**YESTERDAY:** The Curve had a pair of three-run leads disappear twice against the Senators in an 11-9 loss. **Dan Gamache** had three hits for the second straight night and **Sebastian Valle** finished with four RBI. With Altoona leading 7-5 in top of the eighth inning, reliever **John Kuchno** (Loss, 3-4) gave up a single to Wilmer Difo to tie the game. Cutter Dykstra drove in two more runs and Matt Skole extended the advantage to 10-7 to cap the big inning. Altoona trimmed Harrisburg's lead to one run with a two-run homer by Valle in the bottom of the eighth inning. He finished Saturday night's contest 2-for-4 with four RBI and two runs scored. The Curve struck in the first inning with a bases-clearing, three-run double by Gamache to give them a 3-0 lead. After scoring a run in the third, Harrisburg rallied for three runs in the fifth inning, taking a 4-3 lead on an RBI double by Skole. Curve starter **Tyler Glasnow** tossed five innings while scattering six hits and finishing with a season-high eight strikeouts.

**CURVE/SENATORS SERIES:** This series marks the finals set of meetings between the Curve and Senators in 2015. Last week at Metro Bank Park, the Senators swept the Curve in a three-game series. Last time Harrisburg played at PNG Fied, Altoona won 3-of-5 games in late-June.

**FOR ALTOONA:** RHP **Chad Kuhl** makes his 16th start of the 2015 season. Last time out, he allowed three earned runs on six hits in 5.2 innings at Trenton. The Delaware native went seven innings in each of the two starts prior to that rain delayed game at ARM & HAMMER Park. The Pirates aquired Kuhl in the ninth round of the 2013 draft out of the University of Delaware.

**FOR HARRISBURG:** LHP **Richard Bleier** makes his 12th start for the Senators and his 13th overall appearance. He last faced the Curve on June 19, working 7.1 innings, allowing two earned runs on 11 hits with four strikeouts. Bleier was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the sixth round of the 2008 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast.

**CLOSING TIME:** Since June 23, the Curve have lost 10 of 12 games. However, they have held a lead in eight of those 10 losses, and had the go-ahead run score in the next-to-last inning or later in seven of them. After holding the E.L.'s best record at the halfway point of the season, the Curve have now fallen 4.5 games behind the first-place Bowie Baysox in the Western Division.

**TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** With the losses in last Sunday's double-header at Harrisburg, the Curve fell out of first place in the Western Division for the first time since May 7, a span that covered 48 straight games. Prior to May 7, the Curve had led the division for the previous 15 consecutive days. Overall, Altoona sat atop of the Western Division for 63-of-64 games from April 19-June 28.

**SHINING STARS:** The Eastern League's 2015 All-Star rosters were announced on Wednesday, and five Curve players were selected to represent the Western Division during the game on July 15 at Portland's Hadlock Field: **Josh Bell**, **Max Moroff**, **Jason Creasy**, **Dan Gamache** and **Adam Frazier**.

**FANTASTIC FRAZIER:** Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .407 (37/91) in 23 games and .524 in the first inning.

**MAD MAX 2:** **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting into July. His 95 hits are the most in the league and he sits second with his .317 average. His .393 on-base percentage is the third-best, he is second with 40 walks and he leads the E.L. with 49 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak earlier this month, which is tied for the longest among active Curve players with Dan Gamache.

**HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM:** The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .273 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .283 (599/2120) as a team since May 1. The Curve have four active players hitting .300 or better -- **Josh Bell** (.312), **Adam Frazier** (.375), **Dan Gamache** (.320) and **Max Moroff** (.317). However, of those batters, only Bell and Moroff have enough at-bats to qualify for the league leader board.

**JUST JOSHIN' YA:** First baseman **Josh Bell** enters today's game owning a .312 average that is tied for fifth in the Eastern League. The former second-round pick also ranks among the league leaders in hits (91, 2nd), RBI (46, T-4th), on-base percentage (.383, 6th) and triples (6, T-1st).

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut last week, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.

**BACK TO THE FUTURES GAME:** First baseman **Josh Bell** is heading back to the SiriusXM Futures Game for the second straight year, MLB announced on Thursday. Last season, Bell played for the U.S. in Minneapolis at Target Field. This season he will join the U.S. squad on July 12 at Great American Ballpark in Cincinnati. He will be opposed by former Curve catcher **Elias Diaz**, currently a member of the Triple-A Indianapolis Indians, who will be playing for the World team. Curve manager **Tom Prince** will join Ken Griffey, Sr. on the U.S. coaching staff.
