YESTERDAY: Clay Holmes picked up his second victory of the season as the Curve took the rubber game from the Trenton Thunder to take the series, and clinch a 5-1 homestand. Trenton committed five errors, four of which led to Altoona runs, as the Curve jumped out to a 5-2 lead, thanks to an RBI double by Jonathan Schwind, and an RBI each from Harold Ramirez and Barrett Barnes, both who reached on errors. Eric Wood sent the deciding runs home with a two-run double in the fifth inning. Ramirez paced the Curve offense, going 3-for-5 on the day, while Schiwnd and Wood also had multi-hit games.

TODAY: The Curve open a seven-game, eight-day road trip against the Richmond Flying Squirrels, the Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. Altoona took all three games against the Squirrels this past weekend, sweeping a Saturday doubleheader and winning the final game on Sunday by a 6-2 final score. The Curve have taken eight of the first 11 games the squads have played this year. Last time Altoona went to the Diamond, the Curve and Squirrels split a four-game series.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Tyler Eppler gets the nod in game one for the Curve, and makes his seventh start of the season. Last time out, Eppler tossed the first complete game of the season for the Curve, going all seven innings in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Eppler scattered just four hits and one run over his seven innings of work. In his last road start (5/1 @ Akron), the right-hander earned a no-decision after allowing two runs on five hits and striking out six batters in Akron. Eppler was charged with his second loss of the year after allowing three earned runs on 11 hits in 6.1 innings against Erie on April 25. His best start of the season so far came on April 15, when he held Richmond to one run on two hits over six innings with a season-high six strikeouts. Eppler picked up the team's first win of the season on April 10 against Harrisburg at PNG Field, allowing two runs on three hits in six innings. Eppler joined the Curve briefly near the end of the 2015 season after a strong year with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders. The Texas native is in his third professional season following his All-Conference career at Sam Houston State. For more on Eppler, see page two.

FOR RICHMOND: Southpaw Andrew Suarez makes his Double-A debut tonight for Richmond, after posting a 2-1 record with a 2.43 ERA in five starts with Single-A San Jose. In his last start at Stockton, the former Miami Hurricane hurler went seven innings, allowing just one run on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Suarez was a second round pick in last year's June MLB Draft, and went 2-0 with a 1.60 ERA with the AZL Giants, Salem Keizer (short-A) and San Jose. Suarez is the fourth consecutive left-handed starter the Curve will face.

SUN'S OUT: After Wednesday's win over Trenton, the are a perfect 5-0 in day games played at Peoples Natural Gas Field.

30 IS THE NEW 20: Curve skipper Joey Cora won his 130th career game as a minor league manager on Wednesday following the Curve's 5-4 triumph over the Trenton Thunder.

TRIP-TRIP-TRIPLE: The Curve have knocked 14 triples so far this season, the most of any team in the Eastern League. That number is also the most of any team in Double-A, with the Frisco Roughriders of the Texas League second with 13. Altoona is the only team in the league to hit three triples in a game this season, a feat accomplished on April 22 against Richmond at PNG Field. Harold Ramirez and Erich Weiss are tied with a handful of other players for the league lead with three triples this season.

FREE PASS: The Altoona pitched staff has walked more batters than any team in the Eastern League this year, issuing 143 free passes this season. That is also the most walks of any team in Double-A. David Whitehead leads all of Minor League Baseball with 29 walks issued. Cody Dickson is second in the E.L. with 22, which is also ninth in the minors. Whitehead and Clay Holmes have each hit six batters this season as well, the most in the E.L. and tied for fourth-most in Mil R

WEISS-GUY: Curve second baseman Erich Weiss has gotten off to a hot start in 2016, hitting .293 (fifth-best in the E.L.) over 29 games played. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, Weiss saw a streak of six straight games with an RBI end, but the streak is the longest of any Curve hitter early in the season. The former Texas Longhorn has seven multi-hit games and two multi-RBI games, as well as is tied for the league-lead in triples, along with teammate Harold Ramirez.

WHAT A RELIEF: Relievers Jhondaniel Medina has not allowed a run in his last six outings, a span covering 10.2 innings. Dovydas Neverauskas has not allowed a run over his last six outings, a total of 8.2 innings pitched. Medina

extended his streak last night with a three scoreless innings. Over his streak - dating back to April 25 vs. Erie - Medina has allowed just one hit, has struck out five batters and walked only two. Neverauskas extended his streak in Sunday's, tossing a perfect ninth inning to seal the win for Altoona and pick up his first ever Double-A save. Over this stretch, the Lithuanian righty has seen his ERA drop over three full points, from 7.88 to 4.02, and over his last 10 games (since 4/12 vs. AKR), has seen an ERA of 2.45.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his seventh-inning four-bagger on Sunday, tying Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the home run record, as both went big fly 55 times while wearing an Altoona
