YESTERDAY: The Curve lost to the SeaWolves, 7-1. Austin Meadows homered in the first inning and gave the Curve the lead while extending his hitting streak to 17 games, but that was the only run of the night for Altoona. Meadows finished with three hits, including a double. Edwin Espinal and Anderson Feliz each had three hits. Erie totaled 16 hits, including four hits by Connor Harrell. Wynton Bernard homered for the SeaWolves.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue a seven-game road trip with the finale of a four-game series against the Erie Sea-Wolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at Jerry Uht Park. The Curve are coming off of dropping two-of-three games at home against the Binghamton Mets. The SeaWolves lost three-of-four in their last series at Trenton and have dropped six-of-eight overall, dating back to May 31. The Curve dropped two in a three-game set at PNG Field against the SeaWolves from April 25-27 and spit a four-game series at Jerry Uht Park from May 2-5.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Tyler Eppler starts makes his twelfth start of the year for the Curve. Last time out, Eppler was charged with a loss after allowing two earned runs in seven innings and holding the B-Mets to four hits on Saturday. Tonight marks Eppler's second start against the SeaWolves. On April 25, he was charged with a loss at PNG Field against Erie after allowing three runs in 6.1 innings, but surrendered a season-high 11 hits. He posted seven quality starts over his first eight outings and eight total quality starts, but has received the second-lowest run support of any Curve starter this year, with the offense averaging 3.9 runs per game in his starts. Eppler leads the team with 64.1 innings pitched and 43 strikeouts with best WHIP (1.33) in the current starting rotation. The Texas native is in his third professional season following his All-Conference career at Sam Houston State, and briefly appeared with the Curve at the end of last season. FOR ERIE: Lefty Anthony Fernandez makes his fifth start for the SeaWolves and first against the Curve this year. Last time out, the 26 year old was charge with a loss after allowing three earned runs in six innings on Saturday. He had a season-high six strikeouts on May 30 in a loss at Richmond two starts ago, where he allowed one earned run on three hits in six innings. He began the season on the disabled list and was activated on May 19. He began his career with the Seattle Mariners organization, climbing as high as Triple-A, and signed with the Tigers as a free agent in Novem-

UP & DOWN: The Curve went 20-6 from May 5-June 2 and moved from fourth to second in the E.L. West, including an eight-game winning streak from May 10-18, tied for the third-longest in team history. The Curve have won seven of their last nine series, with the lone exceptions being a four-game series split with Akron at PNG Field and losing two-of-three to Binghamton in last weekend's set.

AUSTIN CITY LIMITS: After hitting just .192 through his first 21 games, outfielder Austin Meadows has compiled a 17-game hitting streak since May 23 to raise his average to .302. The Pirates' second-ranked prospect has nine multi-hit games during the streak, including five straight from 5/27-5/31. He's batting .424 (28/66) during the streak with six triples, six doubles, his first three Double-A home runs, eleven RBIs, five stolen bases, five walks, 16 runs scored and just eight strikeouts. The 17-game streak is the longest active streak by an active Eastern League player, the longest by a Curve player this season and the third-best in the E.L. this season. It's also the second-longest active streak in baseball, MLB and MiLB, behind Cleveland prospect Tyler Krieger, who has an 18-game streak for Single-A Lake County. Meadows is also currently on a 22-game on-base streak since May 15, the longest for a Curve player this year. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for the week of May 30-June 5.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie, moving ahead of Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. He added the 43rd home run of his career on May 28.

WHAT A RELIEF: Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind pitched 2.0 scoreless innings on Monday night at Erie, extending his scoreless streak to 19.1 innings, the longest posted by any Curve pitcher this season. He has not surrendered a run in his last 13 appearances. Since April 25, Dovydas Neverauskas is 1-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER, 20.0 IP) and has allowed just three hits. Oppoenents are hitting .133 against him for the season, second-best amongst E.L. relief pitchers. Jhondaniel Medina has opposing hitters to a .141 batting average, the third-best in the league.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.6, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. Hartford (24.0) and Akron (24.6) are the next closest. Erie and New Hampshire (26.0) have fielded the oldest rosters. The three youngest players on the Curve roster are all 21 and are also the three highest-ranked prospects:

Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Meadows (2), Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).
