

YESTERDAY: After falling behind early, the Curve tied the game with an RBI double by Sebastian Valle in the fourth. The Rock Cats answered with a run on a squeeze play by Joey Wong in the bottom of the inning to take a 2-1 lead and cruised to a 4-1 win over the Curve. Altoona was held to three hits, with two beloning to Eric Wood. Jason Creasy (8-6) allowed two runs over six innings. Shane Carle (12-6) allowed one run on three hits. Noel Cuevas hit a two-run homer for New Britain.

CURVE/ROCK CATS SERIES: For this set, Altoona and New Britain square off for the first time since a three-game home sweep by the Curve from June 2-4. New Britain took two-of-three in the only other series this year at New Britain Stadium, back in late May. This series marks the final set of meetings between the two teams in 2015, and today's game is the final visit to New Britain Stadium for the Curve before the team becomes the Hartford Yard Goats

TONIGHT: The Curve and Rock Cats play the finale of a three-game set at New Britain Stadium. Altoona enters the night four games behind first-place Bowie in the Western Division but locked in a tie with Richmond for second in the division.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Matt Benedict makes his 12th start and 18th overall appearance for the Curve this season. Last time out, he allowed 12 earned runs on 13 hits over 4.2 innings against Akron. As a starter for the Curve, Benedict is 4-4 with a 5.52 ERA. When working out of the bullpen, he is 0-1 with a 10.38 ERA. Benedict was drafted in the 30th round in 2011 by the Pirates out of Western Carolina University. He has also pitched at Triple-A with Indianapolis and with A-Adv. Bradenton this season.

FOR NEW BRITAIN: Right-hander Matt FLemer makes his 21st start for the Rock Cats this season, going along with one relief outing. Last time out, he picked up his second straight win after holding Erie to three earned runs over seven innings. He enters having logged 131.0 innings this year, the second-most in the Eastern League. He has pitched 8.2 innings in two separate starts this year. 2015 is the first season at Double-A for Flemer, who was drafted by the Rockies in the 27th round in 2012 out of Cal. He was named the E.L. Pitcher of the Week on June 22.

MAKIN' MOVIES: Last week, the Curve saw players promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis over 48 hours, beginning with Dan Gamache on Friday. Saturday, Josh Bell, Tyler Glasnow and Jeremy Bleich were all officially sent to the Indianapolis roster. Shortstop JaCoby Jones was traded to the Detroit Tigers for Joakim Soria on Thursday, and is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves.

SETTING THE TABLE: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 (28/66) with a home run and eight RBI, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. Frazier has assumed the everyday leadoff duties, and when batting at the top of the order this season he is hitting .357 (74/207) in 51 games and .354 (17/48) in the first inning. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July, and followed with a nine-game hitting streak that ended on last Monday night against Richmond. He had two hits in each of the last seven games of the streak. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and has not played enough games to qualify for the league leaderboard.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder Max Moroff has continued his hot hitting through the entire season. His 127 hits are the most in the league and he sits third with his .311 average. His .383 on-base percentage is the fourth-best, he is fourth with 50 walks and first with 62 runs scored. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 164 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Curve are leading the 12-team Eastern League in batting average with a .274 clip entering play tonight. After batting .248 in April, the Curve have batted .280 (839/2994) as a team since May 1. The Curve have two active players hitting .300 or better -- Adam Frazier (.348) and Max Moroff (.311). However, of those batters, only Moroff has enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard. Four players were batting over .300 when earning a promotion to Triple-A, including Dan Gamache (.335), Willy Garcia (.314), Josh Bell (.307) and Keon Broxton (.302). JaCoby Jones hit .385 in his three games before being traded to the Detroit Tigers' organization.

THE BRAULT VAULT: Curve lefty Steven Brault won the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award for July 27-August 2. In two starts, he went 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA, totaling 15 strikeouts in 12 innings. He also went 2-for-2 at the

plate against Richmond last Wednesday, driving in two runs on each of his first two professional hits. The La Mesa, Calif. native has picked up a win in each of his last four starts since July 18, posting a 1.57 ERA during that span.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team reocrd for most runs in a game was tied. Jose Osuna also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, Dan Gamache went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno made his MLB debut on June 22, becoming the 118th Altoona Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Appearing in relief for the New York Yankees, Moreno pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts to work around a pair of hits. He was a member of the Curve in 2010 and 2011, appearing in fourteen combined games. He is the first Curve alum to make his MLB debut in 2015.
