**LAST NIGHT:** Altoona once again avoided a three-game sweep by exploding for five runs in the bottom of the first, capped off by a two-run single by **Eric Wood** against Akron starter Adam Plutko. Five Curve hitters recorded multi-hit nights, led by **Erich Weiss**, who had a three-hit day, while also scoring three runs. **Anderson Feliz** also knocked two doubles for Altoona, as **Jason Creasy** picked up his first win of the season.

**TONIGHT:** The Curve hit the road for the first time in 2016 as they head to The Diamond in Richmond, Virginia to take on the Flying Squirrels (Double-A/San Francisco Giants). Altoona holds a six-game lead in the all-time series between the two squads, 66-60, but the teams split last year's series evenly, 10-10. The Curve are 23-33 all-time in Richmond.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Clay Holmes** makes his second start of the season for Altoona, and will look to fare better than he did in his first outing, when he gave up six runs on five hits in just over four innings against Harrisburg. Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. **For more on Creasy, see page two.**

**FOR RICHMOND:** Southpaw Adalberto Mejia gets the nod for Richmond, after tossing five scoreless innings with only two hits surrendered in his first start this year on 4/8 against Hartford. In 2015, the Dominican Republic native went 5-2 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 appearances for the Flying Squirrels (nine starts). Mejia enters the 2016 season as the 10th best prospect in the Giants organization, according to *Baseball America*.

**THIS YEAR'S CURVE:** The 2016 Curve roster has 12 players that have worn a Curve uniform prior to this season. 13 will be playing at the Double-A level for the first time in their career. There are 12 pitchers and 13 position players on the Curve roster, including one member of the Pirates' 40-man roster (**Harold Ramirez**). The average age of the Curve's roster is 23.68.

**A NEW SKIPPER:** Former Major League All-Star **Joey Cora** takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30). B.A. also named Ramirez as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average," Eppler as having the "Best Changeup" and McGuire as the "Best Defensive Catcher."

**SPRING TRAINING:** Prior to heading north to Altoona, 13 members of the Curve roster played in Major League Spring Training games for the Pirates this year. Eleven position players, including **Jon Schwind**, **Jose Osuna**, **Harold Ramirez**, **Reese McGuire**, **Barrett Barnes**, **Chris Diaz**, **Erich Weiss**, **Eric Wood**, **Stetson Allie**, **Edwin Espinal** and **Anderson Feliz** all got plate appearances in big league games. Relievers **Montana DuRapau** and **Dovydas Neverauskas** were the only two pitchers on the Curve roster that saw action in MLB Spring Training games.

**GOING STREAKING:** Curve relief pitcher **Josh Smith** extended his scoreless streak to 20 innings after tossing a scoreless seventh frame on Tuesday in relief. Smith's streak dates back to July 20, 2015 and now spans 14 outings, during which he has fanned 10 batters, walked nine and decided in a victory (8/7/15 v. RIC). The Missouri southpaw also saw his ERA drop more than two full points last season, finishing 2015 with a 5.29 ERA after beginning the streak with a 7.34 clip.

**GLOBAL AFFAIR:** Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's Opening Day roster, including the United States (17), Canada (1), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher **Dovydas Neverauskas** became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen **Eric Wood** was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders **Edwin Espinal** and **Anderson Feliz** both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and reliever **Jhondaniel Medina** and infielder **Jose Osuna** both call Venezuela home. Outfielder **Harold Ramirez** represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher **Jin-De Jhang** is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.

**BASE ON BALLS AND BIG FLIES:** The Curve pitching staff has combined to allow 40 walks so far this season, the most in the Eastern League and an average of eight per game. After not allowing a single homer in the first three games, Akron crushed five home runs on Monday night, tying a franchise record for the most in a single game against the Curve in franchise history. Opposing teams are averaging 7.8 runs per game against Altoona so far this year.
