**YESTERDAY:** The Curve bats were silenced in a 4-0 shutout by the Baysox. Joe Gunkel (10-5) held the Curve off the scoreboard for seven innings. **Chad Kuhl** (11-5) allowed three runs (one earned) on three hits and one walk with five strikeouts. In his Double-A debut, **Austin Meadows** totaled two hits. **Jacob Stallings** had the only other two hits in the game for the Curve.

**TONIGHT:** The Curve face the Bowie Baysox in the finale of a four-game set at Prince George's Stadium, looking for a series split. The Curve swept the Baysox in a three-game set in their only other trip to Bowie, Aug. 21-23. The Curve enter play tonight trailing the division-leading Baysox by 5.5 games in the Western Division standings and hold a three-game lead over Akron and Richmond for the second and final playoff spot from the division.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Tyler Eppler makes his Double-A debut after receiving a promotion to Altoona yesterday. In 12 starts and two relief outings with A-Adv. Bradenton, Eppler went 6-1 with a 2.58 ERA. In each of his last three starts with the Marauders, he pitched seven innings without allowing an earned run. Overall, he did not surrender an earned run in his final four starts with Bradenton, a span of 26.2 innings. Eppler was drafted in the sixth round in 2014 out of Sam Houston State. *For more on Eppler, see page two.*

**FOR BOWIE:** Lefty Nick Additon makes his sixth start for the Baysox. He began the season with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. Originally drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 47th round in 2006, Additon became a free agent after the 2013 season and signed a minor league deal with the Baltimore Orioles. He pitched with Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk in 2014 and signed a free agent contract with the Brewers after the season. Milwaukee released him on Aug. 2, and he once again joined the Baltimore organization as a minor league free agent.

**PLAYOFF HUNT:** A win on Aug. 22 moved the Curve back into second place in the Western Division after sitting in third place for 13 days. With a loss to Binghamton on August 11, the Curve fell back to third place in the Western Division for the first time since April 13, five days into the season. From April 16 through June 26, the Curve spent 63-of-64 games in first place in the division. Overall this season, the Curve have spent only 17 games out of a potential playoff spot.

**BLANK CHECK:** The Curve pitching staff leads the Eastern League lead with a franchise record 15 shutouts pitched this season, including Sunday's blanking of the Trenton Thunder. On the other side, the Curve offense has only been shut out five times this season, the fewest of any team in the E.L.

**FANTASTIC FRAZIER:** Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 with a home run and eight RBIs, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and had not recorded enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard until Aug. 20, but now sits at the top of the Eastern League with a .323 average. Brock Holt was the last Curve hitter to win the E.L. batting title when he hit .322 in 2012. Starling Marte recorded the same feat in 2011 with a .332 average.

**MAX ATTACKS:** Infielder Max Moroff is having a breakout season in 2015. He has posted a .295 batting average, the ninth-best in the league. He also ranks among the league leaders in games played (132, T-1st), runs (76, 1st), hits (150, T-2nd), total bases (208, 3rd) and walks (67, 3rd). The infielder also has the highest fielding percentage (.978) among qualifying second basemen and leads all E.L. second basemen in putouts (214), assists (329) and double plays (76). With 150 hits this year, Moroff has set a new record for the most in a season by a switch-hitter in Curve franchise history. He posted a 30-game on-base streak from April 10-May 15, the longest of any player in the league this year. On Friday he was named to the E.L. Post-Season All-Star Team.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS:** The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On Aug. 26, Max Moroff recorded his 143rd hit this season, breaking the single-season franchise record for hits by a switch-hitter, originally set by Shawn Garrett in 2002. With a 5-0 win at New Britain on Aug. 6, the Curve set a new franchise high for the most shutouts in a season with 12 (now at 15). The previous high was 11, totaled three times (2004, 06, 11). On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 16, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new team record. On Aug. 24, Matt Benedict allowing 14 hits in a game, tying the single-game team record.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve currently feature four of MLB.com's mid-season top 30 Pirates prospects: **Austin Meadows** (2), **Barrett Barnes** (16), **Chad Kuhl** (18) and **Steven Brault** (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB.com have been promoted to Triple-A, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Josh Bell** (3) and **Willy Garcia** (12). This year's team has also featured seven of *Baseball America's* preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Meadows (3), Bell (4), Garcia (12), **JaCoby Jones** (13, traded to Tigers), **Stetson Allie** (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect entering the year.
