YESTERDAY: After taking a 6-1 lead, the Curve fell in the series opener to the B-Mets, 13-6. **Jose Osuna** hit a three-run homer in the fourth to put Altoona ahead by five, but Binghamton scored 12 unanswered runs to pull away. Rehabbing Pirates reliever **Rob Scahill** worked three scoreless innings to begin the game. **Jason Creasy** (8-7) allowed seven runs (six earned) on seven hits in four innings. Osuna finished the game 2-for-4 with four RBIs and a walk.

TONIGHT: The Curve and Mets play the second of a three-game set at PNG Field. Altoona enters one game behind Akron for second in the Western Division, 5.5 games behind the first-place Bowie Baysox. Binghamton enters sitting second in the Eastern Division, 1.5 games behind first-place Reading. Last time these two teams met, the Curve took two-of-three at PNG Field May 29-31.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Chad Kuhl** makes his 22nd start for the Curve this season. Last time out, Kuhl did not pick up a decision after allowing four earned runs in five innings against Akron on August 1. He is tied for the team lead with 12 quality starts through his first 21 outings and has only allowed more than three earned runs four times. Kuhl was the second-highest drafted pitcher out of the University of Delaware in the last 25 years when the Pirates selected him in the ninth round in 2013. Last season, he led all Pirates' minor league arms and tied the top of the Florida State League with 13 wins. *For more on Kuhl, see page two.*

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Gabriel Ynoa makes his 21st start this season for the B-Mets. Last time out he did not qualify for a decision despite pitching 7.2 innings and holding Trenton to one run on four hits on August 7. He has pitched seven or more innings in nine of his 20 previous starts this year, including a complete-game, one-hit shutout of the Erie SeaWolves on July 2. He went 3-2 with a 1.95 ERA in five starts in July. Ynoa is ranked as the New York Mets' ninth-best prospect according to MLB.com.

SLIDING: With the loss on Tuesday, the Curve fell back to third place in the Western Division for the first time since April 13, five days into the season. From April 16 through June 26, the Curve spent 63-of-64 games in first place in the division. Overall this season, the Curve have spent only eight games out of a potential playoff spot.

SETTING THE TABLE: **Adam Frazier** was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .342 (78/228) in 56 games. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and has not played enough games to qualify for the league leaderboard.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** has continued his hot hitting through the entire season. His 128 hits are the second-most in the league and he sits sixth with his .301 average. His .377 on-base percentage is the fourth-best, he is third with 52 walks and first with 65 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 158 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .274 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .280 (863/3083) as a team since May 1. The Curve have three active players hitting .300 or better -- **Adam Frazier** (.336), **Max Moroff** (.301) and **Jose Osuna** (.304). However, of those batters, only Moroff has enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard. Four players were batting over .300 when earning a promotion to Triple-A, including **Dan Gamache** (.335), **Willy Garcia** (.314), **Josh Bell** (.307) and **Keon Broxton** (.302). **JaCoby Jones** hit .385 in his three games before being traded to the Detroit Tigers' organization.

THE BRAULT VAULT: Curve lefty **Steven Brault** won the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award for July 27-August 2. In two starts, he went 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA, totaling 15 strikeouts in 12 innings. He also went 2-for-2 at the plate against Richmond last Wednesday, driving in two runs on each of his first two professional hits. The La Mesa, Calif. native has picked up a win in each of his last five starts since July 18, posting a 1.20 ERA during that span with 32 strikeouts in 30 innings.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Two former Curve players have joined the ranks of Major Leaguers for the first time in 2015. Former Curve outfielder Alex Dickerson (2013) made his MLB debut with the San Diego Padres on August 6, becoming the 119th Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno (2010-11) made his MLB debut on June 22, appearing in relief for the New York Yankees.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve currently feature three of MLB.com's midseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Barrett Barnes** (16), **Chad Kuhl** (18) and **Steven Brault** (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB.com have been promoted to Triple-A, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Josh Bell** (3) and **Willy Garcia** (12). This year's team has also featured seven of *Baseball America's* preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Bell (4), Garcia (12), **JaCoby Jones** (13, traded to Tigers), **Stetson Allie** (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect.
