YESTERDAY: The Curve clinched the Western Division wild card with a 4-1 win over the Binghamton Mets. Adam Frazier led off the game with a solo home run. After a lead-off triple by Austin Meadows in the fourth, Barrett Barnes clubbed an RBI double to extend the lead to 2-0. The B-Mets plated a run in the sixth, but Max Moroff answered with a two-run double in the seventh to stretch the Curve advantage to 4-1. Jason Creasy (12-8) worked six innings and allowed one run on four hits. Brett McKinney pitched through the seventh and Jhondaniel Medina picked up a six-out save, his 12th of the season.

TONIGHT: The Curve face the Binghamton Mets in the regular-season finale and the final game of the 2015 regular season. The Curve enter play tonight having clinched the Western Division Wild Card, eliminating Richmond and Akron with last night's win. Binghamton has clinched the Eastern Division wild card.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Tom Harlan makes his fifth start and his 37th overall apperance this season. As a starter, the San Bruno, Calif. native is 2-0 with a 3.15 ERA. His last start came on Aug. 7, when he pitched five innings and allowed one run on five hits against Richmond. Harlan has mostly worked in the bullpen in 2015 after working as a starter with the Curve last year. The Pirates drafted him in the 13th round in 2012 out of Fresno State. FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Mickey Jannis makes his third Double-A start for the Binghamton Mets. Last time out, he allowed two earned runs on three hits over seven innings in a loss at Readong on Sept. 3. He made his Double-A. He was originally selected by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 44th round of the 2010 draft. He spent time in independent baseball from 2012-2015, playing for Lake Erie, Bridgeport, Southern Maryland and Long Island, as well as a stretch with Brisbane in the Australian Baseball League in 2013, prior to signing with the Mets on a minor league deal in July. In eight games (seven starts) for A-Adv. St. Lucie, Jannis went 2-1 with a 2.98 ERA before his promotion to Double-A on Aug. 19.

PLAYOFF HUNT: A win on Aug. 22 moved the Curve back into second place in the Western Division after sitting sitting in third place for 13 days. With a loss to Binghamton on August 11, the Curve fell back to third place in the Western Division for the first time since April 13, five days into the season. From April 16 through June 26, the Curve spent 63-of-64 games in first place in the division. Overall this season, the Curve have spent only 17 games out of a potential playoff spot.

BLANK CHECK: The Curve pitching staff leads the Eastern League lead with a franchise record 16 shutouts pitched this season, including Friday's blanking of the Binghamton Mets. On the other side, the Curve offense has only been shut out five times this season, the fewest of any team in the E.L.

FANTASTIC FRAZIER: Adam Frazier was on fire in June, batting .424 with a home run and eight RBIs, raising his overall average from .293 on June 1 to .363 at the end of the month. He went on a career-best 15-game hitting streak in July. Frazier missed the beginning of the season after breaking a finger in Spring Training and had not recorded enough at-bats to qualify for the league leaderboard until Aug. 20, but now sits at the top of the Eastern League with a .321 average. Brock Holt was the last Curve hitter to win the E.L. batting title when he hit .322 in 2012. Starling Marte recorded the same feat in 2011 with a .332 average.

MAX ATTACKS: Infielder Max Moroff is having a breakout season in 2015. He has posted a .293 batting average, the eighth-best in the league. He also ranks among the league leaders in games played (136, 1st), runs (79, 1st), hits (153, 2nd), total bases (214, 4th) and walks (70, 3rd). The infielder also has the highest fielding percentage (.978) among qualifying second basemen and leads all E.L. second basemen in putouts (215), assists (329) and double plays (76). With 151 hits this year, Moroff has set a new record for the most in a season by a switch-hitter in Curve franchise history. He posted a 30-game on-base streak from April 10-May 15, the longest of any player in the league this year. On Friday he was named to the E.L. Post-Season All-Star Team.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve have set a handful of new franchise records in 2015. On Aug. 26, Max Moroff recorded his 143rd hit this season, breaking the single-season franchise record for hits by a switch-hitter, originally set by Shawn Garrett in 2002. With a 5-0 win at New Britain on Aug. 6, the Curve set a new franchise high for the most shutouts in a season with 12 (now at 16). The previous high was 11, totaled three times (2004, 06, 11). On July 21, the offense totaled 24 hits, the most in a single game in team history, in a seven-inning win over Erie. In the same game, which Altoona won, 18-7, the team record for most runs in a game was tied. Jose Osuna also set a new individual single-game franchise record by scoring five runs. On May 25, Dan Gamache went 5-for-5, tying the

Curve franchise record for most hits in a game by a single player. On May 16, the Altoona pitchers combined for 13 walks, setting a new team record. On Aug. 24, Matt Benedict allowing 14 hits in a game, tying the single-game team record.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve currently feature four of MLB.com's midseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Austin Meadows (2), Barrett Barnes (16), Chad Kuhl (18) and Steven Brault (25). Three other prospects ranked by MLB. com have been promoted to Triple-A, including Tyler Glasnow (1), Josh Bell (3) and Willy Garcia (12). This year's team has also featured seven of Baseball America's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Glasnow (1), Meadows (3), Bell (4), Garcia (12), JaCoby Jones (13, traded to Tigers), Stetson Allie (21), Barnes (23) and Kuhl (28). Brault was B.A.'s 18th-ranked Baltimore Orioles prospect entering the year.
