**YESTERDAY:** The Curve were routed in the third game of the four-game set against the division-leading RubberDucks, 13-4. Harold Ramirez had three hits and clubbed his first Double-A homer. Erich Weiss also had three hits and drove in two runs. Tyler Eppler allowed a career-worst nine runs over just three innings.

**TODAY:** The Curve wrap up their clash with the division-leading Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The Curve were swept by Akron at Canal Park in the last series between the two teams, and lost four of the first five games against the Ducks overall. Entering play, the Curve have won 13 of their last 17 games overall. The RubberDucks are 19-5 in May and have the best record out of all MLB and MiLB teams.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **David Whitehead** takes the mound for his eighth start of the season. Last time out, he posted his third five-inning scoreless performance of the year and picked up a win over Portland on Friday. Whitehead has walked 36 batters this year, the third-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Four starts ago on May 3 at Erie, Whitehead allowed a franchise-record-tying 14 hits and a career-worst 10 runs (six earned) as the Curve were handed their worst shutout loss in franchise history, 14-0. The former Elon pitcher was acquired by the Pirates this past offseason from Philadelphia for Charlie Morton. **For more on Whitehead, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Lefty Shawn Morimando makes his tenth start of the season for Akron. The Virginia Beach product leads all of Minor League Baseball with eight wins, and has held opposing hitters to a .195 average. He has now allowed more than two earned runs in a start this year. Last time out, he allowed two earned runs over five innings against Binghamton. Morimando has earned a win in all but one of his starts this season, a four-inning no-decision against Altoona on April 29 at Canal Park in Akron. He was the Indians' 19th-round pick in the 2011 MLB Draft out of Ocean Lakes High School in Virginia Beach.

**#WINNING:** The Curve have won 13 of their last 17 games, dating back to May 5, when they were 11-16 and fourth in the E.L. West. The stretch began with a three-game sweep of Richmond, but was interrupted by a loss to Trenton on May 9. The Curve responded with an eight-game winning streak, including a four-game road sweep of Richmond. Altoona has moved from fourth to second in the division, but has actually lost a game in the standings on the division-leading RubberDucks.

**A HAROLD-ED PROSPECT:** Curve outfielder **Harold Ramirez** was held hitless on Tuesday to end his 11-game hitting streak, the longest for any Curve player this year. Over the stretch, Ramirez hit .426 (20-for-47) with seven multi-hit games, raising his average from .242 on May 8 to .298 (now .290). During the streak, Ramirez hit six doubles, scored 11 runs, drove in seven runs, walked seven times and struck out seven times. He recorded three hits on Wednesday against Akron, including his first Double-A homer. His .387 batting average in the month of May is the second-best in Double-A, behind only Richmond's Austin Slater (.415).

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Reliever **Dovydas Neverauskas** has not allowed a run over his last ten outings, a total of 14.2 innings pitched. Neverauskas tossed a scoreless inning with two strikeouts on Tuesday night against Akron. His scoreless streak is the longest of any Curve pitcher this year, surpassing the mark originally set by **Jhondaniel Medina** at 14.0 innings.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 41st career homer on May 8 against Richmond, tying Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** The Altoona this roster has an average age of 23.6, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. Hartford (24.0), Trenton (24.3) and Akron (24.5) are the next closest. Erie (26.1) has fielded the oldest roster. The three youngest players on the Curve roster are all 21 and are also the three biggest prospects: **Austin Meadows**, **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**. Only one player on the current roster, Jhondaniel Medina, has any experience above the Double-A level (Medina pitched two games in Triple-A this season). No one else has played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Austin Meadows** (2), **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30).

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Former Curve infielder **Alen Hanson** made his Major League debut on last week at PNC Park in the Pirates' 8-5 victory over the Atlanta Braves with a pinch-hit appearance in the bottom of the sixth inning. Hanson became the 124th Curve alum to make the Majors, and is the first alum to see his debut in 2016. He picked up his first MLB hit the next night.

**GLOBAL AFFAIR:** Seven different countries are represented on Altoona's current roster, including the United States (16), the Dominican Republic (3), Canada (1), Venezuela (1), Colombia (1), Taiwan (1) and Lithuania (1). Relief pitcher **Dovydas Neverauskas** became the first player born and raised in Lithuania to sign with a Major League team when he signed as an international free agent with the Pirates. Canadian third basemen **Eric Wood** was the first Canuck to be drafted when he went in the 6th round of the 2012 MLB Draft. Infielders **Edwin Espinal** and **Anderson Feliz** both are natives of the Dominican Republic, and first basemen **Jose Osuna** both call Venezuela home. Outfielder **Harold Ramirez** represented his home country of Colombia this offseason in the World Baseball Classic qualifying round in Panama. Catcher **Jin-De Jhang** is a native of Taitung City, Taiwan.
