YESTERDAY: Altoona won the finale of the series at Erie, taking three of the four games at Jerry Uht Park. Max Moroff launched a three-run home run in the second to give the Curve a 5-1 lead. Jose Osuna and Adam Frazier each homered for the first longballs of their Double-A careers. The Curve tallied 13 hits, totaling 44 hits in the four-game series. Starting pitcher Matt Benedict earned his second straight win, allowing two runs in six innings.

CURVE/FIGHTINS SERIES: The Curve and Fightin Phils meet for the first time this season with this three-game series. The two teams will see each other again for a three-game series at PNG Field from Aug. 24-26 and total only six matchups this year. Last season, the Curve went 2-4 against Reading, taking one game each at home and on the home.

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Angel Sanchez was the Opening Day starter for the Curve, and has since cruised to a 6-1 record with a 2.54 ERA. In his last start, the Tenares, Dominican Republic native earned a win for the third straight start with six scoreless innings against New Britain on Thursday at PNG Field, giving up just four hits and three walks with three strikeouts. He has won four of his last five starts overall. *For more on Sanchez, see page two.*

FOR READING: Former Reds farmhand Ben Lively will make his first start against the Curve in tonight's series opener, and his eleventh overall start in 2015. He picked up a loss in his last outing against Erie, giving up two earned runs on six hits in five innings. Lively was traded to the Phillies by the Reds in the offseason for Marlon Byrd.

FREE WILLY: Outfielder Willy Garcia is heating up once again as the calendar turns to June. Garcia has clubbed all four of his home runs in his last ten game, and his batting average at .313 entering play tonight. He's also riding a season-best thirteen-game hitting streak into tonight's game, hitting .396 (21-for-53) with four home runs, 11 RBI, nine runs scored and two walks in that span. The streak is the longest for any Curve player in 2015 and the longest current active streak in the Eastern League.

PUT YOUR STUNNA SHADES ON: The Curve now have the best record in the 12-team Eastern League at 34-21, just slightly ahead of New Britain's 34-22 mark and Trenton at 33-24. The 33 wins are still the second-most among Pirates' minor league affiliates with Triple-A Indianapolis leading the pack with 36. The Class-A West Virginia Power have also won 34 games.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .276 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .289 (364/1258) as a team since May 1. The Curve have six active players hitting better than .300, including Jose Osuna (.419 in eight games), Josh Bell (.328), Adam Frazier (.352), Willy Garcia (.313), Max Moroff (.306) and Dan Gamache (.312). However, of those batters, only Bell, Garcia and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard. Keon Broxton is still listed in the league leaders with his .302 average but has been promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis. Catcher Jacob Stallings is now batting .299 on the year.

THE ROAD: The Curve are in the final stretch of games where they play 20 of 29 games on the road and just finished a 5-1 homestand last week. Altoona was 4-6 during its 10-game, 11-day road trip from May 18-28 and won three-of-four in Erie before traveling to Reading for this series. The Curve are 3-1 on the current road trip.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman Josh Bell enters today's game with Erie owning a .328 average that is fourth-best in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (67, 1st), RBI (37, T-2nd), on-base percentage (.398, 5th) and triples (5, T-2nd). Bell has 20 multi-hit games for the Curve.

HIP HIP JOSE! With Keon Broxton's promotion to Triple-A, the Curve have added first baseman/outfielder Jose Osuna from A-Adv. Bradenton. Osuna, 22, played in 44 games this year for Bradenton and hit .282 with 12 doubles, one triple, four homers and 29 RBI in his third season at Bradenton. Last year, Osuna batted .296 in 97 games while hitting 10 home runs and driving in 57 runs. Through his first eight games in Double-A, Osuna is 13-for-31 with four doubles and five RBI. He had a hit in each of his first six career Double-A games and lauched his first Double-A home run on Monday night at Erie.

#OMGAMACHE: IF Dan Gamache had quite a month of May for the Curve as he hit to the tune of a .382 average in 22 games last month. After hitting .077 (2-for-26) in 11 games during April, Gamache collected five doubles, three homers, 12 RBI and 13 runs scored in 68 at bats during May. In that span he also had a 12-game hitting streak (a team-best this year) and he also tied a franchise record with a five-hit day (5-for-5) on May 25 at New Hampshire. The former Auburn Tigers has kept it rolling into June, batting .400 (6-for-15) with a home run in his first four games this month.
