**YESTERDAY:** The Curve shut out the Flying Squirrels for the second straight day, 1-0. **Zack Dodson** allowed two hits in seven innings. **John Kuchno** worked through a scoreless eighth and **Brett McKinney** picked up his first Double-A save with two strikeouts in a perfect ninth. **JaCoby Jones** had an RBI single to plate the only run of the game. **Max Moroff** went 2-for-4 and scored a run.

**CURVE/RUBBERDUCKS SERIES:** The Curve and RubberDucks meet for their final head-to-head series of 2015. The Curve opened their home slate in April by taking three-of-four from the RubberDucks, and followed with two wins in three games at Canal Park to finish the month. The two teams split a four-game set at PNG Field from May 14-17. The Curve avoided a three-game sweep, taking the series finale in Akron with a 2-0 shutout win on June 18. In the most recent series, Akron took three-of-four at Canal Park from July 23-26.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Jason Creasy** makes his 19th start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he picked up his third consecutive loss after allowing seven runs in three innings at Akron. Creasy went 7-0 with a 2.69 ERA in his first ten starts this season up through June 5. Since then, he is 1-4 with a 10.54 ERA in seven starts and one relief outing. The Clayton, N.C. native represented the Curve at the 2015 Eastern League All-Star Game in Portland. *For more on Creasy, see page two.*

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander Adam Plutko makes his 12th start for Akron in his first season at Double-A. Last time out, the Upland, Calif. native allowed one run in seven innings while earning a win over the Curve on July 25. He began the year with A-Adv. Lynchburg of the Carolina League, where he posted a 1.27 ERA and a 4-2 record with the Hillcats in eight starts. 2015 is his second professional season. After leading UCLA to its first-ever College World Series championship in 2013, Plutko was drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the 11th round that summer, but did not make his debut until April 2014 with the Single-A Lake County Captains.

**LIGHTS OUT:** Altoona's starting pitching staff has silenced bats over the last four games, including three straight starts without allowing a run. **Tyler Glasnow** only allowed two runs in six innings against Akron on Sunday while striking out a season-best 12 in a 2-0 loss. On Monday, **Chad Kuhl** worked six scoreless innings against Richmond. **Steven Brault** followed with six scoreless frames on Tuesday with nine punch outs. On Wednesday, **Zack Dodson** pitched seven scoreless innings against the Flying Squirrels. In those four games, Curve starters have posted a 0.72 ERA (2 ER, 25 IP) while allowing just 12 hits and striking out 25 batters.

**SETTING THE TABLE:** Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .357 (65/182) in 45 games and .381 (16/42) in the first inning. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak earlier this month, and followed with a nine-game hitting streak that ended on Monday night against Richmond. He had two hits in each of the last seven games of the streak.

**MAX ATTACKS:** Infielder **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting into July. His 124 hits are the most in the league and he sits third with his .319 average. His .385 on-base percentage is the fifth-best, he is tied for fifth with 44 walks and first with 61 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 168 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter, set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

**HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM:** The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .277 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .285 (796/2798) as a team since May, including a .289 (264/914) team average in July. The Curve have five active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.307), **Adam Frazier** (.246), **Dan Gamache** (.338), **Jose Osuna** (.306) and **Max Moroff** (.319). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard.

**JUST JOSHIN' YA:** First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .307 average that is seventh in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (111, 3rd), RBI (59, 3rd), on-base percentage (.378, 6th), walks (44, T-5th) and triples (6, T-1st). His season-high 17-game on-base streak that began on July 3 was snapped on Saturday night at Akron.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS:** The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.
