

SUNDAY: Jonathan Schwind scored on a wild pitch to put the Curve ahead, 2-1, during a four-run fifth inning. Chris Diaz added an RBI single in the inning, and in his first professional plate appearance, Edgar Santana snuck a two-run single into left field to put the Curve in front, 5-1. **Edwin Espinal** gave the Curve an early lead in the first with a sacrifice fly, and added an RBI single in the seventh. Santana pitched three hitless, scoreless innings to earn his second win in three Double-A outings this year. Jared Lakind and Montana DuRapau each pitched a scoreless frame to close out the Altoona win. Erich Weiss had a double and a triple and scored two runs.

TODAY: The Curve wrap up their seven-game road trip with the finale of a three-game set from Binghamton as Altoona faces the Binghamton Mets, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets, for the first series this season. The Curve won the first two games of the series by a combined score of 11-2. The Curve enter tonight's game with an eightgame winning streak, tied for the third-longest in franchise history. Over the streak, which includes two wins over Trenton, four victories over Richmond and two defeats of Binghamton, Altoona has outscored the opponents, 42-19.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Tyler Eppler starts for the Curve, making his eighth start of the season. Last time out, Eppler matched a career best with seven inning against Richmond for the second straight start, holding the Flying Squirrels to one run on five hits in a no-decision. Eppler tossed the first complete game of the season for the Curve in his previous outing, going all seven innings in the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday, May 7 in a win over Richmond. Eppler scattered just four hits and one run over his seven innings of work. Eppler picked up the team's first win of the season on April 10 against Harrisburg at PNG Field, allowing two runs on three hits in six innings. Eppler joined the Curve briefly near the end of the 2015 season after a strong year with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders. The Texas native is in his third professional season following his All-Conference career at Sam Houston State. For more on Eppler, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Tyler Pill makes his eight start of the year for the B-Mets. Last time out, Pill picked up his third win in four starts after holding Portland to three earned runs in seven innings at Hadlock Field. In his previous start at Reading, the CSU Fullerton product was charged with a loss after allowing a season-high 10 hits and matching a season-worst with five earned runs against him. He did, however, strike out a season-high 12 hitters.

MARK IT EIGHT, DUDE: The Curve's current eight-game winning streak is tied for the third-longest in franchise $history. \ The \ Curve \ also \ won \ eight \ straight \ games \ during \ their \ 2010 \ E.L \ Championship \ season \ (5/20-5/26 \ vs. \ Arkon, \ Arkon,$ at Erie, at Akron) with a team that included Jordy Mercer, Josh Harrison, Jared Hughes, Alex Presley Matt Hague, Tony Watson, Justin Wilson and lock-down closer Daniel Moskos. The most recent eight-game winning streak came in 2013 (6/13-6/20 at New Britain, vs. Trenton, vs. New Hampshire), with strong performances by Gregory Polanco, Alex Dickerson, Jameson Taillon, Nick Kingham, Casey Sadler, Stolmy Pimentel, Alex Dickerson and David Bromberg.

NINE SOUNDS MIGHTY FINE: The Curve are one win shy of matching the second-best winning streak in franchise history, a nine-game run that covered parts of two seasons. The Curve finished the 2005 regular season with a four-game road sweep of the Bowie Baysox before heading to the postseason with Tom Gorzelanny and Josh Bonifay. That stretch included a 4-1, 15-inning win at Prince George's Stadium on September 4, 2005. The Curve then opened the 2006 season on a five-game winning streak, the only 5-0 start in the club's history, from April 6-10 at Blair County Ballpark against Trenton and Erie.

GOING STREAKING: The Curve are two wins shy of tying the franchise record for the longest winning streak in franchise history at ten, which was set from July 24-August 2, 2005, as they earned wins at home against Harrisburg and Binghamton before continuing the streak at Trenton and Erie. Under manager Tony Beasley, that team featured notable Curve names like Jose Bautista, Rajai Davis, Josh Bonifay and Tom Gorzelanny.

WHAT A RELIEF: Reliever Jhondaniel Medina has not allowed a run in his last eight outings, a span covering 13.1 innings. **Dovydas Neverauskas** has not allowed a run over his last eight outings, a total of 11.2 innings pitched. Over Medina's streak - dating back to April 25 vs. Erie - Medina has allowed just one hit, has struck out six batters and walked only three. Neverauskas tossed a scoreless inning to extend his streak in Tuesday night's Curve win at Bing-

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his seventh-inning four-bagger on May 8 against Richmond, tying Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Austin Meadows (2), Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).

GLOBAL AFFAIR: Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's current roster, including the United States (16), the Dominican Republic (3), Canada (1), Venezuela (1), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher Dovydas Neverauskas became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen Eric Wood was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 $\label{eq:mlb} \mbox{MLB Draft. Infielders \mathbf{Edwin} $\mathbf{Espinal}$ and $\mathbf{Anderson}$ \mathbf{Feliz} both are natives of }$ the Dominican Republic, and first baseman Jose Osuna both call Venezuela home. Outfielder Harold Ramirez represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher Jin-De Jhang is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.
