LAST TIME OUT: Altoona notched its first win of the 2016 season behind six quality innings from Tyler Eppler, who scattered just three hits and two runs. Eppler got some early offense to support him, as the Curve scored in each of the first two innings to jump out to a 2-0 lead, and would never trail. First baseman Jose Osuna cracked his first home run of the season in the victory, while reliever Montana DuRapau earned his first career Double-A save.

TONIGHT: The Curve and welcome in the Akron RubberDucks for a three-game mid-week series. Akron comes off a three-game sweep over the reigning E.L. Champion Bowie BaySox. Both Altoona and Akron saw one game get postponed due to weather over the weekend.

CURVE/RUBBERDUCKS SERIES: Akron comes to town with a lead in the all-time series between the two squads, as the RubberDucks have won 198 games to the Curve's 160. However, a win tonight for Altoona would even the alltime series record at Peoples Natural Gas Field.

FOR ALTOONA: For the first time this season, Altoona starts a southpaw as Texas native Cody Dickson toes the slab for the Curve. Dickson spent the entirety of 2015 with Bradenton, racking up a 12-7 record with a 4.13 ERA across 27 games. Tonight marks the Double-A debut for the former Sam Houston State Bearkat. For more on Dickson, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Southpaw Rob Kaminsky makes his first career Double-A start, and begins his first full season in the Cleveland Indians organization, after being dealt by the Cardinals for Brandon Moss at last year's trade deadline. In total last year, Kaminsky went 6-6 with a 2.24 ERA, and enters the 2016 season as the 9th best prospect in the Indians system, according to Baseball America.

THIS YEAR'S CURVE: The 2016 Curve roster has 12 players that have worn a Curve uniform prior to this season. 13 will be playing at the Double-A level for the first time in their career. There are 12 pitchers and 13 position players on the Curve roster, including one member of the Pirates' 40-man roster (Harold Ramirez). The average age of the Curve's Opening Day roster is 23.68.

A NEW SKIPPER: Former Major League All-Star Joey Cora takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30). B.A. also named Ramirez as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average," Eppler as having the "Best Changeup" and McGuire as the "Best Defensive Catcher."

SPRING TRAINING: Prior to heading north to Altoona, 13 members of the Curve roster played in Major League Spring Training games for the Pirates this year. Eleven position players, including Jon Schwind, Jose Osuna, Harold Ramirez, Reese McGuire, Barrett Barnes, Chris Diaz, Erich Weiss, Eric Wood, Stetson Allie, Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz all got plate appearances in big league games. Relievers Montana DuRapau and Dovydas Neverauskas were the only two pitchers on the Curve roster that saw action in MLB Spring Training games.

GOING STREAKING: Curve relief pitcher Josh Smith extended his scoreless streak to 19-innings after tossing a scoreless seventh frame yesterday in relief working despite issuing three walks. Smith's streak dates back to July 20, 2015 and now spans 14 outings, during which he has fanned 10 batters, walked nine and decided in a victory (8/7/15 v. RIC). The Missouri southpaw also saw his ERA drop more than two full points last season, finishing 2015 with a 5.29 ERA after beginning the streak with a 7.34 clip.

GLOBAL AFFAIR: Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's Opening Day roster, including the United

States (17), Canada (1), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher Dovydas Neverauskas became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen Eric Wood was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and reliever Jhondaniel Medina and infielder Jose Osuna both call Venezuela home. Outfielder Harold Ramirez represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher Jin-De Jhang is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.

AIN'T IT GRAND? Friday night saw a pair of Curve alumni hit their first career grand slam to help their teams capture comeback wins. Brock Holt, now with the Red Sox, launched his in the top of the 6th against Toronto, while Starling Marte took Cincinnati reliever J.J. Hoover deep in the top of the 8th to give the Pirates a victory over the Reds to move to 4-0 on the season.
