YESTERDAY: The Curve took the first game of the series from the Binghamton Mets, 5-2. The Curve took 1-0 lead in the third on an RBI single by Erich Weiss. After Kyle Johnson hit a sac fly to tie the game in the bottom of the inning, the Curve answered with a run-scoring single by **Edwin Espinal** in the fourth. Espinal added an RBI single in the sixth and Harold Ramirez hit a two-run home in the seventh to push the Altoona lead to 5-2. Reese McGuire finished a home run shy of the cycle, going 3-for-3 with a double, a triple and a walk. Alex McRae picked up his first Double-A win after allowing two earned runs in 5.2 innings. Edgar Santana pitched 2.1 scoreless innings and Montana DuRapau struck out the side in order in the ninth to close out his 12th save.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue a six-game road trip tonight in Binghamton, N.Y. against the Binghamton Mets, with the second of the three-game series. The Curve took two of three games earlier this season at NYSEG Stadium, while the B-Mets won two of three games at Peoples Natural Gas Field on June 3-5. The three-game series marks the fourth consecutive series the Curve are playing against an Eastern Division opponent. The Curve have won three straight and four-of-five overall, while the B-Mets have dropped seven of their last eight games.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Clay Holmes makes his 14th start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he pitched six scoreless, two-hit innings in a no-decision against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Thursday night. He has picked up a win in each of his last four decisions, spanning seven starts since May 11. Holmes has pitched the second-most innings (68.0) on the team, sit second in strikeouts (46) and has the second-best WHIP (1.51) in the current starting rotation, all behind Tyler Eppler. The Pirates' 15th-ranked prospect entering this season, Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. For more on Holmes, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Rainy Lara makes his 13th start of the year for Binghamton and second against Altoona. Last time he faced the Curve, he picked up a win while working seven scoreless, three-hit innings with six strikeouts at PNG Field on June 4. In his last start on Thursday, Lara picked up his fourth win of the season with seven scoreless, two-hit innings at Richmond. In his last three starts overall, Lara is 2-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20 IP).

HELLO, NEWMAN: Shortstop Kevin Newman, the player selected by the Pirates in last year's MLB Draft (19th overall), was promoted to Double-A to join the Curve on Saturday. Newman was batting .366 through 41 games with A-Adv. Bradenton. The former Arizona Wildcat is ranked by Baseball America as the eighth-best prospect in the Pittsburgh system. As an amateur, Newman won back-to-back batting titles in the prestigious Cape Cod League and had a decorated career at the University of Arizona. While hitting at the top of the order in his first three games, Newman is batting .286 with three runs scored.

TAKE YOUR BASE: Curve pitchers have walked the second-most batters of any Double-A team with 290 free passes issued, trailing only Montgomery of the Southern League. It's the fifth-highest walk total of any team in Minor League Baseball. The pitching staff is averaging 4.2 walks per game. Starting pitchers David Whitehead and Cody Dickson have both issued 47 walks this season, tied for the most in the Eastern League.

WHAT A RELIEF: Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind threw the final out on Sunday against Hartford, extending his current scoreless streak to 25.0 innings, a new franchise single-season record (The longest scoreless streak overall in franchise history was 27.0 IP by Zack Dodson in 2014-2015). He has not surrendered a run in his last 17 appearances. Reliever Jhondaniel Medina has held opposing hitters to a .157 batting average, the fifth-best in the league. Montana DuRapau sits tied for second in the league in saves with 12 in 13 tries.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 44 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third alltime. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Dean Green (41), Jake Fox (38), Quincy Latimore (37) and Steven Moya (35).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.5, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. New Hampshire (26.0) has fielded the oldest roster. The two youngest players on the current Curve roster are both 21 and are also the two highest-ranked prospects: Reese McGuire and Harold Ramirez. Aside from pitchers Jhondaniel Medina (three games at Triple-A this year), no players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese

McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Kevin Newman (11), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).

MOVIN' UP: The Curve have seen five players promoted to Triple-A in 2016, all for the first time in their careers. RHP John Kuchno was promoted on April 15. RHP Jhondaniel Medina was promoted on April 21 and again for one game on May 26. RHP Frank Duncan went up on May 10, and after a onestart return to Altoona, went back to Indianapolis on June 3, RHP Dovvdas Neverauskas was promoted to Triple-A for the first time on June 16. OF Austin Meadows was sent up to Triple-A on June 18.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Six Curve alumni have debuted in the Majors this year, raising the franchise's total to 129 MLB players. On May 16, Alen Hanson (2013-14) debuted with the Pirates. Jameson Taillon (2012-13) pitched for the Pirates on June 8, while A.J. Morris (2014) debuted with the Cincinnati Reds on May 24. Adrian Sampson (2014) got his first start for the Seattle Mariners on June 18. Jacob Stallings (2012/2015) debuted on June 19 with the Pirates against the Cubs.
