YESTERDAY: The Curve had a record-setting day at PNG Field in the double-header sweep of the SeaWolves. After setting a new franchise high with 24 hits and tying the single-game runs record in an 18-7 win in game one, the Curve scored seven runs in the final inning to stun the SeaWolves in an 8-7, walk-off win. In game one, **Jose Osuna** set a new single-game franchise record by scoring five runs scored. Each offensive player for the Curve had at least two hits. Along with the offensive outburst, **Tyler Glasnow** had ten strikeouts over six innings. **Stetson Allie** hit a grand slam and finished with five RBI. In the night cap, the SeaWolves scored seven unanswered runs over the sixth and seventh innings, but the Curve rallied back with seven runs in the bottom of the inning for the walk-off win, sealed by a two-run, game-winning double by **Andy Vasquez**.

CURVE/SEAWOLVES SERIES: Tonight marks the finale meeting between Altoona and Erie in 2015. The Curve swept the first two sets, one at Jerry Uht Park and one at PNG Field, to begin the season series this year, and began the season 8-0 against the SeaWolves. Altoona posted an 8-1 mark in games at Jerry Uht Park this season. Overall, the Curve are 14-5 against the SeaWolves this season.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Chad Kuhl takes the mound in his 19th Double-A start for the Curve. Last time out, he picked up a loss despite not allowing an earned run against Richmond on July 15. He has not allowed an earned run in three starts this month in a span of 18.0 innings. In 2014, Kuhl recorded 13 wins with A-Adv. Bradenton, the most of any Pirates minor league pitcher and tied for the most in the Florida State League. Kuhl was picked up by Pittsburgh in the ninth round of the 2013 draft out of the University of Delaware. **For more on Kuhl, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Derek Hankins makes his 14th start for the SeaWolves. He also made four starts for the Triple-A Toledo Mud Hens. At Double-A this year, Hankins is 4-6 with a 4.86 ERA. In his last start, he allowed two runs in six innings in a win against Akron. Hankins pitched for the Curve from 2008-2010, and was originally drafted by the Pirates in the tenth round in 2004. He spent two season with the Texas Rangers' organization before joining the Tigers in 2013.

SETTING THE TABLE: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .372 (55/148) in 37 games and .444 (15/34) in the first inning. He had a career-best 15-game hitting streak snapped last Thursday night at Richmond.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting into July. His 117 hits are the most in the league and he sits second with his .324 average. His .393 on-base percentage is the third-best, he is sixth with 43 walks and first with 59 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 176 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter, set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .278 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .286 (736/2569) as a team since May 1. The Curve have five active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.318), **Adam Frazier** (.356), **Dan Gamache** (.332), **Jose Osuna** (.306) and **Max Moroff** (.324). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leader board.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .318 average that is fourth in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (107, 2nd), RBI (56, 3rd), on-base percentage (.389, 5th), walks (42, 7th) and triples (6, T-1st).

NOT KUHL-ING OFF: In three July starts, right-hander **Chad Kuhl** has gone 2-1 and has not yet surrendered an earned run over 18.0 innings pitched. He pitched six scoreless innings in a win over Harrisburg on July 6, and followed it by allowing just an unearned run in his next outing on July 11 against Bowie. He picked up the first complete game of his career in the first game of a double-header at Richmond on July 17, but two unearned runs in the first inning were enough to charge him with the loss.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alum to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player.
