YESTERDAY: After falling behind early, the Curve stormed back for a 9-4 win over the Baysox in the series finale. Austin Meadows had three hits, including his first Double-A homer, drove in three runs, scored twice, worked a walk, stole two bases and robbed a potential three-run homer from Quincy Latimore in fourth with the Curve down 4-1. In the next half inning, his homer started the rally, and Eric Wood hit a sacrifice fly to bring the Curve within a run. In the sixth, Anderson Feliz tied the game with an RBI double, Meadows followed with a go-ahead RBI single, Jin-De Jhang added a two-run double and another sac fly by Wood pushed the lead to 8-4. Jonathan Schwind added a home run in the ninth inning. Jared Lakind and Dovydas Neverauskas each pitched two scoreless innings to finish the day.

TONIGHT: The Curve play the fifth of a seven-game road trip with the first of three games against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The two Western Division leaders clash for the third series this season. Akron took 2-of-3 at PNG Field in early April before sweeping the Curve in three games at Canal Park later in the month. The two teams split a four-game set in Altoona last week. The Curve have won 17-of-the-last-22 games entering play. Akron is 19-4 at home this year, including a 17-game home winning streak that was snapped by Harrisburg on Sunday.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander David Whitehead returns to his home state to make his tenth start of the year for the Curve. Last time out, Whitehead allowed one unearned run in 5.1 innings, his longest outing of the year, in a no-decision against Akron. He has not allowed an earned run in his last two starts, including working five scoreless innings and allowing two hits in a win over Portland on May 20. Whitehead has walked 41 batters this year, the most in the Eastern League and tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball. The former Elon pitcher was acquired by the Pirates this past offseason from the Philadelphia Phillies for Charlie Morton. For more on Whitehead, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Shawn Morimando makes his 10th start of the year for the RubberDucks and second-straight start against the Curve. Last time out, the Virginia Beach product tossed seven scoreless innings and held the Curve to three hits on Thursday at PNG Field before a ninth-inning rally lifted the Curve to a 3-2, walk-off win. Morimando has won eight of his ten starts, with his only two no-decisions coming against the Curve. His eight wins this season leads all MiLB pitchers. Only MLB pitchers Jake Arrieta (CHC), Chris Sale (CWS) and Stephen Strasburg (WSH) have more wins this year than Morimando. He faced the Curve at Canal Park on April 29, and allowed two runs in just 4.0 innings on 81 pitches before being removed.

#WINNING: The Curve have won 17 of their last 22 games, dating back to May 5, when they were 11-16 and fourth in the E.L. West. The stretch began with a three-game sweep of Richmond, but was interrupted by a loss to Trenton on May 9. The Curve responded with an eight-game winning streak, including a four-game road sweep of Richmond. Altoona has moved from fourth to second in the division, but has only gained one game in the standings on the division-leading RubberDucks.

A WEISS GUY, EH: Second baseman Erich Weiss is currently on a 12-game hitting streak, the best for any Curve player this season. It's also the longest active streak by an active Eastern League player and tied for the fifth-best in the league this season. The former Texas Longhorn is hitting .362 (17/47) during the streak with four doubles, two triples and 10 RBIs. His .299 batting average is the fifth-best in the E.L. and leads the Curve.

AUSTIN CITY LIMITS: After hitting just .192 through his first 21 games, outfielder Austin Meadows has compiled an eight-game hitting streak to raise his average to .277. The Pirates' second-ranked prospect has five multi-hit games during the streak, including each of the last four games. He's batting .440 (14/28) during the streak with four doubles, a triple, a home run, five stolen bases, four walks, eight runs scored and just two strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 42nd career homer on Friday night at Bowie, moving ahead of Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. He added the 43rd home run of his career on Saturday night.

WHAT A RELIEF: Reliever Dovydas Neverauskas has not allowed a run over his last 12 outings, a total of 17.0 innings pitched. Neverauskas tossed a scoreless inning with two strikeouts on Monday at Bowie. His scoreless streak is the longest of any Curve pitcher this year, surpassing the mark originally set by Jhondaniel Medina at 14.0 innings. Opponents are hitting .139 against Neverauskas this year, third-best in amongst relievers in the E.L., and .119 against Medina, second-best in the league. Jared Lakind tossed two scoreless innings on Monday at Bowie and has not allowed a run in his last 15.2 innings while posting 11 consecutive scoreless appearances.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.6, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. Hartford (24.0) and Akron (24.6) are the next closest. Erie and New Hampshire (26.0) have fielded the oldest rosters. The three youngest players on the Curve roster are all 21 and are also the three highest-ranked prospects: Austin Meadows, Reese McGuire and Harold Ramirez. Aside from reliever Jhondaniel Medina (three games at Triple-A this year), no players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Austin Meadows (2), Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).
