LAST TIME OUT: Altoona and Harrisburg were in a back-and-forth affair through four innings before the Senators used three two-run frames to pull away from the Curve on their way to scoring 10 runs for a second straight game as the Curve fell 10-4 on Friday night. Altoona outfielder Stetson Allie launched the Curve's first home run of the season, and catcher Jin-De Jhang doubled in each of his first two Double-A at-bats.

TONIGHT: The Curve and Senators play the finale of the, season-opening series after Saturday's game was postponed due to weather conditions. A makeup date between the two squads will be announced at a later date.

CURVE/SENATORS SERIES: For the second consecutive season, the Curve open the year against the Harrisburg Senators, the Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Altoona owns a 4-1 all-time record against the Senators in season openers. Last year, the Curve picked up a late run in Pennsylvania's capital city to defeat the Senators, 1-0. Altoona holds a 167-144 all-time record against Harrisburg, including a 91-57 mark at PNG Field. In 2015, the Curve went 9-11 against the Senators and 5-5 at home.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Tyler Eppler makes his second career regular season start for the Curve, after making his Double-A debut last September (9/3). Eppler also tossed the second game of the E.L. Division Series last year against Bowie on 9/10, deciding in the loss after surrendering three runs over six frames. For more on Holmes, see

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Reynaldo Lopez gets the nod for the Senators, and looks to improve upon a 6-7 record from 2015, where he logged a 4.09 ERA over 19 starts (99.0 innings). Last season marked just his second losing campaign of his four-year career, despite striking out a career-best 94 hitters while with Potomac. Entering the season, Lopez was ranked the fifth-best prospect in the Nationals system by Baseball

THIS YEAR'S CURVE: The 2016 Curve roster has 12 players that have worn a Curve uniform prior to this season. 13 will be playing at the Double-A level for the first time in their career. There are 12 pitchers and 13 position players on the Curve roster, including one member of the Pirates' 40-man roster (Harold Ramirez).

A NEW SKIPPER: Former Major League All-Star Joey Cora takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30). B.A. also named Ramirez as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average," Eppler as having the "Best Changeup" and McGuire as the "Best Defensive Catcher."

SPRING TRAINING: Prior to heading north to Altoona, 13 members of the Curve roster played in Major League Spring Training games for the Pirates this year. Eleven position players, including Jon Schwind, Jose Osuna, Harold Ramirez, Reese McGuire, Barrett Barnes, Chris Diaz, Erich Weiss, Eric Wood, Stetson Allie, Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz all got plate appearances in big league games. Relievers Montana DuRapau and Dovydas Neverauskas were the only two pitchers on the Curve roster that saw action in MLB Spring Training games.

GOING STREAKING: Curve relief pitcher Josh Smith extended his scoreless streak to 18-innings after tossing a scoreless eighth frame last night in relief for **Dovydas Neveraskas**. Smith's streak dates back to July 20, 2015 and now spans 13 outings, during which he has fanned 10 batters, walked six and decided in a victory (8/7/15 v. RIC). The Missouri southpaw also saw his ERA drop more than two full points last season, finishing 2015 with a 5.29 ERA after beginning the streak with a 7.34 clip.

GLOBAL AFFAIR: Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's Opening Day roster, including the United States (17), Canada (1), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher Dovydas Neverauskas became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen Eric Wood was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the  $2012\ \text{MLB}$ Draft. Infielders Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and reliever Jhondaniel Medina and infielder Jose Osuna both call Venezuela home. Outfielder Harold Ramirez represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher Jin-De Jhang is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.

AIN'T IT GRAND? Friday night saw a pair of Curve alumni hit their first career grand slam to help their teams capture comeback wins. Brock Holt, now with the Red Sox, launched his in the top of the 6th against Toronto, while Starling Marte took Cincinnati reliever J.J. Hoover deep in the top of the 8th to give the Pirates a victory over the Reds to move to 4-0 on the season.
