YESTERDAY: The Curve won the series opener against the Binghamton Mets, 7-4. Austin Meadows tripled in a run in the first inning, and Jose Osuna brought him across the plate with a ground out. After the B-Mets took a 3-2 lead in the second, the Curve responded in the third with another RBI triple by Meadows and Osuna brought him in to score with a sac fly to take a 4-3 lead. Barrett Barnes tripled in a run in the fourth, but Binghamton closed back within a run in the seventh. Erich Weiss hit an RBI single in the seventh and Stetson Allie hit a sacrifice fly in the eighth to extend the lead to 7-4. Montana DuRapau picked up a six-out save with four strikeouts, including striking out the side in order in the ninth. Brandon Waddell allowed three runs in five innings and picked up his fourth win of the year.

TONIGHT: The Curve play the second of a three-game series against the Binghamton Mets, Double-A affilliate of the New York Mets. This weekend marks the second of five series between the two clubs. The Curve won two of the three games at NYSEG Stadium last month. Entering play tonight, Altoona has won 20-of-26 games. The Curve are in a stretch of playing 14-of-17 games on the road, with this weekend's series being the only time at PNG Field.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Tyler Eppler starts makes his eleventh start this season for the Curve. Last time out, he picked up a win at Bowie on Monday, allowing four runs on nine hits in five innings. Tonight marks his second start against Binghamton this year. He did not pick up a decision in his previous encounter with the B-Mets on May 19, allowing two earned runs in six innings. After posting a 2.74 ERA in his first eight starts, Eppler is 1-1 with a 14.63 ERA in his last two outings. He's posted seven quality starts over his first eight outings, but has received the second-lowest run support of any Curve starter this year, with the offense averaging 3.9 runs per game in his starts. The Curve are 4-6 with Eppler on the mound this year. Eppler is second on the team in innings pitched (57.1) and leads the club with 38 strikeouts. His 1.33 WHIP is the best amongst the current starting rotation, aside from Frank Duncan (one start at Double-A). The Texas native is in his third professional season following his All-Conference career at Sam Houston State, and briefly appeared with the Curve at the end of last season. FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Rainy Lara makes his tenth start for Binghamton this season and his first against the Curve. Last time out, the Bani, Dominican Republic native picked up his second consecutive loss after allowing two earned runs in five inning against Trenton and matching a season high with four strikeouts. In five May starts, Lara went 0-4 with a 7.68 ERA. 2016 is his third season with Binghamton. He made 20 starts at Double-A in 2014 (6-4, 4.31) and 19 last year (9-5, 3.44), while also pitching five times with Triple-A Las Vegas (0-0, 7.13). In 2015, Lara went 2-0 with a 2.40 ERA in his two starts against Altoona, his only career outings against the Curve.

#WINNING: The Curve have won 20 of their last 26 games, dating back to May 5, when they were 11-16 and fourth in the E.L. West. The stretch includes an eight-game winning streak from May 10-18, tied for the third-longest in team history. Altoona has won seven of the last eight series, with the lone exception being a four-game series split with Akron at PNG Field. Altoona has moved from fourth to second in the Western Division in that stretch, but has only gained two games in the standings on the division-leading RubberDucks.

AUSTIN CITY LIMITS: After hitting just .192 through his first 21 games, outfielder Austin Meadows has compiled a twelve-game hitting streak since May 23 to raise his average to .297. The Pirates' second-ranked prospect has eight mutli-hit games during the streak, including five straight from 5/27-5/31. He's batting .467 (21/45) during the streak with five triples, four doubles, a home run, nine RBIs, five stolen bases, five walks, 13 runs scored and just five strikeouts. His .467 average is the second-highest in Double-A and the fifth-best in MiLB since May 23. The 12-game streak is the longest active streak by an active Eastern League player, tied with Erich Weiss for the longest by a Curve player this season and tied for fifth-best in the E.L. this season. He's also currently on a 17-game on-base streak since May 15, the longest for a Curve player this year.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 42nd career homer on Friday night at Bowie, moving ahead of Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. He added the 43rd home run of his career on Saturday night.

WHAT A RELIEF: Reliever Dovydas Neverauskas had his scoreless streak snapped at 18.1 innings after allowing a run on Thursday night at Akron. It is the longest streak posted by any Curve pitcher so far this season. Opponents are hitting .143 against Neverauskas this year, fourth-best in amongst relievers in the E.L., and .127 against Jhondaniel Medina, second-best in the league. Jared Lakind tossed 1.2 scoreless innings on Thursday at Akron and has not allowed a run in his last 17.1 innings while posting 12 consecutive scoreless appearances.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.6, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. Hartford (24.0) and Akron (24.6) are the next closest. Erie and New Hampshire (26.0) have fielded the oldest rosters. The three youngest players on the Curve roster are all 21 and are also the three highest-ranked prospects: **Austin Meadows, Reese** McGuire and Harold Ramirez. Aside from reliever Jhondaniel Medina (three games at Triple-A this year), no players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Austin Meadows (2), Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).
