TONIGHT: The Curve begin their 18th season with tonight's opener at Peoples Natural Gas Field. Last season, the Curve posted a 74-68 record and made the Eastern League playoffs for the first time since their 2010 championship. Harrisburg went 67-75 last year and finished fifth in the Western Division. In the first 17 seasons of Eastern League baseball in Altoona, the Curve have posted a 1206-1198 record, won two division championships and qualified for the postseason six times. 123 former Curve players have made their way to the Majors since the club's first season in 1999.

CURVE/SENATORS SERIES: For the second consecutive season, the Curve open the year against the Harrisburg Senators, the Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Altoona owns a 4-0 all-time record against the Senators in season openers. Last year, the Curve picked up a late run in Pennsylvania's capital city to defeat the Senators, 1-0. Altoona holds a 167-142 all-time record against Harrisburg, including a 91-55 mark at PNG Field. In 2015, the Curve went 9-11 against the Senators and 5-5 at home.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Jason Creasy takes the mound as the Opening Day starter for the Curve. Tonight marks the beginning of Creasy's second season with Altoona. He spent all of 2015 with the Curve. Creasy was an Eastern League All-Star and led the Curve with 12 wins last season. *For more on Creasy, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander John Simms gets the nod as the Opening Day starter for the Senators. The former Rice Owl spent most of last season with A-Adv. Potomac, but did make eight starts for Harrisburg, going 2-3 with a 4.40 ERA. Over all in 2015, Simms made 23 appearances (22 starts) and had an 8-9 record with a 3.30 ERA between Potomac and Harrisburg.

OPENING DAY NOTES: The Curve are 7-10 over their previous 17 season openers. When opening the season in Altoona, the Curve are 6-2, but have gone just 1-8 in openers on the road. The Curve are 5-10 on Opening Day against teams from their own division, and 4-4 against National League affiliates. An Altoona starting pitcher has not earned an Opening Day win since 2010 when **Mike Crotta** earned a victory against the Senators (Angel Sanchez did not pick up a decision in 2015).

ROSTER: The 2016 Curve roster has 12 players that have worn a Curve uniform prior to this season. 13 will be playing at the Double-A level for the first time in their career. There are 12 pitchers and 13 position players on the Curve roster, including one member of the Pirates' 40-man roster (Harold Ramirez).

A NEW SKIPPER: Former Major League All-Star Joey Cora takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30). B.A. also named Ramirez as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average," Eppler as having the "Best Changeup" and McGuire as the "Best Defensive Catcher."

SPRING TRAINING: Prior to heading north to Altoona, 13 members of the Curve roster played in Major League Spring Training games for the Pirates this year. Eleven position players, including Jon Schwind, Jose Osuna, Harold Ramirez, Reese McGuire, Barrett Barnes, Chris Diaz, Erich Weiss, Eric Wood, Stetson Allie, Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz all got plate appearances in big league games. Relievers Montana DuRapau and Dovydas Neverauskas were the only two pitchers on the Curve roster that saw action in MLB Spring Training games.

GOING STREAKING: Curve relief pitcher Josh Smith enters the 2016 campaign on a 17-inning scoreless streak, dating back to July 20, 2015 (12 outings). During his streak, Smith has fanned 10 batters, walked six and decided in a victory (8/7/15 v. RIC). The Missouri southpaw also saw his ERA drop more than two full points, finishing 2015 with a 5.29 ERA after beginning his scoreless streak with a 7.34 clip.

GLOBAL AFFAIR: Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's Opening Day roster, including the United States (17), Canada (1), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher Dovydas Neverauskas became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen Eric Wood was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and reliever Jhondaniel Medina and infielder Jose Osuna both call Venezuela home. Outfielder Harold Ramirez represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher Jin-De Jhang is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.
