YESTERDAY: The Curve snapped their three-game losing streak with a 5-1 win over the Erie SeaWolves. Cody Dickson worked seven innings and allowed one run in the first inning. Reese McGuire brought in the first run in the first inning with a groundout and **Edwin Espinal** drove in a run with an RBI single, the first of this three hits in the game. Eric Wood hit his second double of the game in the ninth to bring a run across. The Curve scored another run in the inning on an error and Erich Weiss singled to extend the lead to 5-1. Dovydas Neverauskas and Montana DuRapau each worked perfect innings to close out the Altoona win.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue a seven-game road trip with the third of a four-game series against the Erie Sea-Wolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at Jerry Uht Park. The Curve are coming off of dropping two-of-three games at home against the Binghamton Mets. The SeaWolves lost three-of-four in their last series at Trenton and have dropped six-of-eight overall, dating back to May 31. The Curve dropped two in a three-game set at PNG Field against the SeaWolves from April 25-27 and spit a four-game series at Jerry Uht Park from May 2-5.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Brandon Waddell makes his seventh start for the Curve and second against the SeaWolves. Last time out, the Houston native picked up a win at PNG Field over Binghamton after allowing three runs in five innings. He made his Double-A debut against the SeaWolves at Jerry Uht Park on May 4 after allowing two earned runs in 6.1 innings. He began the season with A-Adv. Bradenton and went 4-0 in five starts with a 0.93 ERA, picking up a win in each of his last four outing prior to his promotion to Double-A on May 3. Waddell won the Florida State League Player of the Month Award for April and won his first three starts with Altoona, stretching his streak to seven straight starts won overall. He was drafted in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Virginia after leading the Cavaliers to the 2015 College World Series title, pitching seven innings in the championship clincher against Vanderbilt.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Tommy Collier makes his twelfth start of the year for the SeaWolves and third against the Curve. Last time out, he was charged with a loss after allowing four earned runs in 6.1 innings at Trenton on Friday. He picked up a win against the Curve on April 25 at PNG Field with seven scoreless, three-hit innings with a seasonhigh six strikeouts. He did not pick up decision in his next outing, also against Altoona, after allowing three earned runs in six innings at Jerry Uht Park. He faced the Curve three times in 2015, going 3-0, and went seven or more innings in each of his starts, never allowing more than two earned runs. Against Altoona in his career, Collier is 5-0 with a 2.31 ERA in his last six starts against Altoona, dating back to 2014.

UP & DOWN: The Curve went 20-6 from May 5-June 2 and moved from fourth to second in the E.L. West, including an eight-game winning streak from May 10-18, tied for the third-longest in team history. The Curve have won seven of their last nine series, with the lone exceptions being a four-game series split with Akron at PNG Field and losing two-of-three to Binghamton in last weekend's set.

AUSTIN CITY LIMITS: After hitting just .192 through his first 21 games, outfielder Austin Meadows has compiled a 16-game hitting streak since May 23 to raise his average to .289. The Pirates' second-ranked prospect has eight multi-hit games during the streak, including five straight from 5/27-5/31. He's batting .403 (25/62) during the streak with six triples, five doubles, his first two Double-A home runs, ten RBIs, five stolen bases, five walks, 14 runs scored and just eight strikeouts. The 16-game streak is the longest active streak by an active Eastern League player, the longest by a Curve player this season and the third-best in the E.L. this season. It's also the second-longest active streak in baseball, MLB and MiLB, behind Cleveland prospect Tyler Krieger, who has an 18-game streak for Single-A Lake County. Meadows is also currently on a 21-game on-base streak since May 15, the longest for a Curve player this year. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for the week of May 30-June 5.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie, moving ahead of Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. He added the 43rd home run of his career on May 28.

WHAT A RELIEF: Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind pitched 2.0 scoreless innings on Monday night at Erie, extending his scoreless streak to 19.1 innings, the longest posted by any Curve pitcher this season. He has not surrendered a run in his last 13 appearances. Since April 25, Dovydas Neverauskas is 1-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER, 20.0 IP) and has allowed just three hits. Oppoenents are hitting .133 against him for the season, second-best amongst E.L. relief pitchers. Jhondaniel Medina has opposing hitters to a .141 batting average, the third-best in the league.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.6, the youngest of any team in the Eastern

League. Hartford (24.0) and Akron (24.6) are the next closest. Erie and New Hampshire (26.0) have fielded the oldest rosters. The three youngest players on the Curve roster are all 21 and are also the three highest-ranked prospects: Austin Meadows, Reese McGuire and Harold Ramirez, Aside from pitchers Jhondaniel Medina (three games at Triple-A this year) and Frank Duncan (four starts at Triple-A), no players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Austin Meadows (2), Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).
