**YESTERDAY:** The Curve drew five walks in the bottom of the eighth inning to score six runs and defeated the Portland Sea Dogs. **Montana DuRapau** worked around a leadoff double in the top of the ninth to seal the win and the shutout for Altoona. **Barrett Barnes** doubled home the first runs of the game in the bottom of the second inning to give Altoona a 2-0 lead. **David Whitehead** threw five scoreless innings, allowing two hits and walked three.

**TODAY:** The Curve play the second of a three-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, the Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. Even though Portland finished with the worst record in the Eastern League last season, they went 4-2 against Altoona. The Curve have won 12 of their last 14 games.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Lefty **Brandon Waddell** makes his fourth Double-A start for the Curve. Last time out, Waddell earned his third straight Double-A win (seventh consecutive overall this season) after allowing two earned runs in 5.2 innings at Richmond. In his previous start, Waddell allowed one run on three hits over seven innings in a win against Trenton in his first home start at PNG Field. In his Double-A debut at Erie, Waddell allowed two runs in 6.1 innings with no walks and three strikeouts to pick up his fifth consecutive win. In five starts with the Marauders, Waddell went 4-0 with a 0.93 ERA. He earned Florida State League Pitcher of the Week honors last Monday for his six scoreless, two-hit innings against Jupiter over the previous weekend with no walks and a career-high seven strikeouts. He won each of his last four starts prior to his promotion. Waddell was a three-year member of the starting rotation at the University of Virginia prior to being drafted by the Pirates in the fifth round last summer. He pitched seven innings and got the win in the decisive Game Three of the 2015 College World Series Championship against Vanderbilt last summer, giving Virginia its first-ever national championship in baseball and the first ACC CWS title since Wake Forest won in 1955, a 59-year drought.

**FOR PORTLAND:** Right-hander Aaron Wilkerson makes his eighth start of the year for the Sea Dogs. Last time out, he worked a career-high 7.1 innings and held New Hampshire scoreless with eight strikeouts. He opened the season with an 11-strikeout performance against Reading and picked up a win. He made one Triple-A start this season for Pawtucket on April 22 and gave up three earned runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Wilkerson pitched for Cumberland University in Tennessee. After not being selected in the draft in 2011, Wilkerson was signed out of independent baseball in 2014 by the Boston Red Sox.

**EIGHT'S PRETTY GREAT:** Thursday night's loss snapped an eight-game winning streak for the Curve, tied for the third-longest winning streak in franchise history. Altoona last won eight consecutive games in 2013 (June 13-20 at New Britain, vs. Trenton, vs. New Hampshire). They also won eight games in a row during their 2010 E.L. Championship season (May 20-26 vs. Akron, at Erie, at Akron). The Curve have won 12 of their last 14 games overall.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Reliever **Dovydas Neverauskas** has not allowed a run over his last nine outings, a total of 13.2 innings pitched. Neverauskas tossed a scoreless inning to extend his streak in Tuesday night's Curve win at Binghamton. Reliever **Jhondaniel Medina** allowed a run on Thursday at Binghamton for the first time in over eight games, his first run allowed in a span of 14.0 innings, the longest scoreless streak for any Curve pitcher this year.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 41st career home run on May 8 against Richmond, tying Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Austin Meadows** (2), **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30).

**A NEW SKIPPER:** Former Major League All-Star **Joey Cora** takes over as the ninth manager in franchise history. He was officially announced as the new skipper for the Curve on December 15, 2015. The native of Caguas, Puerto Rico spent 11 seasons in the majors with San Diego Padres, Chicago White Sox, Seattle Mariners and Cleveland Indians. He was an A.L. All-Star in 1997 with Seattle. Following his playing career, Cora spent eight seasons on the staff of manager Ozzie Guillen with the White Sox from 2004-2011 and one season as the bench coach with the Miami Marlins in 2012. Cora last managed in the minor in 2003 with Savannah of the South Atlantic League, then a Montreal Expos affiliate. He also guided the Appalachian League's Kingsport Mets in 2001 and 2002. Across three seasons, he is 112-160 as a minor league manager. Cora replaces Tom Prince, who guided the Curve for one season and is now the Pirates' Minor League Field Coordinator.

**GLOBAL AFFAIR:** Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's current roster, including the United States (16), the Dominican Republic (3), Canada (1), Venezuela (1), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher **Dovydas Neverauskas** became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen **Eric Wood** was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders **Edwin Espinal** and **Anderson Feliz** both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and first baseman **Jose Osuna** both call Venezuela home. Outfielder **Harold Ramirez** represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher **Jin-De Jhang** is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Former Curve infielder **Alen Hanson** made his Major League debut on Monday night at PNC Park in the Pirates' 8-5 victory over the Atlanta Braves with a pinch-hit appearance in the bottom of the sixth inning. Hanson became the 124th Curve alum to make the Majors, and is the first alum to see his debut in 2016. He picked up his first MLB hit in Tuesday night's Pittsburgh win over Atlanta.
