YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped the series opener to the Fightin Phils, 9-2. Reading hit four homers against starter Alex McRae, who was making his Double-A debut. Dylan Cozens and Rhys Hoskins hit back-to-back blasts in the third inning, Jorge Alfaro and Aaron Brown each hit two-run homers in a five-run fourth inning. Harold Ramirez had three hits and two RBIs, including getting the Curve on the board with an RBI double in the fifth. Austin Meadows extended his hitting streak to 19 games with a double in the first inning. Jhondaniel Medina surrendered two unearned runs in the sixth. Jared Lakind pitched two scoreless innings, extending his scoreless streak to 21.1 innings.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue a seven-game road trip with the second of a three-game series against the Reading Fightin, Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Curve are coming off splitting a four-game set with the Erie SeaWolves at Jerry Uht Park. Reading swept Akron in three games at Canal Park to take over the top record in all of the Eastern League and all of Minor League Baseball. The Fightins have won five straight games overall entering play tonight.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Clay Holmes makes his twelfth start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he won his fourth straight decision (in five starts) while allowing three earned runs in six innings at Akron on June 2. Holmes has not pitched in nine days, but is second on the team with 57.2 innings pitched this year. He also has the third-most strikeouts on the team and second-most in the starting rotation with 34. The Pirates' 15th-ranked prospect entering this season, Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. *For more on Holmes, see page two.*

FOR READING: Right-hander Mark Leiter Jr. makes his fifth start of the season and eighth appearance overall for the Fightins. Last time out he matched a season-high with five innings pitched in a win over New Hampshire on Monday, allowed one earned runs on three hits. In four starts, Leiter is 2-0 with a 3.18 ERA. In three home outings, the NJIT product has a 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, two starts, one relief outing). Leiter was drafted in the 22nd round in 2013 by the Phillies out of the New Jersey Institute of Technology. He made eight starts for Reading last year and went 2-6 with a 4.79 ERA. Tonight marks his first outing against Altoona in his career.

UP & DOWN: The Curve went 20-6 from May 5-June 2 and moved from fourth to second in the E.L. West, including an eight-game winning streak from May 10-18, tied for the third-longest in team history. The Curve have won seven of their last ten series, with the lone exceptions being a four-game series split with Akron at PNG Field, dropping two-of-three to Binghamton in last weekend's set and a four-game split in Erie this week.

AUSTIN CITY LIMITS: After hitting just .192 through his first 21 games, outfielder Austin Meadows has compiled a 19-game hitting streak since May 23 to raise his average to .308, third in the league. The Pirates' second-ranked prospect has ten multi-hit games during the streak, including five straight from 5/27-5/31. He's batting .463 (31/73) during the streak with six triples, eight doubles, his first four Double-A home runs, 13 RBIs, five stolen bases, six walks, 19 runs scored and just eight strikeouts. The 19-game streak ties the longest streak by an Eastern League hitter this season (Reading's Rhys Hoskins had a 19-game streak from 4/10-5/2), and it is tied for the second-longest in Curve franchise history (Willy Garica in 2015 and Alex Presley in 2010). Meadows is only two games shy of the all-time franchise record streak of 21 games set by Kevin Sefcik in 2002. It's also the second-longest active streak in baseball, MLB and MiLB, behind Cleveland prospect Tyler Krieger, who has a 20-game streak for Single-A Lake County. Meadows is also currently on a 24-game on-base streak since May 15, the longest for a Curve player this year. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for the week of May 30-June 5.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie moved up on the Curve's all-time home run leaders list with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie, moving ahead of Ray Sadler for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise home run record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. He added the 43rd home run of his career on May 28.

WHAT A RELIEF: Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind pitched 2.0 scoreless innings on Friday night at Reading, extending his scoreless streak to 21.1 innings, the longest posted by any Curve pitcher this season. He has not surrendered a run in his last 14 appearances. Since April 25, Dovydas Neverauskas is 1-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER, 20.0 IP) and has allowed just three hits. Opponents are hitting .133 against him for the season, second-best amongst E.L. relief pitchers. Jhondaniel Medina has opposing hitters to a .149 batting average, the fifth-best in the league.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.6, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. Hartford (24.0) and Akron (24.6) are the next closest. Erie and New Hampshire (26.0) have fielded the oldest rosters. The three youngest players on the Curve roster are all 21 and are also the three highest-ranked prospects: Austin Meadows, Reese McGuire and Harold Ramirez. Aside from pitchers Jhondaniel Medina (three games at Triple-A this year) and Frank Duncan (four starts at Triple-A), no players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Three Curve alumni have debuted in the Majors this year, raising the franchise's total to 126 MLB players. On May 16, **Alen Hanson** (2013-14) debuted with the Pirates. **Jameson Taillon** (2012-13) pitched for the Pirates on June 8, while **A.J. Morris** (2014) debuted with the Cincinnati Reds on May 24.
