight innings in two starts against Richmond and Binghamton.

**VIEW FROM THE TOP:** With the losses in yesterday's double-header, the Curve fell out of first place in the Western Division for the first time since May 7, a span that covered 48 straight games. Prior to May 7, the Curve had led the division for the previous 15 consecutive days. Overall, Altoona sat atop of the Western Division for 63-of-64 games from April 19-June 28.

**LATE LOSSES:** The Curve have had the go-ahead run scored against them in the next-to-last inning or later in each game on the current four-game losing streak. After leading 1-0 through seven innings against Erie at PNG Field on Thursday, the SeaWolves tied the game in the seventh and pulled ahead 2-1 in the top of the ninth. On Friday, The SeaWolves broke a 1-1 tie in the eighth to earn a 2-1 win. In Sunday's double-header at Harrisburg, the Curve lost a pair of early leads and ultimately surrendered the lead to the Senators in the bottom of the sixth in both of the seven-inning games. The four-game slide ties the longest this season for the Curve.

**JUST JOSHIN' YA:** First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .325 average that leads the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (87, T-1st), RBI (44, T-5th), on-base percentage (.395, 2nd) and triples (6, T-1st).

**HONING IN?:** LHP **Josh Smith** tossed two more scoreless innings on Friday night in the extra-innings win for the Curve and another scoreless frame last night. For Smith, it was the seventh scoreless appearance in his last eight outings. This month in five games, Smith has an ERA of 0.93.

**HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM:** The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .275 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .281 (543/1931) as a team since May 1. The Curve have six active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.325), **Adam Frazier** (.357), **Dan Gamache** (.311), **Jose Osuna** (.307), **Jasob Stallings** (.309) and **Max Moroff** (.313). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

**MAD MAX 2:** **Max Moroff** has heated back up in mid-June. His 87 hits are tied for the the best total in the league with Josh Bell and his .313 average is fourth in the league. His .384 on-base percentage is the fifth-best. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he had a season-best 12-game hitting streak end last Monday in the first game of the double-header against Harrisburg.

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Former Curve relief pitcher **Diego Moreno** made his MLB debut last week, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE...S GAME:** First baseman **Josh Bell** is heading back to the SiriusXM Futures Game for the second straight year, MLB announced on Thursday. Last season, Bell played for the U.S. in Minneapolis at Target Field. This season he will join the U.S. squad on July 12 at Great American Ballpark in Cincinnati. He will be opposed by former Curve catcher **Elias Diaz**, currently a member of the Triple-A Indianapolis Indians, who will be playing for the World team. Curve manager **Tom Prince** will join Ken Griffey, Sr. on the U.S. coaching staff.

**HALFWAY HOME:** With the conclusion of Thursday night's game, the Curve finished the first half of the 2015 season 12 games over .500 with a record of 42-30. Overall, the Curve sat in first place in the Eastern League's Western Division for all but six days between Opening Day and June 25, and every day since May 7.
