YESTERDAY: The Curve took the second game of the three-game set, 3-0. Steven Brault fired six scoreless innings with nine strikeouts, holding the Flying Squirrels to just two hits. He also contributed in a big way at the plate, collecting his first two professional hits, both being RBI singles. Max Moroff went 2-for-4 with an RBI double. Clario Perez pitched two scoreless innings and Jeremy Bleich shut the door in the ninth for his fourth save.

CURVE/FLYING SQUIRRELS SERIES: Richmond had a 15-game losing streak coming into the last series between the two teams at PNG Field, and they snapped it with a four-game sweep of the Curve. They have since climbed back into playoff contention. They have given the Curve more trouble than any other team in the league this year, incluing taking three-of-five at The Diamond two weeks ago.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Zack Dodson makes his 20th start and his 21st overall appearance for the Curve this season. Dodson has logged 114.1 innings this season, the second-most of any pitcher on the staff. In his last start, the San Antonio native picked up his third straight loss after allowing five earned runs in seven innings. He has lost six of his last seven decisions, with his last win coming on July 8 at Erie. He opened the season on a 23.1-inning scoreless streak. which included all of his starts in April. In May, his ERA was 3.93, but he went 1-3 with a 5.58 ERA in June. For more on Dodson, see page two.

FOR RICHMOND: Lefty Matt Gage faces the Curve for the second time. He made his Double-A debut against the Curve at The Diamond on July 17, allowing one run over five innings in the win. In his second and most recent start, he picked up another win after allowing one run in six innings at Erie on July 23. He began the season with Single-A Augusta, where he went 4-4 with a 4.07 ERA. He was drafted in the 10th round in 2014 by the Giants out of Siena.

SETTING THE TABLE: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .363 (65/179) in 44 games and .390 (16/41) in the first inning. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak earlier this month, and followed with a nine-game hitting streak that ended on Monday night against Richmond. He had two hits in each of the last seven games of the

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder Max Moroff has continued his hot hitting into July. His 122 hits are the most in the league and he sits fourth with his .316 average. His .383 on-base percentage is the fifth-best, he is tied for sixth with 44 walks and first with 60 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 165 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter, set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .278 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .286 (792/2774) as a team since May, including a .292 (260/890) team average in July. The Curve have five active players hitting .300 or better -- Josh Bell (.309), Adam Frazier (.351), Dan Gamache (.338), Jose Osuna (.304) and Max Moroff (.316). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

JUST JOSHIN' YA: First baseman Josh Bell enters today's game owning a .309 average that is sixth in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (111, 2nd), RBI (59, 3rd), on-base percentage (.385, 5th), walks (44, 5th) and triples (6, T-1st). His 17-game on-base streak that began on July 3 was snapped on Saturday night at Akron.

NOT KUHL-ING OFF: In five July starts, right-hander Chad Kuhl has gone 3-1 and has only surrendered two earned runs over 29.2 innings pitched. He pitched six scoreless innings in a win over Harrisburg on July 6, and a followed it by allowing just an unearned run in his next outing on July 11 against Bowie. He picked up the first comeplete game of his career in the first game of a double-header at Richmond on July 17, but two unearned runs in the first inning were enough to charge him with the loss. In a win against Erie on July 22, he had his streak of 24 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run snapped. On July 27 against Richmond, Curve pitched six scoreless, three-hit innings against Richmond but did not receive a decision.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game,

which Altoona won, 18-7, the team reocrd for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.


