LAST NIGHT: The Curve broke a scoreless tie with a bases-clearing, two-out triple by **Stetson Allie** in the top of the ninth inning to beat the Flying Squirrels, 3-0. Allie finished the night 2-for-4 with three RBIs. **Frank Duncan** (1-0) worked 3.2 scoreless innings with five strikeouts to earn the win in his Double-A debut. Starter **Cody Dickson** bounced back from a rough start to begin the year with five scoreless innings, allowing two hits with three walks and two strikeouts. **Montana DuRapau** came in to record the final out and strand two runners on base in the bottom of the ninth to earn his second save of the year.

TODAY: The Curve play the finale of the four-game series at The Diamond in Richmond, Virginia, the first road series of 2016, against the Flying Squirrels (Double-A/San Francisco Giants). The Curve split last year's series, 10-10. Altoona finished one game ahead of Richmond for the Western Division's final playoff spot in 2015.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **David Whitehead** makes his second Double-A start for the Curve. Last time out, he allowed five runs in four innings on five hits with three walks and six strikeouts in his Double-A debut on Tuesday against Akron. Last season, Whitehead went 9-11 with a 4.44 ERA while playing with Clearwater in the Florida State League. Originally drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 34th round in 2013, Whitehead was traded to the Pirates in the offseason for right-handed Major League pitcher Charlie Morton. *For more on Whitehead, see page two.*

FOR RICHMOND: Lefty Matt Gage makes his second start of the year for Richmond. In his 2016 debut at Reading on Monday, Gage went two innings and allowed seven earned runs on nine hits. He joined the Flying Squirrels at the end of the 2015 season and made nine appearances (seven starts), compiling a 2-3 record with a 4.66 ERA. Gage was drafted in the 10th round in 2014 by San Francisco out of Siena.

THIS YEAR'S CURVE: The 2016 Curve roster has 12 players that have worn a Curve uniform prior to this season. 13 will be playing at the Double-A level for the first time in their career. There are 12 pitchers and 13 position players on the Curve roster, including one member of the Pirates' 40-man roster (**Harold Ramirez**). The average age of the Curve's roster is 23.68.

A NEW SKIPPER: Former Major League All-Star Joey Cora takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30). B.A. also named Ramirez as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average," Eppler as having the "Best Changeup" and McGuire as the "Best Defensive Catcher."

SPRING TRAINING: Prior to heading north to Altoona, 13 members of the Curve roster played in Major League Spring Training games for the Pirates this year. Eleven position players, including **Jon Schwind**, **Jose Osuna**, **Harold Ramirez**, **Reese McGuire**, **Barrett Barnes**, **Chris Diaz**, **Erich Weiss**, **Eric Wood**, **Stetson Allie**, **Edwin Espinal** and **Anderson Feliz** all got plate appearances in big league games. Relievers **Montana DuRapau** and **Dovydas Neverauskas** were the only two pitchers on the Curve roster that saw action in MLB Spring Training games.

GLOBAL AFFAIR: Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's Opening Day roster, including the United States (17), Canada (1), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher **Dovydas Neverauskas** became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen **Eric Wood** was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders **Edwin Espinal** and **Anderson Feliz** both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and reliever **Jhondaniel Medina** and infielder **Jose Osuna** both call Venezuela home. Outfielder **Harold Ramirez** represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher **Jin-De Jhang** is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.
