**YESTERDAY:** The Curve took the series opener against the Bowie Baysox, 6-3. After falling behind 1-0 in the second, the Curve plated five runs in the sixth to jump ahead. **Eric Wood** scored on a passed ball to tie the game and **Barrett Barnes** hit a two-run double to break the tie. **Erich Weiss** and **Jacob Stallings** each added a sac fly to cap the big inning. Bowie's Garabez Rosa hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the sixth to pull the Baysox back within two. Wood worked a bases-loaded walk in the ninth to put the Curve in front by three. **Jhondaniel Medina** had two strikeouts in the ninth to close out his seventh save. **Zack Dodson** (7-10) stranded the bases loaded in the second and settled in to allow one run over five innings with six strikeouts.

**TONIGHT:** The Curve play the second of a three-game road set against the division-leading Bowie Baysox. The Curve enter the series tied for second place with the Akron RubberDucks for the second and final postseason spot in the E.L. Western Division. The Baysox hold a 5.5-game lead over Akron and Altoona. The Curve swept a three-game set against the Baysox earlier this season and split a four-game series at PNG Field in the Baysox second trip and final to Altoona. After this series, the Curve return to Prince George's Stadium for a four-game series a week from Monday.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Jason Creasy** makes his 22nd start and 24th overall appearance of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he ended a stretch of six losses in seven starts with his first win since 6/21, allowing two runs in seven innings in a win over Richmond on Sunday. Creasy went 7-0 with a 2.69 ERA in his first ten starts this season up through June 5. Since then, he is 2-6 with a 6.79 ERA (43 ER/57 IP) in nine starts and two relief outings. The Clayton, N.C. native represented the Curve at the 2015 Eastern League All-Star Game in Portland. *For more on Creasy, see page two.*

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Gene Escat makes his fourth start and 30th overall appearance for the Baysox this season. As a starter, Escat is 0-1 with a 3.77 ERA. In 26 bullpen appearances, he is 1-3 with a 3.32 ERA. In his last outing, he made his Triple-A debut on Monday in a start for the Norfolk Tides against the Indianapolis Indians (AAA - Pirates), in which he surrendered an RBI single to former Curve first baseman Josh Bell and allowed two total runs in three innings. In his last start for the Baysox, Escat allowed three earned runs in three innings in a loss against Richmond on Aug. 12. Escat was selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the 23rd round of the 2012 MLB Draft out of Fresno State, where he was teammates with current Curve pitcher Tom Harlan. While pitching for the Bulldogs, Escat was part of the 2008 College World Series championship team. As a fifth-year senior in 2012, Escat went 4-0 with a 1.44 ERA.

**SLIDING:** With a loss to Binghamton on August 11, the Curve fell back to third place in the Western Division for the first time since April 13, five days into the season. From April 16 through June 26, the Curve spent 63-of-64 games in first place in the division. Overall this season, the Curve have spent only 16 games out of a potential playoff spot.

**CONNECTION PROBLEMS:** After batting .282 as a team from May 1-July 31, the Curve offense is hitting just .240 (139/578) so far in the month of August. Altoona still holds the top overall offense in the Eastern League for the 2015 season with a .271 average, slightly ahead of Reading (.270).

**BLANK CHECK:** The Curve pitching staff is tied for the Eastern League lead with 13 shutouts pitched this season. On the other side, the Curve offense has only been shut out four times this season, the fewest of any team in the E.L.

**FANTASTIC FRAZIER:** Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 with a home run and eight RBIs, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and had not recorded enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard until Thursday, but now sits at the top of the Eastern League with a .321 average. Brock Holt was the last Curve hitter to win the E.L. batting title when he hit .322 in 2012. Starling Marte recorded the same feat in 2011 with a .332 average.

**MAX ATTACKS:** Infielder **Max Moroff** has 137 hits this season, the second-most in the league, and he sits seventh with his .297 average. His .375 on-base percentage is sixth-best in the league, he is third with 59 walks and first with 71 runs scored. He has played in 120 games, the second-most of any player in the league. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 156 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS:** The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve currently feature three of MLB.com's midseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Barrett Barnes** (16), **Chad Kuhl** (18) and **Steven Brault** (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB.com have been promoted to Triple-A, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Josh Bell** (3) and **Willy Garcia** (12). This year's team has also featured seven of *Baseball America's* preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Bell (4), Garcia (12), **JaCoby Jones** (13, traded to Tigers), **Stetson Allie** (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect entering the year.
