YESTERDAY: The Curve fell behind early and lost to the RubberDucks, 12-2. Akron opened a 3-0 lead in the second, pulled ahead 7-1 through four and added five more runs in the fifth to take a 12-1 lead, with all of the runs charged to Curve starter **Matt Benedict**. **Stetson Allie** hit an RBI single to get Altoona on the board in the second and **Sebastian Valle** added an RBI double in the sixth. Akron's Bryson Myles finished a triple shy of the cycle, going 3-for-4 with four RBI.

CURVE/RUBBERDUCKS SERIES: The Curve and RubberDucks meet for their final head-to-head series of 2015. The Curve opened their home slate in April by taking three-of-four from the RubberDucks, and followed with two wins in three games at Canal Park to finish the month. The two teams split a four-game set at PNG Field from May 14-17. The Curve avoided a three-game sweep, taking the series finale in Akron with a 2-0 shutout win on June 18. In the most recent series, Akron took three-of-four at Canal Park from July 23-26.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Chad Kuhl makes his 21st start for the Curve this season. Last time out, Kuhl worked six scoreless innings but did not earn a decision in a Curve win over Richmond. He leads the team with 12 quality starts through his first 20 outings and has only allowed more than three earned runs only three times. Kuhl was the second-highest drafted pitcher out of the University of Delaware in the last 25 years when the Pirates selected him in the ninth round in 2013. *For more on Kuhl, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Mike Clevenger makes his 21st start of the year for the RubberDucks. In his last outing, he lost to Bowie after giving up three earned runs in 3.2 innings. He is pitching in his first season at Double-A and last faced the Curve on April 28 at PNG Field, when he pitched six innings and allowed one run in a no-decision. In his only other start against the Curve this year, he worked 4.1 innings and allowed one run with six strikeouts at Canal Park on April 18. Clevenger was the fourth-round pick of the Los Angeles Angels in 2011. He was traded to the Indians last August for Vinnie Pestano.

MAKIN' MOVIES: The Curve have seen four players promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis over the last 48 hours, beginning with **Dan Gamache** on Friday. Today, **Josh Bell**, **Tyler Glasnow** and **Jeremy Bleich** were all officially sent to the Indianapolis roster. Shortstop **JaCoby Jones** was traded to the Detroit Tigers for Joakim Soria on Thursday.

SETTING THE TABLE: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .358 (68/190) in 46 games and .386 (17/44) in the first inning. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July, and followed with a nine-game hitting streak that ended on Monday night against Richmond. He had two hits in each of the last seven games of the streak.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting through the entire season. His 124 hits are the most in the league and he sits fifth with his .313 average. His .379 on-base percentage is the fifth-best, he is tied for fifth with 44 walks and first with 61 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 165 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter, set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .276 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .283 (808/2860) as a team since May, including a .284 (268/943) team average in July. The Curve have three active players hitting .300 or better -- **Adam Frazier** (.347), **Jose Osuna** (.306) and **Max Moroff** (.313). However, of those batters, only Moroff has enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard. ___ players were batting over .300 when earning a promotion to Triple-A, including **Dan Gamache** (.335), **Willy Garcia** (.314), **Josh Bell** (.307) and **Keon Broxton** (.302). **JaCoby Jones** hit .385 in his three games before being traded to the Detroit Tigers' organization.

NOT KUHLL-ING OFF: In five July starts, right-hander **Chad Kuhl** went 3-1 and has only surrendered two earned runs over 29.2 innings pitched, good for an ERA of 0.61 ERA. He pitched six scoreless innings in a win over Harrisburg on July 6, and a followed it by allowing just an unearned run in his next outing on July 11 against Bowie. He picked up the first complete game of his career in the first game of a double-header at Richmond on July 17, but two unearned runs in the first inning were enough to charge him with the loss. In a win against Erie on July 22, he had his streak of 24 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run snapped. On July 27 against Richmond, Curve pitched six scoreless, three-hit innings against Richmond but did not receive a decision.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.
