YESTERDAY: The Curve fell victim to a five-run third inning and lost to the Bowie Baysox, 6-3. **Jacob Stallings** doubled in a run in the second to put the Curve in front early, but the Baysox poured on five runs against Altoona starter **Tyler Eppler** in the third capped by a three-run homer from Quincy Latimore. Stallings added a solo homer in the seventh, his third of the year. **Brett McKinney**, **Josh Smith** and **Montana DuRapau** each posted scoreless work out of the bullpen.

TONIGHT: The Curve face the Binghamton Mets in the first of four games in final series of the 2015 regular season. The Curve enter play tonight with a two-game lead over Akron and Richmond for the second and final playoff spot from the Western Division. Binghamton has clinched the Eastern Division wild card.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty **Steven Brault** makes his 15th Double-A start for the Curve. Last time out, Brault worked seven scoreless innings in a win over Trenton at PNG Field on Aug. 30. In nine starts since July 18, Brault is 7-0 with a 1.10 ERA, the lowest in all of Double-A baseball. Tonight marks his first start against the B-Mets. Brault was the 11th-round draft pick of the Baltimore Orioles in 2013 out of NCAA DII Regis University. He was traded to the Pirates this offseason along with pitcher Stephen Tarpley for Travis Snider. **For more on Brault, see page two.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Robert Gsellman makes his 16th Double-A start for the B-Mets. Last time out, he allowed one earned run over seven innings in a no-decision against New Hampshire. In his last seven starts, Gsellman is 4-1 with a 1.56 ERA. He has made two starts against the Curve this season, including his Double-A debut on May 30 at PNG Field, when he allowed a season-high six earned runs over four innings in a loss. On Aug. 12, he gave up four runs (one earned) on just three hits in five innings in a loss at Altoona. Gsellman was a 13th round pick of the New York Mets in 2011 and began this season with A-Adv. St. Lucie, where he was a Florida State League All-Star. He was promoted to Double-A on May 28.

PLAYOFF HUNT: A win on Aug. 22 moved the Curve back into second place in the Western Division after sitting sitting in third place for 13 days. With a loss to Binghamton on August 11, the Curve fell back to third place in the Western Division for the first time since April 13, five days into the season. From April 16 through June 26, the Curve spent 63-of-64 games in first place in the division. Overall this season, the Curve have spent only 17 games out of a potential playoff spot.

BLANK CHECK: The Curve pitching staff leads the Eastern League lead with a franchise record 15 shutouts pitched this season, including Sunday's blanking of the Trenton Thunder. On the other side, the Curve offense has only been shut out five times this season, the fewest of any team in the E.L.

FANTASTIC FRAZIER: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 with a home run and eight RBIs, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and had not recorded enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard until Aug. 20, but now sits at the top of the Eastern League with a .323 average. Brock Holt was the last Curve hitter to win the E.L. batting title when he hit .322 in 2012. Starling Marte recorded the same feat in 2011 with a .332 average.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder Max Moroff is having a breakout season in 2015. He has posted a .294 batting average, the ninth-best in the league. He also ranks among the league leaders in games played (133, 1st), runs (76, T-1st), hits (150, T-2nd), total bases (208, T-3rd) and walks (68, 3rd). The infielder also has the highest fielding percentage (.978) among qualifying second basemen and leads all E.L. second basemen in putouts (215), assists (329) and double plays (76). With 150 hits this year, Moroff has set a new record for the most in a season by a switch-hitter in Curve franchise history. He posted a 30-game on-base streak from April 10-May 15, the longest of any player in the league this year. On Friday he was named to the E.L. Post-Season All-Star Team.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On Aug. 26, Max Moroff recorded his 143rd hit this season, breaking the single-season franchise record for hits by a switch-hitter, originally set by Shawn Garrett in 2002. With a 5-0 win at New Britain on Aug. 6, the Curve set a new franchise high for the most shutouts in a season with 12 (now at 15). The previous high was 11, totaled three times (2004, 06, 11). On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. **Jose Osuna** also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, **Dan Gamache** went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 16, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new team record. On Aug. 24, Matt Benedict allowing 14 hits in a game, tying the single-game team record.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve currently feature four of MLB.com's mid-season top 30 Pirates prospects: **Austin Meadows** (2), **Barrett Barnes** (16), **Chad Kuhl** (18) and **Steven Brault** (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB.com have been promoted to Triple-A, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Josh Bell** (3) and **Willy Garcia** (12). This year's team has also featured seven of *Baseball America's* preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Meadows (3), Bell (4), Garcia (12), **JaCoby Jones** (13, traded to Tigers), **Stetson Allie** (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect entering the year.
