YESTERDAY: Altoona won its fourth straight game and remained unbeaten in seven games against Erie this season. Starting pitcher **Jason Creasy** won his fourth straight start to improve to 7-0 this year, which is tied for the most wins in the Eastern League. **Willy Garcia** gave the Curve a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single. Creasy surrendered his only runs in the first inning as Erie took a 2-1 lead, but the Curve tied it back up in the third when **Max Moroff** scored on a wild pitch. The Curve jumped ahead in the sixth on a sac fly by **Jacob Stallings**. **Jhondaniel Medina** got a 1-4-6-3 double play to end the game and record his second save of the year. The Curve notched 14 base hits, but 13 of them were singles and they hit just 3-for-12 with runners in scoring position.

CURVE/SEAWOLVES SERIES: The Curve and SeaWolves renew the season series this weekend in Erie with the Curve having dominated the club in the early going. Entering the series this weekend, the Curve are 7-0 versus Erie with three wins in Curve, Pa. and four in Erie. After this series the teams will meet for three more series and two of them will be in Curve, Pa.

FOR ALTOONA: Starter **Zack Dodson** makes his tenth start of the year and his first against Erie. In his last start, the Texas native did not earn a decision after allowing two runs in 6.2 innings against Binghamton at PNG Field. The lefty ranks sixth in the Eastern League with a 2.54 ERA. He opened the year without giving up a run in his first four appearances, three of them starts. Dodson was drafted by the Pirates in the fourth round in 2009. *For more on Dodson, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: RHP Chad Green will face the Curve for the second time this season. On April 24 at Jerry Uht Park, Green received his second loss of the year after allowing four earned runs in 4.2 innings as the Curve knocked eight base hits against him. In his last outing, Green allowed three runs in 5.1 innings against Trenton and picked up his sixth loss of the year. Green pitched better in May, going 2-3 but posting a 2.48 ERA in five starts.

FREE WILLY: Outfielder **Willy Garcia** is heating up once again as the calendar turns to June. Garcia has clubbed all three of his home runs in the last week (all off of Bryan Evans of New Britain in two different starts) and has his batting average at .313 entering play tonight. He's also riding a season-best, ten-game hitting streak into tonight's game, hitting .425 (17-for-40) with three home runs, nine RBI, six runs scored and two walks in that span.

PUT YOUR STUNNA SHADES ON: The Curve now have the best record in the 12-team Eastern League at 32-20, just slightly ahead of New Britain's 31-22 mark. The 31 wins are still the third-most among Pirates' minor league affiliates with West Virginia leading the pack with 33. Triple-A Indianapolis, who is also in first-place, has 33 wins.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: With 14 more hits in last night's game, the Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .275 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .290 as a team since May 1. The Curve have seven active players hitting better than .300, including Jose Osuna (.478 in six games), Josh Bell (.332), Adam Frazier (.323), Jacob Stallings (.313), Willy Garcia (.313), Max Moroff (.309) and Dan Gamache (.307). However, of those batters, only Bell, Garcia and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard. Keon Broxton is still listed in the league leaders with his .302 average but has been promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis.

THE ROAD: The Curve are in the final stretch of games where they play 20 of 29 games on the road and just finished a 5-1 homestand. Altoona was 4-6 during its 10-game, 11-day road trip from May 18-28 and will play the second of a seven-game road swing tonight in Erie.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game with Erie owning a .332 average that is fourth-best in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (63, 2nd), RBI (34, T-3rd), on-base percentage (.403, T-2nd) and triples (5, T-1st). Bell has 19 multi-hit games for the Curve with five of them being three-hit days and two of them being four-hit games.

KUHL WHIP: RHP **Chad Kuhl** turned in another terrific performance on Tuesday night as he beat the Rock Cats for a second-straight start. In his last two outings versus the 'Cats, Kuhl has allowed one run in 12.1 innings while striking out 12 batters and walking three. Even better, he's lasted at least five innings in all of his starts and gone at least six innings in eight-straight starts dating back to April 24.

HIP HIP JOSE! With Keon Broxton's promotion to Triple-A, the Curve have added first baseman/outfielder **Jose Osuna** from A-Adv. Bradenton. Osuna, 22, played in 44 games this year for Bradenton and hit .282 with 12 doubles, one triple, four homers and 29 RBI in his third season at Bradenton. Last year, Osuna batted .296 in 97 games while hitting 10 home runs and driving in 57 runs. Through his first six games in Double-A, Osuna is 11-for-23 with three doubles and three RBI. He has a hit in each of his first six career Double-A games.

In that span he also had a 12-game hitting streak (a team-best this year) and he also tied a franchise record with a five-hit day (5-for-5) on May 25 at New Hampshire.

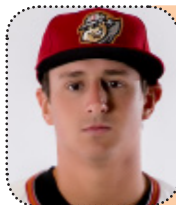
