**YESTERDAY:** The Curve fell behind 1-0 in the first inning on Pat Valaika but tied the game with a home run by Willy Garcia in the second inning to knot the score at 1-1. The Curve took the lead in the fifth with a double by Gift Ngoepe, and Garcia followed in the sixth with his second home run of the game to give Altoona a 3-1 lead. The Curve added three more runs in the eighth with a two-run double from Jacob Stallings and a sacrifice fly by Eric Wood. Curve starter Matt Benedict earned his first-career Double-A win, allowing one run on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts in his six innings. New Britain starting pitcher Bryan Evans had 12 strikeouts.

**CURVE/ROCK CATS SERIES:** Meeting for the second time in less than a week are the Curve and Rock Cats, who after this series don't see one another again until early August in New Britain. The Curve went 1-2 in New Britain after having a chance to take the series in the rubber match last Thursday only to come up on the short end.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Curve right-hander and Opening Day starter Angel Sanchez takes the mound tonight. He has earned a win in each of his last two starts and three of his last four overall. Sanchez did not allow an earned run in three of his first four starts and has given up two or fewer earned runs in eight of his ten starts this season. Tonight will be first time Sanchez has faced New Britain in 2015. *For more on Sanchez, see page two.*

**FOR NEW BRITAIN:** Right-hander Brett Marshall is set to make his first start of the 2015 season in his Rockies organizational debut. Last season as a member of the Reds-affiliated Louisville Bats, Marshall went 1-10 with a 6.53 ERA. Originally a sixth-round draft pick of the New York Yankees, Marshall climbed to the Majors and donned the pinstripes for three games in 2013. The Rockies signed Marshall to a minor league contract in November.

**KUHL WHIP:** RHP Chad Kuhl turned in another terrific performance on Tuesday night as he beat the Rock Cats for a second-straight start. In his last two outings versus the 'Cats, Kuhl has allowed one run in 12.1 innings while striking out 12 batters and walking three. Even better, he's lasted at least five innings in all of his starts and gone at least six innings in eight-straight starts dating back to April 24.

**A TALE OF TWO MONTHS:** April and May were very different months for the Curve but through it all the team still resides in first place into their first game this month. In April, the team had the best pitching staff in the league (2.32 ERA) and the 6th-best team batting average at .252. In May, the Curve led the league with a blistering .285 batting average but had the fifth-highest ERA in the league at 3.84.

**HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM:** The Curve pounded out a season-high 13 runs while producing 17 hits on Saturday, one shy of the season-high so far. It's been a big run for the Curve bats lately, who have hit with a .330 clip over the last ten games since being held to just three hits in a, 4-1, loss in New Hampshire on May 23. Leading the charge during that time has been Josh Bell (.361) and Jacob Stallings (.444). Entering play today, the Curve are once again leading the league in hitting with a .274 average.

**JUST JOSHIN' YA:** First baseman Josh Bell starts the month of June with the fourth-best batting average of any player in the 12-team Eastern League at .330. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (60, 3rd), RBI (34, T-3rd), on-base percentage (.401, 5th) and triples (5, T-1st). Bell has 18 multi-hit games for the Curve with five of them being three-hit days and two of them being four-hit games.

**#OMGAMACHE:** IF Dan Gamache had quite a month of May for the Curve as he hit to the tune of a .382 average in 22 games last month. After hitting .077 (2-for-26) in 11 games during April, Gamache collected five doubles, three homers, 12 RBI and 13 runs scored in 68 at bats during May. In that span he also had a 12-game hitting streak (a team-best this year) and he also tied a franchise record with a five-hit day (5-for-5) on May 25 at New Hampshire.

**HIP HIP JOSE!** With Keon Broxton's promotion to Triple-A, the Curve have added first baseman/outfielder Jose Osuna from A-Adv. Bradenton. Osuna, 22, played in 44 games this year for Bradenton and hit .282 with 12 doubles, one triple, four homers and 29 RBI in his third season at Bradenton. Last year, Osuna batted .296 in 97 games while hitting 10 home runs and driving in 57 runs. Through his first four games in Double-A, Osuna is 8-for-15 with three doubles and three RBI.

**CRUISIN' CREASY:** Starter Jason Creasy has opened the 2015 campaign with a 6-0 record through his first 10 starts. He's turned in four straight quality starts after his QS on Saturday night and has five of them in his 10 starts this year. He's gone at least five innings in all of his 10 starts and at least six innings in six of the 10. His 2.68 ERA is eighth-best in the Eastern League and his six wins are tied for second-most in the league and most for any starting pitcher.

The club is now wrapping up being home for six games in seven days before returning to the road for seven more through Erie and Reading.

**APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS:** Shortstop Gift Ngoepe enjoyed the turnover of the calendar to the month of May. In 27 games played this month, the South Africa native hit .322 (29-for-90) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, eight RBI and 18 runs scored with an on-base percentage of .413. In 18 games during April, Ngoepe hit .172 with an OBP of .232.
