YESTERDAY: The Curve jumped ahead early and held off a late rally by the Baysox for an 8-5 win. Tyler Glasnow (3-2) gave up just one just hit in six scoreless innings, striking out seven. Mel Rojas Jr. got the scoring started with an RBI triple in the second inning, the first of four runs on the frame for the Curve. Rojas finished the night with three hits. Moroff also had three hits, driving in two runs on the night and scoring once. Stetson Allie had a two-run single in the fifth. Eight different Curve players scored one run in the game.

CURVE/BAYSOX SERIES: This series marks second series between the Curve and Baysox, with the first one also being played at PNG Field. The Curve swept the Baysox in that set on May 11, 12 and 13. This series marks the final visit to PNG Field for the Baysox this year. The Curve will travel to Bowie to face the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium on August 21-23 and August 31-September 3.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Chad Kuhl** takes the ball tonight for the Curve while making his 16th start in 2015. Kuhl picked up a no-decision on May 11 in his only other start against Bowie. The Delaware product finished the night going six innings, giving up four runs and striking out six. The right-hander was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 out of the University of Delaware. During his junior season, Kuhl posted a record of 10-2 over 105.1 innings. He led the Pirates' farm system in wins 2014 with 13 while pitching for the Bradenton Marauders of the Florida State League. *For more on Kuhl, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Lefty Ashur Tolliver makes his second start for Bowie and this 23rd overall appearance this season. It will be just the fourth start of his professional career. In his first start of 2015 on June 29, Tolliver pitched two scoreless innings. Overall this year, the former Oklahoma City Univ. Star is 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA this season. He has now allowed a run over his last nine games since May 27 working 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings.

SHINING STARS: The Eastern League's 2015 All-Star rosters were announced on Wednesday, and five Curve players were selected to represent the Western Division during the game on July 15 at Portland's Hadlock Field: **Josh Bell**, **Max Moroff**, **Jason Creasy**, **Dan Gamache** and **Adam Frazier**.

SETTING THE TABLE: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .405 (45/111) in 25 games and .577 (15/26) in the first inning. He is currently on a 12-game hitting streak, two shy of the 14-game streak he went on with James-town in 2013.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting into July. His 102 hits are the most in the league and he sits third with his .319 average. His .392 on-base percentage is the third-best, he is third with 41 walks and second with 53 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak earlier this month, which is tied for the longest among active Curve players with Dan Gamache and Adam Frazier.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .276 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .286 (633/2216) as a team since May 1. The Curve have four active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.312), **Adam Frazier** (.378), **Dan Gamache** (.310) and **Max Moroff** (.319). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leader board.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .312 average that is fourth in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (97, 2nd), RBI (51, 4th), on-base percentage (.380, 6th) and triples (6, T-1st).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.

BACK TO THE FUTURES GAME: First baseman **Josh Bell** is heading back to the SiriusXM Futures Game for the second straight year, MLB announced on Thursday. Last season, Bell played for the U.S. in Minneapolis at Target Field. This season he will join the U.S. squad on July 12 at Great American Ballpark in Cincinnati. He will be opposed by former Curve catcher **Elias Diaz**, currently a member of the Triple-A Indianapolis Indians, who will be playing for the World team. Curve manager **Tom Prince** will join Ken Griffey, Sr. on the U.S. coaching staff.
