YESTERDAY: The Curve lost the series finale in Akron, 2-0. **Tyler Glasnow** (5-3) finished the game with a season-high 12 strikeouts, the most for any Altoona pitcher this season. He pitched six innings, allowing five hits and two walks. The only two runs of the game came on a solo home run Alex Lavisky in the fifth inning off of Glasnow. **Adam Frazier** totaled two hits for the seventh straight game and now has a nine-game hitting streak overall. Akron's Shawn Morimando (7-10) tossed six scoreless innings with seven strikeouts.

CURVE/FLYING SQUIRRELS SERIES: Richmond had a 15-game losing streak coming into the last series between the two teams at PNG Field, and they snapped it with a four-game sweep of the Curve. They have since climbed back into playoff contention. They have given the Curve more trouble than any other team in the league this year, including taking three-of-five at The Diamond two weeks ago.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Chad Kuhl makes his 20th start for the Curve this season. Last time out, Kuhl picked up his eighth win of the year while working 5.2 innings against Erie and allowing two earned runs. He leads the team with 11 quality starts through his first 19 outings and has only allowed more than three earned runs only three times. He has faced Richmond twice this season, going 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA. Last time he faced the Squirrels on July 17, he suffered a loss after allowing only two unearned runs. Kuhl was the second-highest drafted pitcher out of the University of Delaware in the last 25 years when the Pirates selected him in the ninth round in 2013. **For more on Kuhl, see page two.**

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Joan Gregorio makes his third start and his 31st overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. In his last start on July 21 against Akron, he worked a season-high four innings without allowing a run and only surrendered one hit. In two separate outings against Altoona this year, Gregorio has combined for 2.1 scoreless innings.

SETTING THE TABLE: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .380 (65/171) in 42 games and .410 (16/39) in the first inning. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak earlier this month, and is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak. He has two hits in each of his last seven games.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting into July. His 119 hits are the most in the league and he sits fifth with his .314 average. His .381 on-base percentage is the sixth-best, he is seventh with 43 walks and first with 60 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 160 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter, set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .279 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .286 (784/2743) as a team since May, including a .293 (241/826) team average in July. The Curve have five active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.313), **Adam Frazier** (.364), **Dan Gamache** (.338), **Jose Osuna** (.302) and **Max Moroff** (.314). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .313 average that is sixth in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (110, 2nd), RBI (59, 3rd), on-base percentage (.385, 5th), walks (44, 5th) and triples (6, T-1st). His 17-game on-base streak that began on July 3 was snapped on Saturday night at Akron.

NOT KUHLL-ING OFF: In three July starts, right-hander **Chad Kuhl** has gone 2-1 and has only surrendered two earned runs over 23.2 innings pitched. He pitched six scoreless innings in a win over Harrisburg on July 6, and followed it by allowing just an unearned run in his next outing on July 11 against Bowie. He picked up the first complete game of his career in the first game of a double-header at Richmond on July 17, but two unearned runs in the first inning were enough to charge him with the loss. In a win against Erie on Monday, he had his streak of 24 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run snapped.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.
