YESTERDAY: The Baysox rolled to an 11-3 win over the Curve in Game 4. Altoona starter **Steven Brault** allowed six earned runs on nine hits over 4.2 innings. **Austin Meadows** and **Jacob Stallings** each had three hits. **Barrett Barnes** and **Eric Wood** each had an RBI. Bowie's Quincy Latimore went 4-for-5 with two home runs, two doubles, six RBIs and three runs scored.

TONIGHT: The Curve face the Bowie Baysox in Game 4 of the Western Division Series, the first postseason series for the Curve since they won the E.L. Championship over Trenton in 2010. The Curve went 9-5 against Bowie this season. They swept a three-game series against the Baysox at PNG Field May 11-13 and split four games at home July 10-13. Altoona swept Bowie again in a three-game set at Prince George's Stadium Aug. 21-23 and dropped three-of-four in Bowie Aug. 31-Sept. 3.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Jason Creasy** made 25 starts and 27 overall appearances this season for the Curve. In his last start, he worked six innings and allowed one earned run in a win at Binghamton on 9/6. Last he faced the Baysox, he picked up a win at Bowie allowing two earned runs over six innings on 9/1. Creasy went 7-0 with a 2.69 ERA in his first ten starts this season up through June 5. Since then, he is 5-8 with a 5.72 ERA (53 ER/83.1 IP) in 14 starts and two relief outings. The Clayton, N.C. native represented the Curve at the 2015 Eastern League All-Star Game in Portland. *For more on Creasy, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander David Hess made two Double-A starts for the Baysox, going 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA. In his Double-A debut on Sept. 1, he allowed four earned runs in 3.1 innings against the Curve in Bowie. In his last start, he picked up his first Double-A win, working 6.1 innings and allowing one earned run with eight strikeouts at Erie on Sept. 6. Prior to his promotion to Bowie, Hess went 9-4 with a 3.58 ERA for the A-Adv. Frederick Keys in 26 games (25 starts). Over his last 12 starts for Frederick, he went 7-0 with a 1.34 ERA after beginning the year 2-4 with a 5.83 ERA in his first 14 games. In August, Hess went 4-0 with a 0.99 ERA. He was picked in the fifth round of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Tennessee Tech.

PLAYOFF HISTORY: The Curve make their sixth Eastern League postseason appearance in 2015. Altoona first qualified for the playoffs in 2003 as a wild card team and lost in the Division Series to Akron in four games. The Curve won the division for the first time in 2004 and swept Erie in the Division Series, but New Hampshire swept the Championship Series in three games. The Curve returned as a wild card team again in 2004 and 2005, but lost a decisive fifth game in the Division series to Akron in back-to-back years. In 2010, Altoona won its second regular-season division title and beat Harrisburg four games to advance to the Championship Series against Trenton. The Thunder won the first game in extra innings, but the Curve won the next three to clinch its first-ever Eastern League Championship.

BLANK CHECK: The Curve pitching staff led the Eastern League lead with a franchise-record 16 shutouts pitched this season, including last Friday's blanking of the Binghamton Mets. On the other side, the Curve offense was shut out only five times this season, the fewest of any team in the E.L.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder **Max Moroff** had a breakout season in 2015. He posted a .293 batting average, the eighth-best in the league. He also ranked among the league leaders in games played (136, 1st), runs (79, 1st), hits (153, 2nd), total bases (214, 4th) and walks (70, 3rd). The infielder also had the highest fielding percentage (.978) among qualifying second basemen and led all E.L. second basemen in assists (330) and double plays (76) and finished second in putouts (215). With 153 hits this year, Moroff set a new record for the most in a season by a switch-hitter in Curve franchise history. He posted a 30-game on-base streak from April 10-May 15, the longest of any player in the league this year. He was named to the E.L. Mid-Season All-Star Team and Post-Season All-Star Team.

FANTASTIC FRAZIER: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 with a home run and eight RBIs, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and had not recorded enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard until Aug. 20, and sat at the top of the Eastern League with a .324 average, leading the E.L., but the league batting title was awarded to Bowie's Trey Mancini.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On Aug. 26, Max Moroff recorded his 143rd hit this season, breaking the single-season franchise record for hits by a switch-hitter, originally set by Shawn Garrett in 2002. With a 5-0 win at New Britain on Aug. 6, the Curve set a new franchise high for the most shutouts in a season with 12 (now at 16). The previous high was 11, totaled three times (2004, 06, 11). On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 16, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new team record. On Aug. 24, Matt Benedict allowing 14 hits in a game, tying the single-game team record.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve currently feature four of MLB.com's mid-season top 30 Pirates prospects: **Austin Meadows** (2), **Barrett Barnes** (16), **Chad Kuhl** (18) and **Steven Brault** (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB.com have been promoted to Triple-A, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Josh Bell** (3) and **Willy Garcia** (12). This year's team has also featured seven of *Baseball America's* preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Meadows (3), Bell (4), Garcia (12), **JaCoby Jones** (13, traded to Tigers), **Stetson Allie** (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect entering the year.
