YESTERDAY: The Altoona Curve brought in the tying run in the seventh and scored three times in the tenth to beat the Erie SeaWolves, 7-4, snapping a season-worst four-game losing streak. The Curve broke a 4-4 tie in the tenth with an RBI single by **Anderson Feliz** in the top of the tenth inning. **Erich Weiss** followed with an RBI single and **Austin Meadows** hit a sacrifice fly to put the Curve in front, 7-4, all against Erie reliever Paul Voelker (0-1). Erie worked two walks in the bottom of the tenth, but Montana DuRapau (Save, 5) struck out Corey Jones to end the game. Altoona reliever Josh Smith (Win, 1-1) pitched two scoreless relief innings with two strikeouts. With the Curve trailing by a run in the seventh, Eric Wood ripped a two-run single to even the score at 4-4. The Curve opened the scoring with an RBI single by **Edwin Espinal** and a sacrifice fly by **Stetson Allie** in the first inning. After an Erie run in the bottom of inning, Barrett Barnes clubbed his first homer of the season in the second, a solo shot to extend the Curve lead to 3-1. The SeaWolves rallied to take a 4-3 lead in the sixth, but Jhondaniel Medina got Harold Castro to ground into a double play to work out of a bases-loaded, one-out jam. Seven different Curve batters had an RBI in the game.

TONIGHT: The Curve play the second of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, the Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at Jerry Uht Park. Erie won two games in the three-game series at PNG Field in Altoona's only other meetings with them this year. Last year, the Curve won their first eight games against the SeaWolves.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander David Whitehead takes the mound for the Curve in his fifth start of the year. Last time out, Whitehead suffered a loss after walking six over 3.2 innings and giving up three runs. In his previous start two starts, both against Richmond, the Ohio native tossed five innings of scoreless baseball, allowing just one hit. The former Elon pitcher was acquired by the Pirates this past offseason from Philadelphia for Charlie Morton. In each of his last two starts. Whitehead has walked six and hit two batters. For more on Whitehead, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Lucas Harrell makes his third start for the SeaWolves and second straight against the Curve. Last time out, Harrell held the Curve to one run over four innings on two hits, but walked four on April 27 at PNG Field. He made his first appearance for the SeaWolves on April 22 at Binghamton and held the Mets to one run over five innings and picked up a win. Harrell was the fourth-round pick of the Chicago White Sox in 2004 and made his MLB debut in 2010. He spent parts of two seasons in the Majors with Chicago and four seasons with the Houston Astros. He has pitched 88 MLB games in his career, including 62 starts, with a 18-33 record and a 4.84 ERA.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Curve have played back-to-back extra-inning games the last two days after not needing extra frames through any of the first 22 games. Akron defeated Altoona with a walk-off single by Jordan Smith in the 12th inning on Sunday. Yesterday, the Curve rallied for three runs in the top of the tenth to beat the SeaWolves.

TOUCH HOME: After being held to seven total runs in the three games at Akron, the Curve offense scored seven last night at Erie. It was the fourth-highest run total Altoona has gathered this season.

A NEW SKIPPER: Former Major League All-Star Joey Cora takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

AUSTIN CITY LIMITS: Outfielder Austin Meadows joined the Curve Monday after a delayed start to his season due to suffering a orbital fracture in his right eye during spring training after he was hit in the face with a baseball in early March. Meadows enters 2016 as the No. 2 prospect in the Pirates' organization according to MLB.com and Baseball America. He was also named "Best Athlete" among Pittsburgh minor leaguers by B.A. Meadows was also listed as MLB. com's 20th-overall prospect in the minors and the No. 4 outfield prospect. The Atlanta native joined the Curve briefly at the end of the 2015 regular season and hit .360 over six games. He also hit a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth at PNG Field against the Bowie Baysox, completing a seven-run comeback in Game One of the ELDS. He was the ninth overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Pirates (Reese McGuire was selected five picks later), and participated in the Arizona Fall League after last season.

Meadows (2), Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30). B.A. also named Ramirez as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average," Eppler as having the "Best Changeup," McGuire as the "Best Defensive Catcher" and Meadows as the "Best Athlete."

GLOBAL AFFAIR: Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's current roster, including the United States (17), the Dominican Republic (2), Canada (1), Venezuela (1), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher Dovydas Neverauskas became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen Eric Wood was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and first baseman Jose Osuna both call Venezuela home. Outfielder Harold Ramirez represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher Jin-De Jhang is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.
