YESTERDAY: The Curve finished a three-game sweep of the Bowie Baysox with a 2-0 shutout behind seven scoreless innings from **Chad Kuhl** (10-4). **Stetson Allie** broke the scoreless tie in the fifth inning with a sacrifice fly. **Eric Wood** added an RBI single in the eighth. **Jose Osuna** had two doubles. **John Kuchno** worked a scoreless eighth inning and **Jhondaniel Medina** closed out his eighth save of the season.

TONIGHT: The Curve open a three-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. The Curve enter tonight's game 3.5 games behind the first-place Bowie Baysox and two games ahead of third-place Akron for the final postseason spot in the Western Division. The Fightins sit in first place in the Eastern Division, 3.5 games ahead of Binghamton. The Curve dropped two-of-three at Reading earlier this season, including a marathon 18-inning game, the longest game played in the Eastern League this season.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Matt Benedict** makes his 15th start and 21st overall appearance for the Curve this season. Last time out, he allowed six earned runs on 10 hits in 4.1 innings in a no-decision against Portland. As a starter for the Curve, Benedict is 5-4 with a 5.03 ERA. When working out of the bullpen, he is 0-1 with a 10.38 ERA in six games. Benedict was drafted in the 30th round in 2011 by the Pirates out of Western Carolina University. He has also pitched at Triple-A with Indianapolis (0-1, 3.60) and with A-Adv. Bradenton (3-1, 2.73) this season.

FOR READING: Right-hander Nick Pivetta makes his fifth start for the Fightin Phils and seventh at Double-A this season. Last time out, he allowed five earned runs in 3.2 in a no-decision against New Hampshire. He began the season with the A-Adv. Potomac Nationals, where he went 7-4 with a 2.29 ERA in 15 games (14 starts) and was named a Carolina League All-Star. He was promoted to Double-A Harrisburg on July 8 and made three starts for the Senators, going 0-2 with a 7.20 ERA. He was traded by the Washington Nationals to the Philadelphia Phillies for closer Jonathan Papelbon on July 28 and joined Reading.

PLAYOFF HUNT: Saturday night's win moved the Curve back into second place in the Western Division after sitting in third place for 13 days. With a loss to Binghamton on August 11, the Curve fell back to third place in the Western Division for the first time since April 13, five days into the season. From April 16 through June 26, the Curve spent 63-of-64 games in first place in the division. Overall this season, the Curve have spent only 17 games out of a potential playoff spot.

CONNECTION PROBLEMS: After batting .282 as a team from May 1-July 31, the Curve offense is hitting just .248 (160/646) so far in the month of August. Altoona still holds the top overall offense in the Eastern League for the 2015 season with a .272 average, slightly ahead of Reading (.269).

BLANK CHECK: The Curve pitching staff is tied for the Eastern League lead with 14 shutouts pitched this season, including Sunday's blanking of the Bowie Baysox. On the other side, the Curve offense has only been shut out four times this season, the fewest of any team in the E.L.

FANTASTIC FRAZIER: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 with a home run and eight RBIs, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and had not recorded enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard until Aug. 20, but now sits at the top of the Eastern League with a .329 average. Brock Holt was the last Curve hitter to win the E.L. batting title when he hit .322 in 2012. Starling Marte recorded the same feat in 2011 with a .332 average.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** has 137 hits this season, the third-most in the league, and he sits eighth with his .293 average. His .372 on-base percentage is seventh-best in the league, he is third with 61 walks and first with 72 runs scored. He has played in 122 games, the second-most of any player in the league. After compiling a 30-game on-base streak and an 11-game hitting streak earlier this season, he went on a 12-game hitting streak in June. Moroff is on pace for 153 hits this season, which would break the record for most by a Curve switch hitter set by Shawn Garrett at 142 in 2002. The overall franchise record for the most hits in a season is 178, set by Starling Marte in 2011.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 17, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new record.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve currently feature three of MLB.com's midseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Barrett Barnes** (16), **Chad Kuhl** (18) and **Steven Brault** (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB.com have been promoted to Triple-A, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Josh Bell** (3) and **Willy Garcia** (12). This year's team has also featured seven of *Baseball America's* preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Bell (4), Garcia (12), **JaCoby Jones** (13, traded to Tigers), **Stetson Allie** (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect entering the year.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Two former Curve players have joined the ranks of Major Leaguers for the first time in 2015. Former Curve outfielder Alex Dickerson (2013) made his MLB debut with the San Diego Padres on August 6, becoming the 119th Curve alumnus to reach the big leagues. Former Curve relief pitcher Diego Moreno (2010-11) made his MLB debut on June 22, appearing in relief for the New York Yankees.
