YESTERDAY: The Curve ended their season-worst six-game losing streak thanks to seven scoreless innings on the mound from **Steven Brault**, who earned his first Double-A win with five strikeouts and no walks, going one above the minimum batters faced. **Eric Wood** gave the Curve a 1-0 lead in the third inning and **Stetson Allie** added a run with a solo homer in the sixth. **John Kuchno** worked the eighth and ninth innings to earn his fourth save of the season. **Max Moroff** and **Sebastian Valle** each had two hits.

CURVE/TRENTON SERIES: This series marks the first set of meetings between the Curve and Thunder in 2015. The four games at ARM & HAMMER Park will be the only trip to the Garden State for the Curve this season. Trenton makes one trip to PNG Field later this season, a four-game set from August 27-30. Last year, the Curve went 5-4 against the Yankees' Double-A affiliate, including a 3-3 mark at ARM & HAMMER Park.

FOR ALTOONA: RHP **Jason Creasy** seeks to become the first pitcher in the Eastern League to reach nine wins. The North Carolina native has posted a 2.99 ERA through his first 15 starts at Double-A. He won four straight starts from May 20-June 5, and picked up a victory in each of his first seven decisions. Last time out, Creasy did not receive a decision after pitching seven innings against Erie on June 26, allowing just one earned run on five hits.

FOR TRENTON: LHP **Caleb Smith** makes his 14th start for the Thunder this season coming off a win against Richmond his last time out, when he tossed six scoreless innings and allowed two hits. The Texan has gone 4-1 with a 2.61 ERA on the road, but has a 6.23 ERA and a 1-3 record in six starts this season at ARM & HAMMER Park. June was his best month of the season so far, as he was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over five games.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: With the losses in Sunday's double-header at Harrisburg, the Curve fell out of first place in the Western Division for the first time since May 7, a span that covered 48 straight games. Prior to May 7, the Curve had led the division for the previous 15 consecutive days. Overall, Altoona sat atop of the Western Division for 63-of-64 games from April 19-June 28.

SHINING STARS: The Eastern League's 2015 All-Star rosters were announced on Wednesday, and five Curve players were selected to represent the Western Division during the game on July 15 at Portland's Hadlock Field: **Josh Bell**, **Max Moroff**, **Jason Creasy**, **Dan Gamache** and **Adam Frazier**.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .317 average that sits tied for third in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (89, 2nd), RBI (45, 6th), on-base percentage (.388, 4th) and triples (6, T-1st).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .274 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .282 (569/2017) as a team since May 1. The Curve have five active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.317), **Adam Frazier** (.363), **Dan Gamache** (.300), **Jasob Stallings** (.307) and **Max Moroff** (.325). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

MAD MAX 2: **Max Moroff** heated up in June. His 94 hits are the most in the league and he sits first with his .325 average.. His .398 on-base percentage is the second-best, and he is tied for second with 37 walks. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak earlier this month, which is tied for the longest among active Curve players with Dan Gamache.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher **Diego Moreno** made his MLB debut last week, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alum to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.

BACK TO THE FUTURE...S GAME: First baseman **Josh Bell** is heading back to the SiriusXM Futures Game for the second straight year, MLB announced on Thursday. Last season, Bell played for the U.S. in Minneapolis at Target Field. This season he will join the U.S. squad on July 12 at Great American Ballpark in Cincinnati. He will be opposed by former Curve catcher **Elias Diaz**, currently a member of the Triple-A Indianapolis Indians, who will be playing for the World team. Curve manager **Tom Prince** will join Ken Griffey, Sr. on the U.S. coaching staff.

HALFWAY HOME: With the conclusion of last Thursday night's game, the Curve finished the first half of the 2015 season 12 games over .500 with a record of 42-30. Overall, the Curve sat in first place in the Eastern League's Western Division for all but six days between Opening Day and June 28.

FANTSTIC FRAZIER: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .392 (31/79) in 20 games.

HONING IN?: LHP **Josh Smith** gave up a rare June run in Monday's game at Harrisburg. However, Smith has posted seven scoreless appearances in his last nine outings. This month in seven games, Smith has an ERA of 1.80, a 180-degree turnaround from his 13.50 ERA in six April outings.
